



Recommended Itinerary for Fully Inclusive Package

Arrival Day

- Arrive midday, enjoy a light lunch al fresco & check into your cottage.
- Put your walking boots on & head out for a short exploratory walk under the canopy of Acacia trees that line the stream below the lodge.
- Return in time for a refreshing shower before coming through for a delicious farm-fresh 3-course meal after choosing an award-winning South African wine from our underground cellar.

Day 1

- After an early-morning steaming cup of coffee on the verandah, head out into the game reserve on foot with an experienced guide, where you have the chance of tracking rhino, identifying new birds and gazing out at the spectacular vistas. Return for a hearty South African breakfast, followed by a lazy morning beside the pool.

- Enjoy a private lunch served al fresco on the viewing deck.
- After a short siesta, afternoon tea and freshly baked treats will be served, before saddling-up a mountain bike or one of our beloved horses, and head into the hills for a romantic sunset ride.
- Return in time for sundowner drinks overlooking the Drakensberg Mountains.
- Dinner enjoyed on the verandah.

Day 2

- After breakfast, you will be introduced to your battlefield guide who will give you a brief summary about the history of South Africa, leading up to the South African War. You will then be driven to the Colenso battle and Churchills Capture Sites,

- where seven Victoria Crosses were awarded - won in a single morning's fight contributing to two of only three father and son VC's ever to be awarded.
- Picnic lunch will be enjoyed under the canopy of Acacia trees at Ambleside Military Cemetery.
- From here you will drive to the summit of Spioenkop, where you will hear the story of the bloodiest, single day of the entire South African war.
- Return in time for drinks at the lodge, with a selection of our craft gins - before savoring a well-deserved 3-course dinner.

Day 3

- After breakfast, head up into the majestic Drakensberg mountains with a tasty picnic lunch. Enter the Royal Natal National Park (Maloti-Drakensberg Park), where you can enjoy a leisurely stroll to the Cascades waterfall.



...continued Day 3

- or if you are more adventurous you can attempt the full Tugela Gorge hike (14km round trip). Enjoy your picnic lunch beside the river, listening to the chorus of birds in the special UNESCO World Heritage Site..
- Return in time for sunset drinks overlooking the Drakensberg mountains, followed by a dinner under the stars.



Departure Day

- Enjoy a leisurely breakfast, after which you can choose to go out one of the many self-guided walking trails on the farm, stretching your legs before your onward journey.
- As you depart the lodge, you can choose to visit the Rangeworthy Cemetery, 2km along the exit road.
