## PROTECTED MARINE CONSERVATION AREA

Characterised by its towering sand dunes, inland lakes and pristine beaches, beautiful Benguerra Island forms part of a group of tropical islands which were declared a national park in 1971. The others include Santa Carolina, Bangué, Magaruque, and Bazaruto.

## EASY ACCESSIBILITY

Vilanculos in Mozambique is easily accessible from South Africa. Just a short 1hr 30mins flight with SA Airlink will ensure you don't miss your breakfast in Johannesburg, but still arrive in the beautiful Bazaruto Archipelago in time for lunch. From the airport, a helicopter transfer to your accommodation reveals the dreamlike mirage of impossibly white sand dunes and endless shades of turquoise water not far below.

## DIVERSITY OF MARINE LIFE

The waters that lap the archipelago brim with an array of reef fish, sea turtles and game fish. Numerous endangered marine species have also been documented here, such as whale sharks, manta rays, leatherback turtles, humpback whales and the very rare dugong.

## BEAUTIFUL BEACHES

Mozambique has remained an exclusive destination as many of its islands and mainland beaches are isolated and secluded, offering guests the ultimate escape. There are no golf courses or shopping malls here. It's the unspoiled natural beauty and rich marine life that have pushed the country to the top of the list for honeymooners, scuba divers and water sports fanatics. Soft, white sand beaches lined with coconut palms stretch as far as the eye can see.



# Travel to the Bazaruto Archipelago and beyond

Travelling to Mozambique requires careful consideration and attention to detail when booking flights and transfers. Contact your preferred Travel Specialist to assist with your travel plans.

## GETTING THERE

Airlink and LAM operate direct flights from Johannesburg to Vilanculos (only 1hr 30mins), while LAM also runs flights between Maputo and Vilanculos.

A short 10 minute scenic helicopter transfer from Vilanculos International Airport to the Benguerra Island lodge helipad. This is followed by a short walk to the reception.

# In the water



1

### SNORKELLING

Venture out into the Indian Ocean at low tide and explore large areas of exposed coastal reefs just off Benguerra Island. Discover the spectacular Two Mile Reef, which offers snorkelling opportunities for every guest, regardless of age and expertise. One of the favourite sites here is the Aquarium, known for its diverse reef and pelagic fish, and extensive coral, as well as a fascinating array of underwater rocks and boulders that create interesting structures such as swim throughs, and overhangs.

The waters of the Bazaruto Archipelago boast outstanding natural reefs which are carefully preserved.

### SWIMMING WITH HORSES

Equine enthusiasts of all ages and riding levels can enjoy a fun-filled Swimming with Horses adventure. Dress down for the occasion in just your swimwear and ride bareback into azure waters, gently striding into the warm waters of the Indian Ocean. Expect splashing and the occasional grunt of pleasure from your horse as it wades into the calm waters surrounding the lodge. This 30-to-45-minute adventure allows for a maximum of four guests per swim and is perfect as a standalone activity or can be added after a more extensive horseback exploration of the island.

### SCUBA DIVING\*

We offer a fully equipped Dive Centre, providing a full range of diving adventures that will suit the preferences of every scuba enthusiast. The island offers exceptional diving opportunities and boasts outstanding protected reefs. There is an infinite range of dive sites, such as Two Mile Reef, 5 Mile Reef, 9 Mile Reef, San Sebastian, and Magaruque Island, to name a few.

## SCUBA DIVING COURSES\*

The Dive Centre at &Beyond Benguerra Island offers a full range of PADI-accredited courses for those looking to advance their diving qualifications.

### PADI DISCOVER SCUBA DIVING

This introductory course is perfect for little ones or adults who are keen to explore the world of diving. It is also recommended for guests who have limited time on the island.

### PADI SCUBA DIVER

This course is a lifetime certification. The maximum depth is 12 m (39 ft) and the minimum age is 10 years old. This course does not offer a full certification as an independent diver.

### REFRESHER DIVE

Necessary for fully certified divers who have not participated in diving for six months or more.

### PADI OPEN WATER DIVER

Learn to scuba dive to a depth of 18 m (59 ft) and earn a qualification allowing you to dive independently. Upon conclusion guests will receive a lifetime PADI Open Water diving certificate.

### PADI ADVANCED OPEN WATER

This course is available to certified Open Water divers. After completing five specialised training dives, the course will certify divers to reach a maximum depth of 30 m (98 ft).

### RESCUE DIVER

"Challenging and rewarding" best describe the PADI Rescue Diver course. This course expands on what divers have already learnt about dealing with difficult situations.

### EMERGENCY FIRST RESPONSE

Guests can take a step towards emergency preparedness and meet part of the PADI Rescue Diver prerequisites with this course.

### BIRDWATCHING

The last remaining patch of protected indigenous forest on the island can be found around &Beyond Benguerra Island lodge. Keen birders can keep an eye out for special sightings such as green malkoha and plain-backed sunbird. Head to the inland lakes to search for greater flamingo and western osprey. Pink-backed pelican, lesser crested tern, ruddy turnstone and other water birds can also be found in the area.

## 6

### SCENIC HELICOPTER FLIGHTS\*

Experience the beauty of the Bazaruto Archipelago from above as you board a state-of-the-art helicopter and fly along the Mozambican coastline. This scenic trip offers magnificent photographic opportunities through every window, with unobstructed views of the idyllic islands and the depths of clear water surrounding them.

## 7

### COMMUNITY VISITS

A fascinating excursion to the community centre, Centro Cumunitario Kanhe Kwedo, will introduce you to the heart of the island, where local women create beautiful, beaded items for sale and men practice conservation initiatives. Stroll among the pews of the village church, visit the local clinic built with the help of past guest donations, taste fresh fruit and vegetables grown by local farmers and interact with the friendly Mozambican people in their coastal villages.

# Sustainability initiatives



## CARE OF Land

- 30 576 plastic bottles eliminated annually through on-site water bottling plant
- 91 728 litres of water saved (3 litres used to make a 1 litre plastic bottle)
- 572 kg of plastic eliminated annually
- Zero plastic straws
- All guest amenities recyclable
- 1 535 Coca-Cola cans and 64 cases of plastic wrapping eliminated per month through a return-for-deposit glass bottle system
- On-site capping machine enables the re-use of soft drink glass bottles for healthy guest beverages
- Surplus bottles donated to a local honey farmer for packaging of his organic honey



## CARE OF Wildlife

- An average 226 community children receive marine-themed conservation lessons per year
- No-take Marine Conservation Area established in front of the lodge: ecosystem changes will be documented to demonstrate the benefits of protected areas to local fishing communities
- Three underwater acoustic receiver stations positioned in the Bazaruto Archipelago (part of a broader network of receivers managed by other research and conservation teams) record the passing of tagged reef predators to monitor the movement patterns and environmental stresses of these indicator species
- Marine Predator Tagging Project commenced in July 2019. As top reef predators, giant trevally and grey reef sharks play a critical role in the health and balance of their marine ecosystems

Impact made possible through Oceans Without Borders, our marine conservation initiative, in partnership with Wild Impact\*, our long-standing community and conservation development partner.



## CARE OF People

- 168 million MZN spent on local procurement initiatives
- 220 Hippo Water Rollers provided for clean water access and transport
- 860 COVID-19 food relief parcels given to local communities
- 800 solar lanterns donated by &Beyond's 'Light the Way' initiative for those with no electricity access
- 49 Star-in-Training lodge trainees from the local community receive workplace experience
- Five ANAC (National Administration for Conservation Areas) marine rangers achieve PADI Dive certification
- Island Clinic expanded with additional consulting rooms, nurses' accommodation, electricity, and permanent water supply
- Community centre built (also a safe refuge during cyclone strikes)
