Directions





HOW TO GET HERE

From **O.R. Tambo International Airport**, take the R21 to Pretoria. Take exit 134 onto the N1 North towards Polokwane. When reaching the Kranskop Toll Plaza keep to the very left lane onto the R33 towards Modimolle. Drive past Vaalwater, where the R33 becomes the R517. **The Main Gate of Welgevonden Game Reserve** is 26km from Vaalwater, on the R517 towards Thabazimbi. The distance is approximately 270km and should take about approximately **2 hours & 45 minutes**.

The road is fully tarred and easy to drive on—there's no need for a four-wheel drive.

ARRIVAL

For the safety of our guests and to preserve the pristine environment of Welgevonden Game Reserve, private vehicles are not permitted within the reserve itself.

Upon arrival at the **Welgevonden Main Gate**, guests will be required to park their vehicle in the secure, designated guest parking area. From here, your guide from Ndlovu Safari Lodge will meet you between 12h30 and 13h00 and assist with your luggage before transferring you to the lodge in an open safari vehicle.

This transfer typically takes 60 minutes and is a scenic drive that often includes exciting wildlife sightings. Your safari experience begins the moment you enter the reserve!

FLIGHT

- There is a helipad on site. Which will take approx. 1 hour from O.R Tambo
- The reserve also has two airstrips, the closest one only being 15 minutes away from the lodge.

Ndlovu Safari Lodge is a 5-star graded property set in a secluded valley within Welgevonden Game Reserve. The lodge is situated along a year-round river, offering a peaceful and scenic setting. It features just five spacious and private villas, designed with a warm, classical style accented by subtle African influences. The intimate scale of the lodge ensures privacy and personalised service, making it ideal travellers seeking a refined and private safari experience.

LOCATION WITHIN THE RESERVE

Ndlovu Safari Lodge is centrally located in Welgevonden Game Reserve, with some of the reserve's main wildlife hotspots just a short drive away, making game viewing especially rewarding.

ALL INCLUSIVE

The lodge operates on an all-inclusive basis, with all meals, game drives, and selected beverages included in the stay.

CHILD POLICY

We welcome guests aged 12 years and older. Children under 12 are only permitted when the entire lodge is booked exclusively. This policy helps us maintain a peaceful and relaxing environment for all our guests.

FACILITIES

At the heart of Ndlovu Safari Lodge is the main lodge, where guests can unwind in several comfortable lounge areas with fireplaces. Meals are served in a dedicated dining room, and there's a well-stocked bar for refreshments throughout the day.

One of the standout features is the expansive viewing deck, overlooking a year-round river and open plains where animals often wander by, offering some of the best on-site wildlife viewing in the reserve.

Other facilities include an outdoor dining area, a Lapa with multiple seating options and its own fireplace, a firepit circle for evenings under the stars, and a heated swimming pool for year-round use.

Villa's









Each of Ndlovu's five villas offers a private and spacious retreat, designed with classical warmth and subtle African accents. Large sliding doors open onto a generous wooden deck with a heated plunge pool and uninterrupted views into the surrounding bush. Privacy walls at the back ensure complete seclusion, making each villa feel like its own hideaway in nature.

While the villas vary slightly in layout and size, they average around 50 square meters indoors and 110 square meters outdoors, giving every guest a comfortable mix of indoor and outdoor living.

Villa's



Villa 4/5 are interconnected, making them a practical option for families or friends traveling together. Both rooms include the same high-quality amenities as the other villas and share a generous outdoor deck and plunge pool, with views into the bush. Room 4 is slightly more compact and does not include its own lounge area with a fireplace or a private outdoor bath or shower. This configuration offers an ideal mix of privacy and togetherness.

Please note: Villa 4 and 5 form one combined villa with two rooms. If Villa 5 is booked by only 2 PAX, Villa 4 will automatically be blocked to ensure exclusive use of the shared spaces.



Villa 2 is our designated honeymoon suite, offering the most expansive outdoor deck at the lodge. While it doesn't include an indoor lounge or fireplace (like Room 4) it features a private outdoor Lapa with its own fireplace, ideal for cozy evenings. The suite also boasts the largest outdoor bath and shower area, making it a perfect choice for couples seeking space and privacy.


