One of the three bedrooms in Mary Budden Cottage, Cosmos has a fireplace and a beautiful bathroom enriched by its wooden flooring.

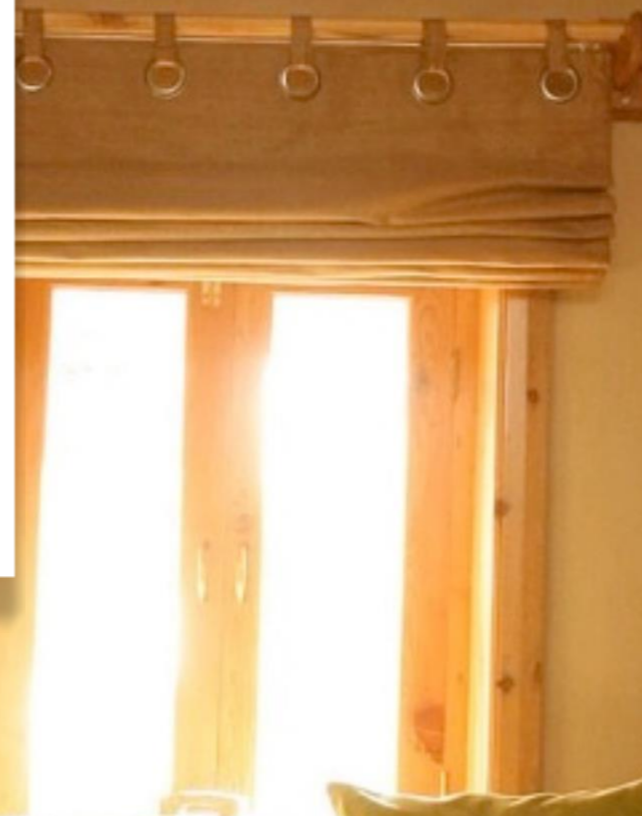




Wisteria

Dalar Village Homestay

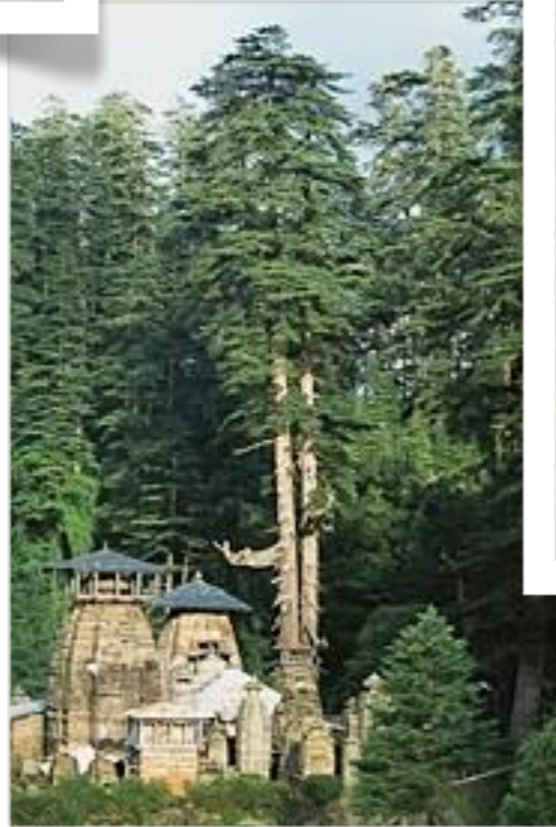
