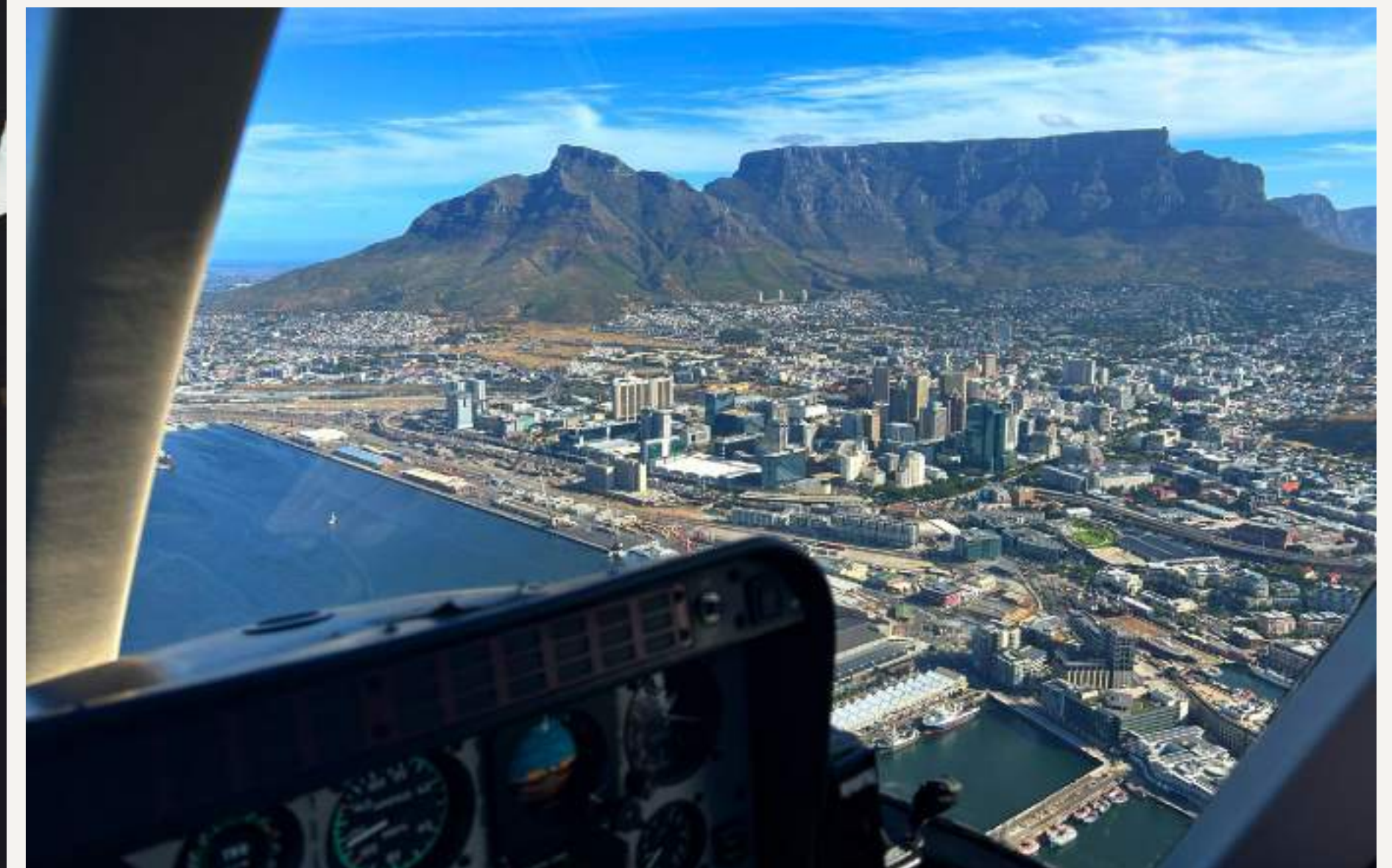
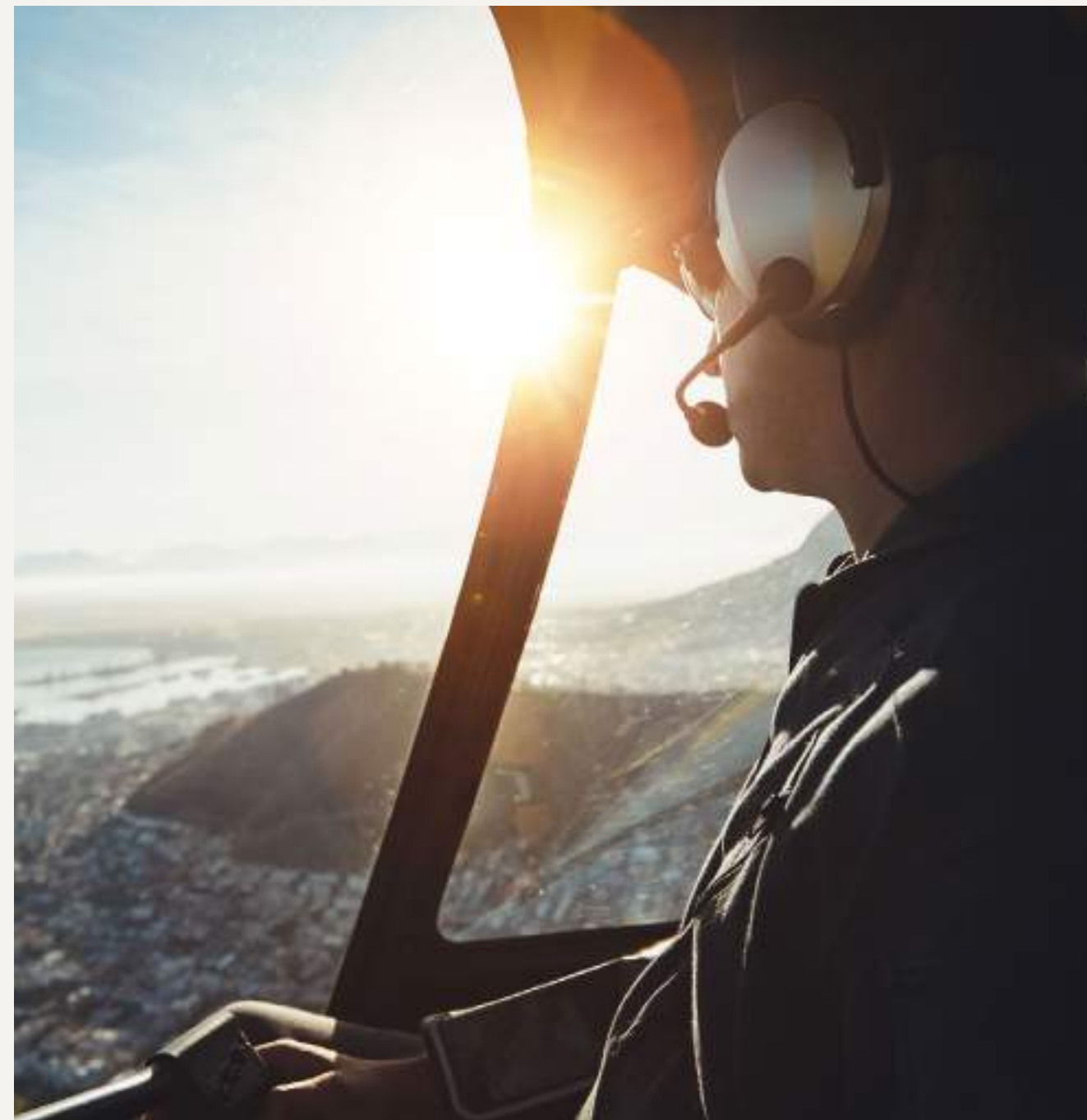


SPA AND WELLNESS

BY AIR

- There are daily, scheduled flights into Cape Town International Airport
- Private charters are available into Cape Town International Airport



TRANSFERS

- Airport transfers and point-to-point transport can be arranged (additional cost)



BY ROAD

- 30-60 minute drive from Cape Town International Airport (13 miles), depending on traffic
- Direct route via major city highways
- Off-street and covered parking available (additional cost)

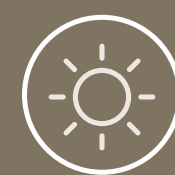




SPRING

(September – November)

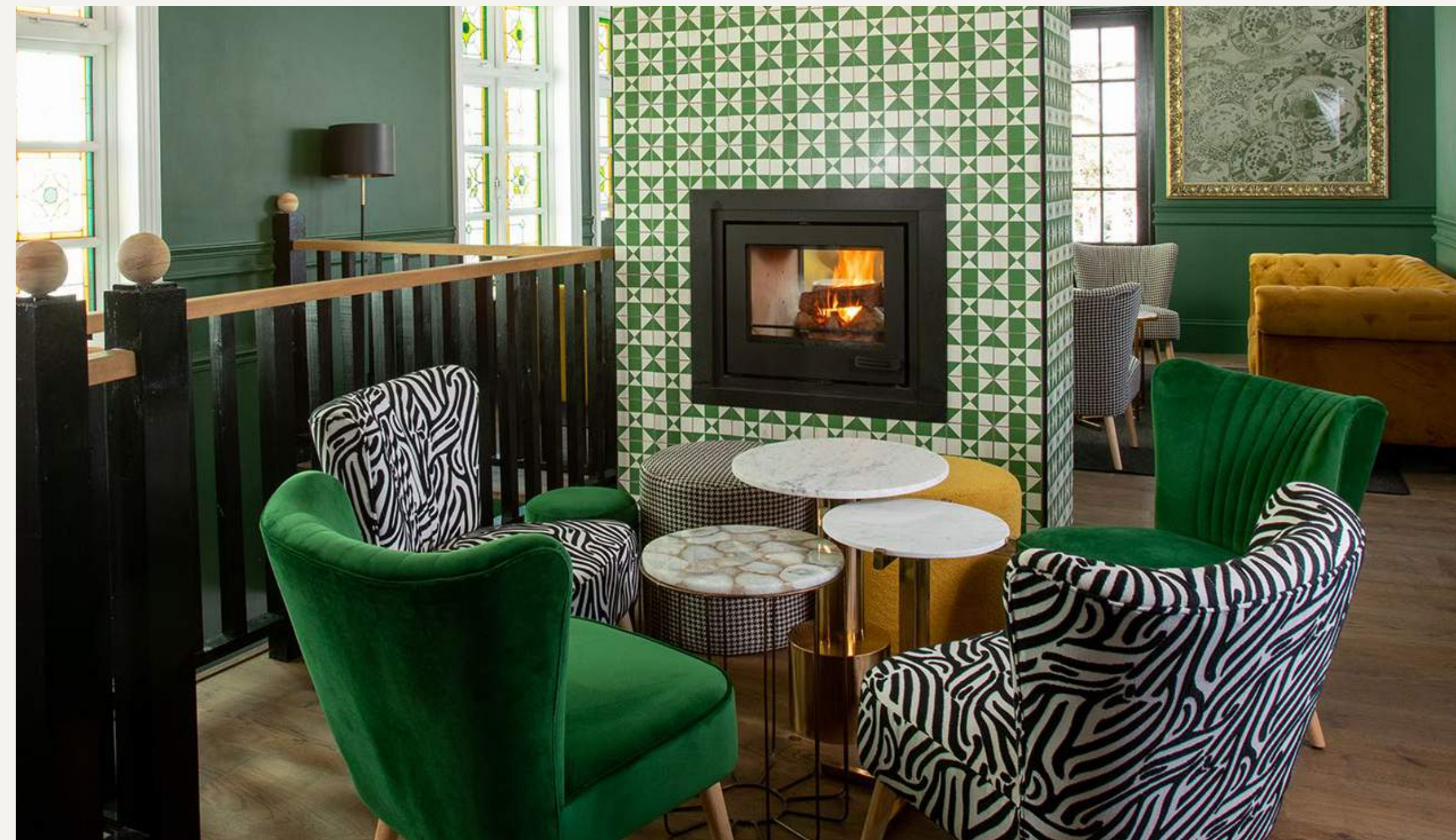
- **Temperature:** 16-22°C (61-72°F)
- **Highlights:** Wildflowers blanket the West Coast in September, a natural spectacle worth the drive. Spring is also a great time to spot whales and other marine life.
- **Seasonal appeal:** Mild temperatures ideal for hiking and exploring.



SUMMER

(December – February)

- **Temperature:** 16-27°C (62-81°F)
- **Highlights:** The warm summer months offer the perfect weather for long beach days and balmy evenings out. February is also the height of harvest season, with many wine estates offering special experiences.
- **Seasonal appeal:** Sunny skies and very little rain.



AUTUMN

(March – May)

- **Temperature:** 15-23°C (59-73°F)
- **Highlights:** Cooler autumn temperatures create excellent shark-cage diving conditions for thrill-seekers. With fewer visitors, Cape Town's best spots are yours to enjoy unhurried.
- **Seasonal appeal:** Comfortable weather and dramatic sunsets.



WINTER

(June – August)

- **Temperature:** 7-18°C (45-64°F)
- **Highlights:** Visit one of the Cape's many wine estates and sip on a glass of wine in front of a cosy fire. Cooler, quieter days make it an ideal time to explore museums, galleries and Cape Town's indoor culinary scene.
- **Seasonal appeal:** A quieter season for food, wine and culture.

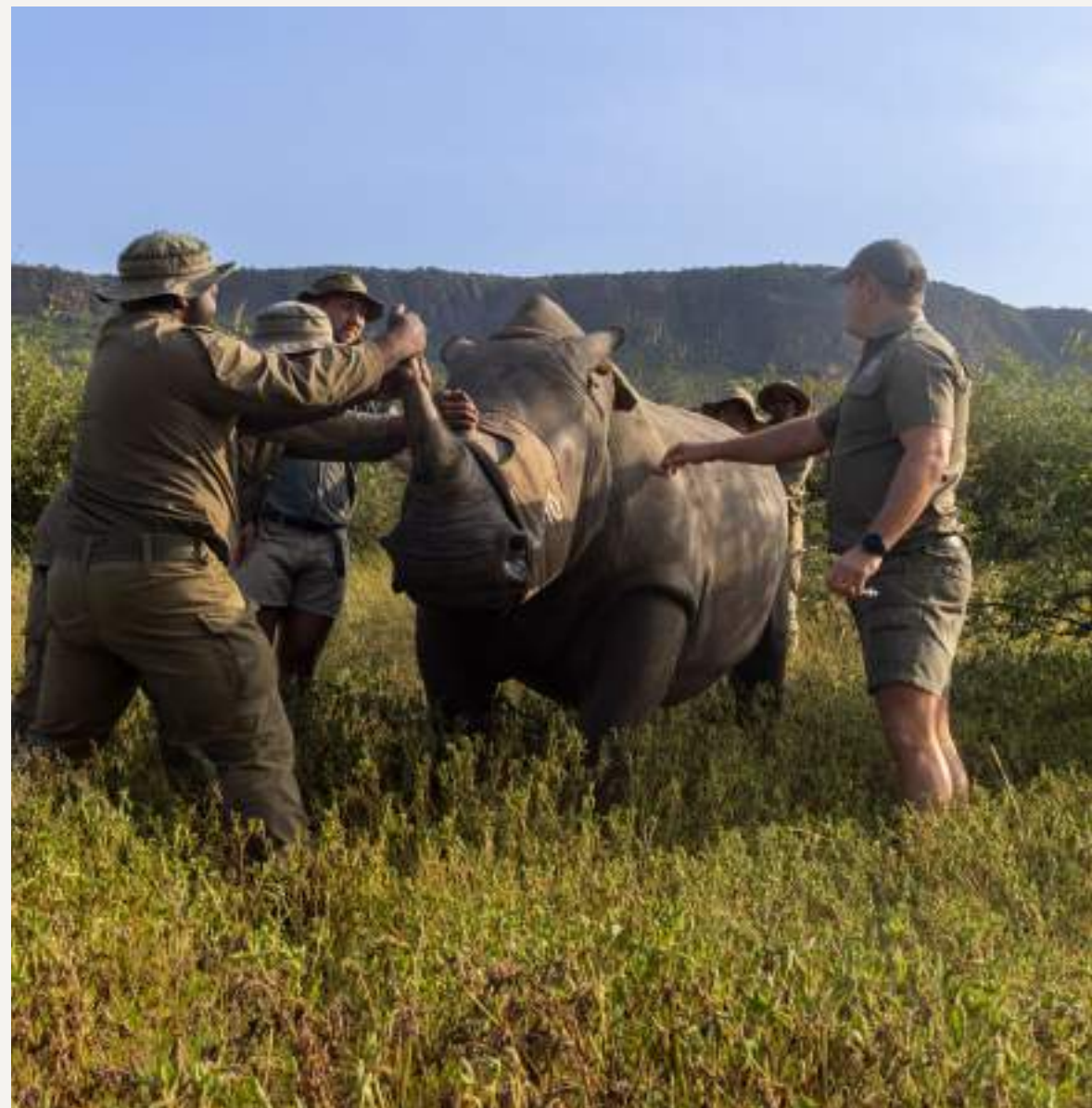
COLLECTIVELY CREATING POSITIVE, MEANINGFUL, AND SUSTAINABLE CHANGE
