#### WHERE IS SAN CAMP

20°30'0.16"S 25° 7'44.07"E

San Camp is situated on the edge of the vast and mysterious Makgadikgadi Salt Pans, the remnant of an extinct super lake that once covered most of Botswana. Whilst they may look empty, the pans are home to unique desert wildlife including ostrich, lion, brown hyena and, of course, the cheeky meerkats.

# WHEN IS A GOOD TIME TO GO

San is open during the dry season only. Please note that some activities are still weather dependent.

## **HOW DO I GET THERE**

Direct flights from Cape Town and Johannesburg to Maun and then take a small charter plane to the Makgadikgadi. Road and self-drive transfers from Maun (approx. 4-5 hrs) are also possible.

## WHERE WILL I STAY

San Camp has 5 twin and 2 double tents all with ensuite bathrooms, indoor showers and large verandas. The tents are spacious, stylish and have solar lighting (ceiling & bedside lights).

#### WHAT WILL I EAT

San Camp has a reputation for delicious, fresh and original menus. Plated meals are elegantly presented. Please inform reservations of any dietary requirements prior to travel.

# WHAT ARE THE FACILITIES

A magnificent mess tent contains a small natural history museum and library. The tea tent, spread with cushions, is a tranquil sanctuary as is the tented yoga pavilion and plunge pool.

#### WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- Camera charging facilities are available in the mess tent (please bring an adaptor).
- There is no Wifi or phone signal in camp.
- Our vehicles are open, with rooftop seats, and fit a maximum of 7 people.
- We can accommodate a maximum of 14 guests in camp.
- Please consult your doctor for recommended vaccinations.
- If quad biking, please bring a good pair of sunglasses or goggles - the sunlight and dust can be harsh.



# WHAT WILL I DO HERE?

# Dry Season (April - October):

- · Meet the habituated meerkats.
- Walks with the Zu/'hoasi Bushmen.
- Search for the elusive brown hyena.
- · Game drives and night drives.
- Game drives to the Makgadikgadi NP (on request for stays of 4 nights or more).
- Visits the site of Chapman's Baobab.
- Helicopter flips.\*
- Morning and afternoon horse rides.\*
- Lie out on the pans at sun set and watch the planetarium show unfold.
- Quad biking (2 guests per quad bike, weather dependent).
