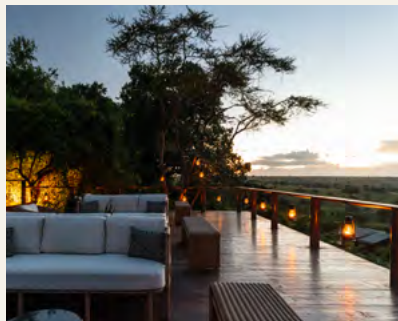

A Riverside Sanctuary in the Wild

Hidden among the rocky outcrops of the northern Serengeti, overlooking the Grumeti River, lies a luxury tented retreat that follows the timeless path of the Great Migration.



Rising on wooden platforms above the banks of the Grumeti River, our camp is designed to flow with the natural contours of the landscape. This unique elevation provides a magnificent perspective of the sprawling savanna and the resident hippos in the river below, blending high-end comfort with the raw spirit of the northern Serengeti.

Effortless Mara River Access

The camp offers convenient game drive access to the iconic Mara River for all guests booked on the property's game package. This premium positioning allows travel planners to easily arrange comprehensive full-day tracking excursions in the hopes of witnessing a thrilling, high-drama wildebeest river crossing.

Prime Great Migration Location

Situated along a key corridor of the annual Great Migration, the camp is ideally placed to experience one of nature's most magnificent events. Guests visiting from April through June, and again from late October through December, are well positioned to witness the massive herds traversing the region firsthand.

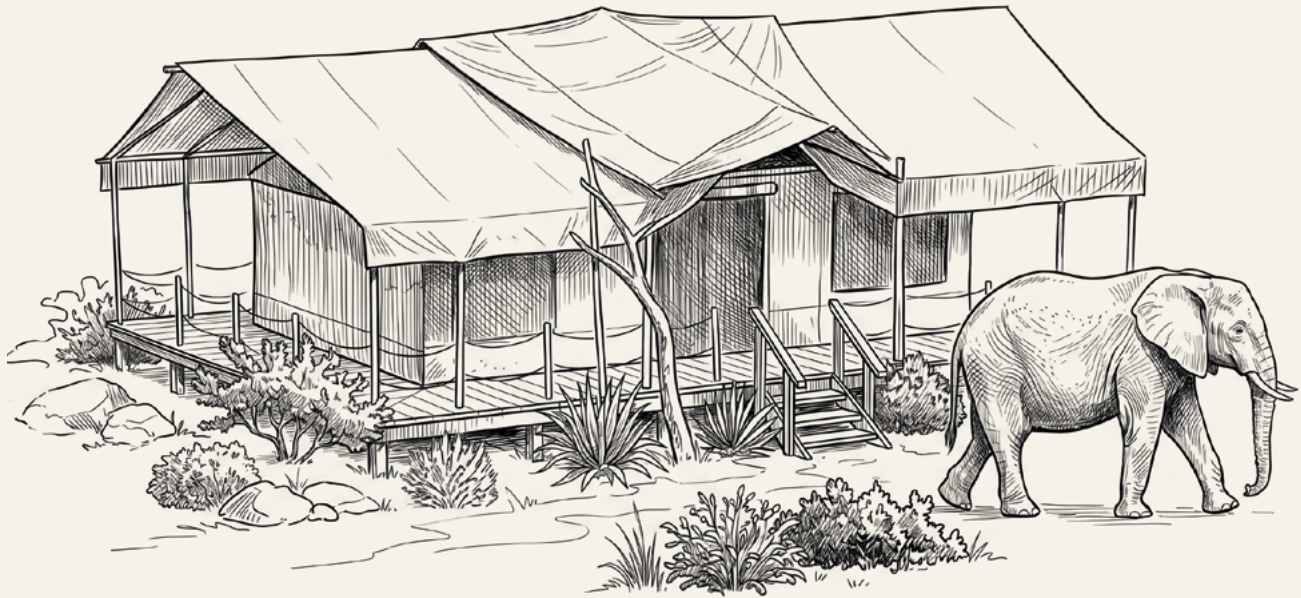
Sophisticated On-Site Wildlife Viewing

The property is engineered to provide exceptional wildlife viewing opportunities without the need to leave the grounds. Featuring expansive private guest decks and beautifully designed split-level main lounges, the camp serves as an elevated, highly sophisticated vantage point for observing game directly.

Iconic Resident Hippo Pools

The camp is located adjacent to a series of vibrant river pools along the Grumeti River, home to a large and active population of resident hippos. Guests can enjoy the classic soundtrack of their calls from the comfort of camp, or book a guided bush walk along the riverbanks for close-up viewing.





At One with the Wild

The tented suites at Serengeti Migration Camp are a masterful blend of low-impact design and high-end luxury, hidden among the rocky outcrops and lush vegetation along the Grumeti River. Positioned at the very heart of the Serengeti's most dramatic wildlife theatre, each spacious canvas tent is raised on a wooden deck to offer 360-degree views of the surrounding wilderness. It is an immersive sanctuary where the ancient rhythm of the migration meets the refined comfort of an authentic safari lodge.

♦ 20 Canvas Safari Tents (64m²)

Spacious canvas tents set on elevated hardwood platforms with private wraparound decks, lounge areas, and 360-degree views of the river and plains. All tents are convertible into twin or double configurations.

Nestled among natural boulders and acacia trees, each tent offers privacy - allowing the gentle sights and sounds of the river to create a serene backdrop for your ultimate Serengeti adventure.



Observe the resident hippos from your private deck, track the Great Migration through the rugged northern hills, or share stories by the campfire as the sounds of the Grumeti River drift through the night.

Daily Game Drives

Set out in our custom-designed 4x4 vehicles, specifically engineered for the rugged northern terrain. With the guidance of our expert guides, you'll explore the rolling hills and hidden valleys of the Serengeti, encountering a spectacular density of wildlife.

Mara River Day Trips

Embark on an iconic full-day excursion to the world-renowned Mara River. This journey takes you to the heart of the Great Migration's most dramatic landscape, where you can witness the sheer scale of the herds as they gather along the riverbanks in anticipation of the crossing.

Grumeti River Walks

Experience the Serengeti from a different perspective on a guided walking safari along the banks of the Grumeti River. Accompanied by an armed scout, you'll discover the intricate details of the bush, from tracking footprints to identifying medicinal plants.

Bush Breakfast or Lunch

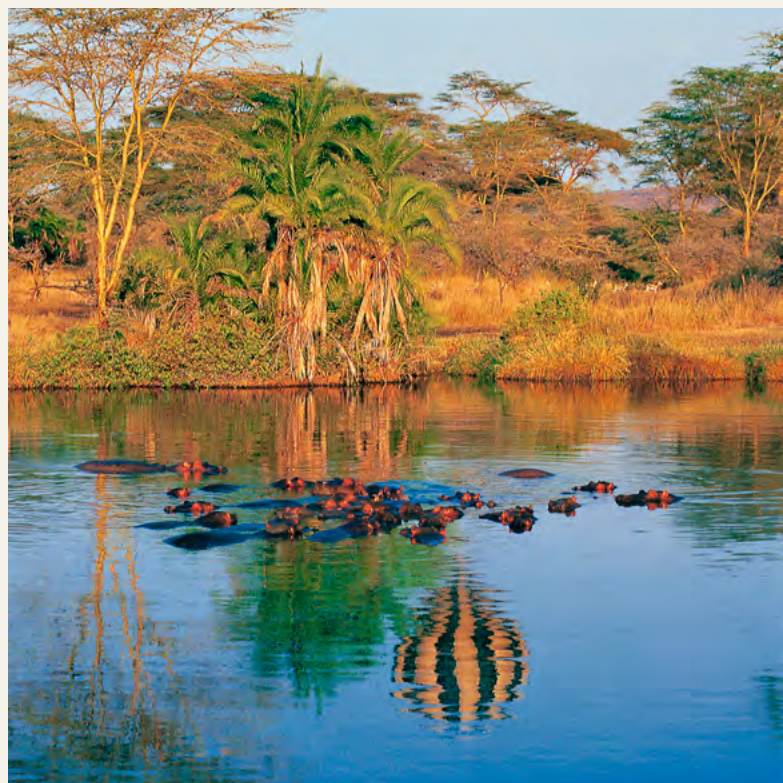
