Ubud Wana Resort is a hidden heavenly resort for peace conscious travelers to unwind and relax in a truly quality serenity of Nyuh Kuning hamlet of Ubud and experience in a pampered stay away from home with its heartfelt hospitality, an area that has embraced tourism yet still maintains the traditional roots of the Balinese Hindu community, the myths and legends that underlie so much of a countryside living, designed with rooftop gardens in a two storied building to optimize the natural stunning beauty of the surroundings, split into a few wings with wide distance alleys in between, permitting tropical sunshine to illuminate the resort area and fresh cool breeze to rustle into the entire resort premises. It covers 5000m2 areas on a sloping contour with 73 rooms comprising 68 regular rooms with different angles and views, 2 Honeymoon Suites and 3 Family Suites, in response to every individual need of those in pursuit of a peaceful retreat in the island

Each room is furnished with high end quality materials encompassing solid wooden furniture, high end quality King Koil bed mattress, marble floors, traditional batik fabrics collected from some different islands of Indonesia archipelago as headbed wall backdrops, granite table vanity, energy saving LED lightings, 40' LED TV, and high quality Grohe and Kohler sanitair to offer an entirely cozy stay. Lobby, walkway floors and green walls with vertical hanging gardens along the alleys are crafted by natural stones sourced from Sulawesi and West Java, as a nature touch of the resort's architectural design.

The resort features three separate swimming pools across the resort area with its slightly different depth, 50m, 80m and 120m to cater the excitements of kids, teenagers and adults severally. The pool is also equipped with comforting facilities to include water jet pool seating and four spa bed, to indulge in while letting the children splash around their own size swimming pool.

DESTINATION & DESCRIPTION

Ubud Wana Resort lies in the award winning traditional hamlet of Nyuh Kuning, 350m above sea level, enveloped in the south outskirts of the heart of bustling Ubud with hustle free traffic congestion, a 260m away within an easy walking distance to Ubud Sacred Monkey Forest Sanctuary that provides a short-cut walking access to Ubud down town. Arrival in the hamlet entrance with the population of around 180 families, you will be amazed by the artistic design of Balinese traditional residential along the ways in which each house has almost similar look-gate with its indigenous flower plants, all season blooming with strong fragrance frangipani, lining up. The locals are mostly wood-covers and some are our employees garnering the opportunity to prosper from this robust tourism industry in the area, a sustainable tourism program to undertake a role of Corporate Social Responsibility by empowering the locals. Here, guests can visit art shops, yoga center and restaurants, see the daily life, a dance museum, art and cultural activities of the local community. It is only a 55 minute drive from International Ngurah Rai Denpasar Airport.

Lodtunduh Village

Lodtunduh village is 1.5 km south or about a 20 minutes walk from Ubud Wana Resort and in many ways a typical South Bali village that is centered around the growing of rice and the creation of art. In recent years there has been a steady stream of culturally broadening influences and visitors arriving here due to the beauty of the rice fields. The village is also known as one of the potential in the development of rural tourism and agriculture. Along the way on this village you will find many galleries and shops offering a variety of crafts and painting that made by villagers.

Mas Village

Mas Village is 3 kms to the east from Ubud Wana Resort, one of villages in Bali fundamentally identified as an artistic countryside by focusing in artistic of wood carving. It owns the typical style of wood carving art by placing forward the distinguish synergy the humanism and naturalism. The village's popularity as an art village is famous in the national and world level which is not forgetting from the highness name of some maestros which has borne and found the spirit (taksu) and soul. The famous maestro who was borne in this village is Ida Bagus Tilem

Penestanan Village

Penestanan village is in the west of Ubud Wana Resort, a traditional and pretty village of artists and bead-workers on the western outskirts of Ubud. Surrounded by beautiful terraced rice-fields, this charming village is the home of hundreds of painters and bead-workers who live and work in their traditional walled family compounds. So people with artistic trades as painters, stone and wood carvers, jewellers, basket and textile makers, etc, Each grew specializing in their own particular type of art.

Singekerta Village

Singekerta village is 1km to southwest of Ubud Wana Resort, the most talented Masters of wood carving on the island, you will see the myriad of carving workshops showcasing local made wooden handicrafts in various souvenir style carvings from tiny detailed dancers to full size Komodo dragons
