ABOUT THREE TREE HILL

Three Tree Hill is nestled in the foothills of the KwaZulu-Natal Drakensberg Mountains, offering a unique blend of history, nature, and sustainability. This intimate, owner-managed lodge is Fair Trade certified, emphasizing their commitment to responsible tourism. Guests are welcomed into a warm, homely atmosphere, with a focus on preserving the rich history of the surrounding Anglo-Boer War sites and the heritage of the local Zulu culture.

Beneath the lodge's Molly Blackburn Library lies an underground wine cellar, providing a unique setting for wine enthusiasts. The cellar boasts a curated selection of South African wines, aligning with the lodge's commitment to sustainability and ethical sourcing. Guests can enjoy private meals and wine tastings, hosted by the owner in this intimate space, enhancing their culinary experience.

Three Tree Hill offers a wine list featuring a variety of 90 South African wines produced under organic and biodynamic practices, women wine makers, black-owned wineries and smaller producers. Wines have also been carefully selected to represent all regions, grape varieties and terroirs of South Africa, which all make for the variety of distinctive and unique wines. Wines have also been chosen for producers who adhere to ethical practices, ensuring fair wages and improved living conditions for farm workers. There is also a vintage section in the cellar where guests can choose older vintages dating as far back as 2009.

The lodge's dining experience emphasizes fresh, locally sourced ingredients. Meals are served individually, with a set three-course dinner menu together with wine recommendations that changes daily. Guests can savour homely farm-style dishes, followed by South African cigar, port or cognac, either by the fireplace or under the stars around the boma fire.



ABOUT SOUTH AFRICAN WINE

South Africa's wine industry is a vibrant tapestry of producers, from celebrated wine estates to independent winemakers crafting exceptional wines from carefully selected vineyards. While many renowned wineries are set on picturesque estates in the Cape Winelands, others create distinctive wines without owning vineyards or estates of their own.

What unites them all is a shared passion for quality winemaking and a commitment to expressing the unique character of South Africa's diverse wine-growing regions.

WINEGROWING REGIONS

Although South Africa's wine industry is concentrated in the Western Cape, vineyards stretch from the cool Atlantic coast near Cape Town to the southernmost tip of Africa, and even our very own district in KwaZulu Natal, consisting of the Lions River and Central Drakensberg, creating one of the most geographically diverse wine-producing landscapes in the world.

LABELS AND CERTIFICATION



This **seal on the left** appears on each bottle of wine or estate brandy which has been certified by the Wine Certification Authority. The seal guarantees the trustworthiness of all information relating to origin, cultivar and vintage as stated on the label. The identification numbers on the seal are an indication of the strict control by the Wine Certification Authority, from the pressing of the grapes to the certifying of the final product. The **seal on the right** is a world first and a great advantage for South Africa. It is a joint visual guarantee, (not only for the integrity of origin, vintage and cultivar) but also for the sustainable production of wine and traceability from the vineyard to the bottle.

The WO seal is available to producers who only comply with WO requirements and not IPW requirements. 96% of certified wines are certified in accordance with the WO and IPW schemes, meeting the requirements to carry the sustainability seal.

This alliance is called Sustainable Wine South Africa and we believe it aligns really well our ethos at Three Tree Hill.

WINE RATINGS

While ratings and awards can be useful guides, wine remains a matter of personal taste. Some of South Africa's most memorable wines may not be the highest-scoring, but rather those that best reflect the character of their vineyard, region and winemaker. Many wine enthusiasts use ratings as a starting point and then explore wines that suit their own palate.

Platter's South African Wine Guide

The most widely recognised wine guide in South Africa, often referred to as the "Bible" of South African wine. This is the rating system we have used for our wine list. Wines are rated on a **5-star scale**:

- ★★★★★ – Exceptional, world-class wine
- ★★★★★☆ – Outstanding
- ★★★★★ – Excellent
- ★★★★☆ – Very good
- ★★★ – Good quality
- Below ★★★ – Sound but less distinguished

A 5-star rating is highly sought after and awarded to only a small percentage of wines each year.

Tim Atkin South Africa Report

British Master of Wine Tim Atkin annually reviews South African wines using the international **100-point scale**:

- 95–100 points – Outstanding to world-class
- 90–94 points – Excellent
- 85–89 points – Very good
- Below 85 points – Good to acceptable

His report is highly influential both locally and internationally.

WINE BY THE GLASS (200ml)

What follows below is merely a guide to help you choose a glass of wine. Should you require a taste of something else from the list, please feel free to ask your waitron.

Pierre Jourdan Brut R125

MCC with sweet entry, shy apple flavours and brisk finish.

2025 Trizanne Signature Wines (TSW) Sauvignon Blanc R95

Vibrant & fresh note of passion fruit, citrus & subtle herbal notes with a distinct minerality expected from this cooler climate wine.

Energetic palate, which finishes off on a dry, clean and very classy note.

2024 DMZ Chardonnay R95

Stone fruit aromas of nectarine and peach with subtle citrus hints and creamy oak. The palate has bright acidity and limey freshness but delivers rich texture and chalky, mineral length.

2024 HER Chenin Blanc R70

Lively and captivating bursting with aromas ripe apple, juicy melon, and delicate citrus blossoms.

2025 Dawn Patrol Cinsault Rosé R70

Displays flavours of wild strawberries, floral undertones & mouth-watering pomegranate, complimented with a fantastic dry finish.

2021 Reyneke Organic Shiraz/Cabernet Sauvignon R95

Fruit is rich and pure, but has an old-world feel in its complex long, dry finish.

2020 Org de Rac Organic Cabernet R80

Distinctive aromas of tomato leaf, pencil shavings and mulberry beckon on the nose. A rich and well-rounded wine with sumptuous dark fruit flavours supported by velvety tannins.

2024 Peacock Merlot R70

Distinctive notes of plums and red berries, with subtle earthy notes also adding to the complexity. I would recommend serving it slightly chilled, with a simple lamb chop on the braai or just enjoying it on its own.

DE-ALCOHOLISED

Winemaking is gentle, with minimum intervention and only when the winemaker is content with the quality of the wine, the alcohol is removed via a spinning cone. Done under vacuum and at a low temperature, this process ensures the product retains its unique appeal.

Suitable for Vegans and low in calories.

Darling Cellars Sparkling Blanc R295

Darling

An elegant white sparkling with aromas of green apple and sweet pear following through to a balanced palate with a lively sparkle and lingering finish that leaves you wanting more.

Darling Cellars Sauvignon Blanc R200

Darling

A light yellow with green tint in colour, flavours of ripe tropical fruit, yellow peaches and gooseberries complimented by a fresh acidity and lingering finish.

Leopards Leap Natura Classic White R195

Franschhoek

Crisp and refreshing, with tropical fruit flavours and integrated palate. Made from Chenin Blanc and Muscat grapes.

Darling Cellars Shiraz R200

Darling

Deep ruby red in colour with hints of ripe red fruit, crushed black pepper, dried rose petals and candied cherries. Well integrated French Oak tannins.

Leopards Leap Natura Classic Red R195

Franschhoek

Red berries and sweet spice intrigue and follow through for a smooth mouthfeel and lingering after-taste. Made from Cinsaut and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes.

SPARKLING WINES

Under agreement with France, South Africa does not use the term "Champagne" which is a geographic appellation describing the sparkling wines from the Champagne region in France. In South Africa the term METHOD CAP CLASSIQUE (MCC) is rather used. MCC describes Sparkling Wines made by the classic Methode Champenoise.

2018 Simonsig Cuveé Royale R1150

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (91pts)

The finesse, purity & power of Chardonnay finds expression in this grand style of Blanc de Blanc. Creamy, dry elegance with cinnamon and toast.

Colmant Brut Rosé NV R905

Franschhoek (Platter ★★★★★☆) (92pts)

Delightful blend of Pinot Noir (80%) and Chardonnay (20%) with a minimum 24 months on the lees. This MCC is macerated on the skins to give the Brut Rose its colour and signature berry aroma and flavour. Elegant, with silky richness & vibrant colour that reflects the fresh notes of wild strawberries & red currants.

2021 Makeba Cap Classique Pinot Noir Brut R765

Walker Bay (Platter ★★★★★☆) (80pts)

Delicate red fruit aromas lead with raspberry, strawberry and pomegranate, complemented by ruby grapefruit brightness. Biscuit and brioche characters add textural complexity, while subtle spicy notes provide depth and intrigue.

Abingdon Pet-Nat R495

KwaZulu Natal Lions River

Pet-Nat stands for petillant-naturel – a wine that's bottled before the fermentation is complete. The result is a sparkling wine that has less fizz than champagne but tastes just as good. Perfumed floral nose of violets, subtle apricots, white peach and pear drop on the palate.

Pierre Jourdan Brut NV R435

Franschhoek (Platter ★★★★★☆) (87pts)

Classic blend of chardonnay & 9% pinot noir.
Fruity-fresh, mainly citrus with peach for early drinking.

CHENIN BLANC

Chenin is the Cape's signature variety, with the largest planting of this variety in the world. Smoky sweet Sunday Gammon will match well with these wines.

2025 Lievland Old Vine Chenin Blanc R420

Paarl (Platter ★★★★★) (89pts)

Light straw colour with notes of white peach, citrus and pineapple on the nose. The mouthfeel is rich and ripe and coupled with vibrant acidity.

2025 Cederberg Chenin Blanc R300

Citrusdal (Platter ★★★★★) (88pts)

South Africa's highest lying vineyards (1036m above sea level) near the coastal windswept town of Elim, makes this chenin truly unique. This unoaked vintage tastes of crisp, green apples lengthening with a dry finish.

2024 Kumusha Chenin Blanc R285

Breedekloof (Platter ★★★★★) (84pts)

A collaboration between Zimbabwean Sommelier, Tinashe Nyamudoka, and Swartland winemaker, Attie Louw, this wine reveals aromas of pear, white peach & lime on the nose. Juicy palate with flavours of melon & matamba (monkey orange) with a crisp, dry finish.

2022 Marras Chenin Blanc R255

Paardeberg

Medium-bodied dry white with juicy pear & quince on the palate and baking spice aftertaste. Unpretentious and uncomplicated.

2024 Adama HER Chenin Blanc R255

Paarl (Platter ★★★★★) (87pts)

Lively and captivating unwooded Chenin Blanc, bursting with aromas of ripe apple, juicy melon, and delicate citrus blossoms. The medium-bodied palate reveals layers of vibrant tropical fruit, intertwined with a subtle mineral edge, leading to a crisp, invigorating finish that lingers with elegance and freshness. They don't only have a female winemaker – every member of their team is female. From viticulture and winemaking to finance, logistics, marketing and sales, HER is built by women across the wine value chain and we love that!

CHARDONNAY

(Wooded)

Roast chicken, lentil curry and bobotie dishes go well with Chardonnay.

2022 Karatara Chardonnay R495

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (93pts)

This wooded chardonnay has the classic notes of lemon and grapefruit you would expect from a Chardonnay, with hints of almonds and a fine mineral finish.

2020 Hartenberg Chardonnay R395

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (92pts)

This vintage is so smooth with lime grass flavour notes, together with vanilla, butter and cream finish.

2024 DeMorgenzon (DMZ) Chardonnay R395

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (89pts)

Stone fruit aromas of nectarine and peach with subtle citrus hints and creamy oak. The palate has bright acidity and limey freshness but delivers rich texture and chalky, mineral length.

CHARDONNAY

(Un-Wooded)

2024 Bouchard Finlayson Sans Barrique Chardonnay R375

Walker Bay (Platter ★★★★★) (90pts)

Crafted in a Burgundian style for wine lovers who like their Chardonnay unhindered by the taste of oak. Rounded, rich with pure lemon and lime fruit, creaminess with cool, zesty, balanced finish.

2023 Compagniesdrift Chardonnay R225

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (84pts)

The establishment of Compagniesdrift was to ensure meaningful and economically viable empowerment of the workers from the Myburgh family's Meerlust Workers Trust. This pale wine has a vibrant green hue in the glass with a light and dainty fresh, citrus appeal. A versatile wine that can be enjoyed anywhere and at any time, not necessarily with food.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Always suited to enjoy with lunchtime home grown salads and our famous fish pie.

2020 Fryers Cove Bamboes Bay Sauvignon Blanc R975

Bamboes Bay, West Coast (Platter ★★★★★) (88pts)

Invigorating sea-inflected intensity in greenage, lemongrass, passionfruit array. Taut & bracingly racy, balanced by the underlying weight. On the nose this wine is a vibrant mix of clean, herbaceous and tangy passion fruit aromas, with briny wisps of seaweed in the background.

2025 Trizanne Signature Wines (TSW) Sauvignon Blanc R375

Agulhas (Platter ★★★★★) (86pts)

Vibrant & fresh note of fig and granadilla, with crisp acid and cool-climate dustiness typical of the Cape South Coast.

Energetic palate, which finishes off on a dry, crisp and very classy note.

2025 Aslina Sauvignon Blanc R295

Stellenbosch

Ntsiki Biyela grew up in Mahlabathini, a rural village in KwaZulu-Natal, and matriculated from high school in 1996. Having spent a year as a domestic worker, she was awarded a scholarship to study winemaking at Stellenbosch University and eventually graduated in 2003 with a BSc in Agriculture (Viticulture and Oenology). Her beloved grandmother was the guiding light in her life and it became obvious that her new brand should be named Aslina in the matriarch's honour.

A full rounded tropical character sauvignon blanc, with complex bright fruit and lots of citrus characters. Lemon zest, with beautiful complexity and depth and a lingering silky finish.

WHITE BLENDS

2020 Cape Point Isliedh R1150

Cape Town (Platter ★★★★★) (94pts)

Pronounced (ai-lay). This Sauvignon Blanc/Semillon blend displays a silky, grippy finesse, combining lightness of texture with depth of flavour. Thrilling acidity and vibrant citrus fruit with creamy, broad macadamia and oatmeal from 16 months on the lees and barrel ferment. Made for ageing.

2018 Bizoe Henriëtte R525

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (89pts)

Judiciously oaked Semillon/Sauvignon Blanc blend. Wisps of orange peel on the palate, fresh tropical fruit aroma & a delicate aftertaste derived from being matured in oak barrels for 7 months. Limited edition of 2700 bottles.

VIOGNIER

These wines can be enjoyed with roast pork and crispy crackling.

2022 Lismore Age of Grace Viognier R625

Overberg (Platter ★★★★★) (91pts)

Beautiful perfume of honeysuckle & orange blossom, with a textured palate of apricot, kiwi & pineapple. A sensual & exotic experience, made by a woman, barrel-fermented & aged.

2022 Tamboerskloof (Kleynood) Viognier R495

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (95pts)

Frangipani, jasmine and citrus blossom flavours on the nose, which are well supported by apples, peaches and citrus on the palate.

GEWÜRZTRAMINER

Best served with traditional Malay-spiced Bobotie dish.

2019 Simonsig Gewürztraminer R235

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (86pts)

The first cellar to release a Gewürztraminer in South Africa, which is notoriously difficult to grow. Lush tropical fruit & rich spice aromas. Exotic tastes of litchi, Turkish delight & roses. Juicy, well-balanced sweetness with a clean, lingering aftertaste.

2022 Anthonij Rupert Terra del Capo Pinot Grigio R225

Franschhoek (Platter ★★★★★) (85 pts)

Bracingly fresh, with convincing green apple fruit, tingling acidity that is light and easy to drink.

RIESLING

Grilled Vegetable Quiche and Goats Cheese will compliment your Riesling well.

2017 Spioenkop Riesling R650

Elgin (Platter ★★★★★) (91 pts)

Dry Alsace style. Aromatics of grapefruit and lime, and the palate is 'tightly wound with punchy acidity and a very dry finish' or 'dense, pithy and wonderfully racy and pure'.

2022 Saurwine Chi Riesling R535

Elgin (Platter ★★★★★) (95 pts)

Chi means 'life force' and stands for Chiuta (an African rain god) Fragrant orange blossom, green melon, lime. Yellow stone fruits, honeysuckle and flint.

SEMILLON

Drakensberg Smoked Trout Crepes served with a Dill Dressing will do well with this wine.

2018 Shannon Semillon R475

Elgin (Platter ★★★★★) (93pts)

Naturally fermented Semillon, which is round on entry, then dense & concentrated in the middle. My absolute favourite white wine in the world!

ROUSSANNE

This white wine is so plucky that we are bold enough to recommend enjoying lamb with it!

2020 Painted Wolf Solo Roussanne R375

Swartland (Platter ★★★★★) (91 pts)

Bursting with stone fruit aromas, this is a wonderfully complex wine with a slight waxiness combined with vanilla and fresh minerality on the palate. Will age well.

COLOMBARD

Best enjoyed with Pork Sirloin Steaks and Apple Ginger Sauce

2024 Lowerland Vaalkameel Colombard R825

Douglas (Platter ★★★★★) (92 pts) (100% Organic)

Fresh, fruity, yet fully rounded with red apple skin aromas followed by stone fruit component and ginger spice on the nose with gentle, long & white peachy finish.

ROSÉ WINES

Long, lazy lunches on the verandah will go well with these Rosé wines

2025 Delaire Graff Cabernet Franc Rosé R425

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (87 pts)

Made from 100% Cabernet Franc, this unique dry rosé displays flavors of red berries & cream, satisfying balance of weight with pleasing dryness.

2024 Lowerland Tieroog Tannat Rosé R395

Prieska (Platter ★★★★★) (87 pts)

It is a fruity, full-bodied five-way blend of our red cultivars. A dance-off of fragrant spice and cool herbs on the nose, followed by lovely red fruits and hints of black tea on a lengthy palate. With the higher components of tannat and petit verdot balanced by merlot's juicy softness, this Bokooi delivers a perfect balance of intensity and drinkability.

2025 Dawn Patrol Cinsault Rosé R255

Swartland (Platter ★★★★★)

Ideal with our rich Lamb shank Potjiekos and baked vegetables with fresh mint sauce.

2021 Groot Constantia Shiraz R795

Cape Town (Platter ★★★★★) (91 pts)

The first wine estate was established at the Cape of Good Hope in 1685 by Simon van der Stel, governor of the Cape. On the nose it shows black pepper & subtle violet undertones. Palate is spicy & elegant.

2021 Robertson Constitution Road Shiraz R725

Robertson (Platter ★★★★★) (89 pts)

Only selected hand-picked grapes were used to produce an exclusive 50 barrels of this wine. Dark ripe blackberry with seductive fruit and black pepper.
Velvety palate.

2020 Hartenberg Shiraz R640

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (88 pts)

Deep black - red in colour and spicy, earthy notes on bouquet entry. Also, cloves, red and black berry fruit. The palate is rich, fruit-driven and has great balance. Fine, powdery tannins finish the wine.

2020 Schultz Family Pepper Street Solid Syrah R625

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★)

This Syrah exhibits beautiful aromas of dark berry, cherry and pepper with seamlessly integrated tannins and seductive hints of mocha, earth and spice adding to the complexity, which in turn follows through on the lengthy palate.

2021 Klein Goederust Shiraz R600

Franschhoek (Platter ★★★★★☆) (88 pts)

In 2019 the Siguqa family acquired this property and so began their own winemaking journey, inspired by their family matriarch Nomaroma Siguqa, a lifelong Cape wine farm labourer. This Syrah exhibits beautiful aromas of dark berry, cherry and pepper with seamlessly integrated tannins and seductive hints of mocha, earth and spice adding to the complexity, which in turn follows through on the lengthy palate.

2016 Bizoe Estelét Syrah R545

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★)

Gorgeous plum and blackberry fruit aromas and flavours are held together by lilting notes of violet, black tea and anise. The long, iron-tinged finish really sails on nicely, with well-integrated, mouthwatering acidity.

2023 Trizanne Signature Wines (TSW) Syrah R375

Swartland (Platter ★★★★★☆) (88 pts)

Beautifully ripe and fresh black and red fruits on the nose accompanied by some aromatic spice – black pepper and cardamom – with some dust and warm earth undertones. On the palate, the fruit is persistent and abundant framed by tug dry tannin.

PINOT NOIR

South African Pinot Noir tends to be of light or medium body with blackberry and currant aromas. Poultry dishes, cured cold meats and local Indezi cheeses will go well with any of these below.

2024 Tesselaarsdal Pinot Noir R1525

Walker Bay (Platter ★★★★★☆) (93 pts)

Berene Sauls grew up in a small village called Tesselaarsdal, situated 24 km Northeast of the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley, Hermanus, in the Overberg region.

Tesselaarsdal has a unique history: in 1810, Johannes Tesselaar bequeathed his farmland to his servants and slaves. She named her wine Tesselaarsdal to honour that legacy. Berene initially joined Hamilton Russell Vineyards as an au pair, aged 19. She soon moved to an administrative position on the estate, becoming involved in the export, labelling and warehousing of wines. Clean & lifted wild red fruit with cranberry & red plum aromas, hint of baking spices & cloves. Long gentle palate with savoury minerality & crystalline purity.

2022 Bouchard Finlayson Galpin Peak Pinot Noir R1200

Walker Bay (Platter ★★★★★) (92 pts)

Firm but deliciously elegant. Fragrant rich with exuberant fruit & long lasting palate profile.

2022 Crystallum Peter Max Pinot Noir R800

Walker Bay (Platter ★★★★★) (95 pts)

Reflects an excellent Cape vintage combining power, concentration and elegance.

The nose shows dark cherry, raspberry, strawberry, dark chocolate and sweet spice. The palate offers plenty of fruit and texture, while maintaining a wonderful vibrancy and freshness.

2024 Creation Estate Pinot Noir R775

Walker Bay (Platter ★★★★★) (90 pts)

Deep ruby colour with intensely fragrant bouquet shows mélange of red berry aromas, elegant vanilla and a whiff of wood spice. Superbly balanced.

2022 Cirrus Pinot Noir R765

Ceres Plateau (Platter ★★★★★) (94 pts)

Distinctive raspberry and strawberry aromas jump out of the glass, with layers of fennel and pepper. Light and refreshing, the red fruit brings juiciness to the palate, balanced by silky tannins. Notes of smoky cedar and a backbone of pepper spice, with a light, dry finish.

2020 Haute Cabrière Pinot Noir Reserve R595

Franschhoek (Platter ★★★★★) (90 pts)

Cherry fruit brushed with wet earth & leaves. Pleasing dryness & balanced acid. Aged for 11 months in specialised French oak barrels.

MERLOT

The sweetness of our Apricot and Macadamia nut stuffed Chicken Breasts served with Garlic, Sherry Citrus Sauce is a great accompaniment to these wines.

2017 Vergelegen Reserve Merlot R875

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (87 pts)

Ripe plum colour with a ruby rim. Heady aromas of nutty fruitcake, tobacco presage lush, powerful palate, with herbal hint & rather sullen strong tannins before a slightly sweet finish.

2021 Thelema Merlot R695

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (93 pts)

Bright fruit with choc-mocha notes & tobacco. Smooth, elegant & effortlessly enjoyable.

2018 Plasir de Merle Merlot R675

Paarl (Platter ★★★★★)

Perfumed violets, gentle mocha flesh with ripe red berry flavours supported by a hint of mint. Soft ripe tannins add to this impressive Merlot

2024 Peacock Wild Ferment Merlot R195

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (86 pts)

Distinctive notes of plums and red berries, with subtle earthy notes also adding to the complexity. An integrated acidity on the palate adding to the elegant and rounded tannins. It is perfect on its own or with a meal. I would recommend serving it slightly chilled, with a simple lamb chop on the braai or just enjoying it on its own.

PINOTAGE

A 1920's grape cross grafted between Pinot Noir and Cinsaut (Hermitage) gave us a true South African gem served best with true South African dishes, such as Bobotie, Ostrich or Oxtail casserole and hearty winter bean soups.

2021 Painted Wolf Guillermo Pinotage R700

Swartland (Platter ★★★★★) (88 pts)

Organically certified Pinotage grapes give rise to an intense, rich wine packed with flavours of ripe blueberry and mulberry, exotic spice and creamy vanilla with evident ripe tannins and a long lingering finish.

2021 Spioenkop 1900 Pinotage R600

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (92 pts)

This is a pleasantly rustic style of Pinotage with intense terroir flavours of graphite, and later violets, black olives, dark forest fruit and herbs. The palate is lean and with nice acidity with grippy tannins. A different style than the Spioenkop Pinotage.

2024 Survivor Pinotage R430

Swartland (Platter ★★★★★) (90 pts)

Sumptuously ripe & opulent. A rush of sweet bramble & mulberry, with weavings of cherry cordial & dark chocolate from oak barrelling for 18 months. A youthful wine ready to drink now, but can be cellared. Great with locally made boerewors grilled on the braai.

2024 Diemersfontein Pinotage R345

Wellington (Platter ★★★) (81 pts)

On the nose distinct coffee, rich dark chocolate and baked plums.
The ripe subtle tannins create a wine to be drunk very young.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

All of these Cabernets will slip down best with our home-bred Brahman Beef Fillet and rich, creamy Mushroom Sauce.

2017 Bartinney Cabernet R855

Stellenbosh (Platter ★★★★★) (93 pts)

Carbon neutral winery. True classic with upfront cassis, tobacco & pencil lead nuances on the nose, followed by rich plum & chocolate flavor on the palate.

2021 Springfield Whole Berry Cabernet Sauvignon R455

Robertson (Platter ★★★★★)

Harvested by hand, carried to the cellar in baskets, placed uncrushed into open tanks and left to ferment with natural yeasts into wine. Unfiltered with soft fresh palate.

2022 La Motte Cabernet R385

Helderberg (Platter ★★★★★) (88 pts)

Hand sorted grapes ensure that only the ripe tannins end in the bottle. Beautifully structured with complex, ripe blackcurrant flavours. Matured in French oak barrels for 15 months.

2020 Org de Rac Organic Cabernet R325

Swartland (Platter ★★★★★) (83 pts)

Distinctive aromas of tomato leaf, pencil shavings and mulberry beckon on the nose. A rich and well-rounded wine with sumptuous dark fruit flavours supported by velvety tannins.

MALBEC

Grilled lamb chops with garlic new potatoes go so well with these Malbecs.

2023 Anura Malbec R595

Paarl (Platter ★★★★★) (90 pts)

Bold, confident, shows rich black fruit, pot-pourri florals and creamy vanilla from 24 months in oak. Firm tannins and rich texture. A conversation stopper of note.

SANGIOVESE

Enjoy slightly chilled as an aperitif on a summer evening.

2023 Anthonij Rupert Terra Del Capo Sangiovese R295

Franschhoek (Platter ★★★★★) (86 pts)

Subtle whiffs of black & red fruit outlined by firm tannins.

Boasts sour cherry flavour, fresh tannin & acid bite.

TANNAT

Kudu fillet in a red wine reduction with thyme & rosemary potato au gratin or our solar-cooked lamb shank potjiekos will go beautifully with this wine.

2019 Lowerland Tolbos Tannat R855

Douglas (Platter ★★★★★) (92 pts) (100% Organic)

Perfume characters with the red and black berry aromas, followed by spicy notes that follow through to the plate with well-balanced soft tannins. Sweet fruit & some power, but good, dry finish. Aged for 10 months in old French oak.

ZINFANDEL / PRIMITIVO

The mouth waters at the thought of matching this with our Lamb Shank Potjiekos or Beef Fillet with Mushroom Sauce.

2019 Idiom Zinfandel (Primitivo) R750

Stellenbosh (Platter ★★★★★) (85 pts)

An explosively exotic wine. Aromas of fynbos and a fusion of sage, rosemary and mint entice the nose. Intense fruit with polished finish.

MOURVÈDRE

Enjoy this single varietal with Grilled pork knuckle & spicy chorizo.

2021 Beaumont Mourvèdre R995

Overberg (Platter ★★★★★) (93 pts)

Vivid fruit alongside a spice & herb array. Dark, thick-skinned berries resulting in powerful spicy & sometimes gamey aroma. Complex & involving.

NERO D'AVOLA

Bosman Nero is the first and only wine to be made from the Sicilian red grape Nero d'Avola in South Africa. So, it is perhaps the most unique of the Mediterranean varietals to be grown locally. This wine would go well with tomato-based dishes, such as our Tomato Soup starter.

2020 Bosman Nero D'Avola R850

Wellington (Platter ★★★★★) (89 pts)

Lovely fresh red berry aromas with hints of anise and maraschino. A generous palate, light body, with a luscious concentration of fruit, a good tannin structure and a lingering finish.

CINSAUT

This wine will go very well with roasted legs of lamb, Moroccan lamb, well-made Curry stews or Escargot.

2017 Naudé Old Vines Werfdans Cinsault R800

Darling (Platter ★★★★★) (92 pts)

Complex bouquet of floral and red fruit notes, such as rose petals, raspberries and cranberries. On the palate, it has a medium-bodied structure with moderate acidity and a soft tannin finish. It is a well-balanced wine, with a perfect harmony between fruit and earthy flavours.

2021 Darling Cellars Old Bush Vine Cinsaut R600

Darling (Platter ★★★★★) (94 pts)

An irresistible, well balanced red wine, with a bright ruby red colour and sour cherries, red cherries and candy floss on the nose. The fruity palate is delicious with earthiness and flavours of white pepper followed by a fresh acidity on the pallet. Grape tannins are very well supported by the oak tannins. The wine finishes with a long aftertaste. Bush vines older than 30 years.

GRENACHE NOIR

Best enjoyed on its own, slightly chilled with a selection of tapas from the kitchen

2019 Painted Wolf Lycaon Grenache R900

Wellington (Platter ★★★★★) (93 pts)

Red fruit, smoked meat and mixed spice abound. This is an expressive wine with good acidity, smooth tannins, and plenty of cranberries, sour cherries and a touch of liquorice on the palate. 85% Grenache and 15% Shiraz.

2022 Illimis Grenache Noir R725

Wellington (Platter ★★★★★) (94 pts)

Lighter style Grenache. Opulent berries, fresh herbs, confectioned red fruit and floral aromas followed by chalky tannins on the finish.

CABERNET FRANC

Try this with a portion of slow cooked duck & hoisin sauce.

2016 Warwick Cabernet Franc R1250

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (95 pts)

Rich, explosive core with soft, sweet blackcurrant fruit. For those that like your reds with a double helping of flavor & the softness of a velvet slipper.

TEMPRANILLO

Try this wine with slow cooked risotto, and a selection of artisan cheese & pates.

2022 Baleia Limitados Tempranillo R900

Duivenhoks (Platter ★★★★★)

A lush, dry Tempranillo that presents a harmonious blend of savory spices, dark fruits, and delicate undertones of dried figs in its aroma. The palate is treated to velvety tannins and the delightful essence of black currant flavors.

NEBBIOLO

Best enjoyed with our lunch charcuterie platter and homemade marinated olives.

2022 Abingdon Signature Nebbiolo R995

KwaZulu Natal Lions River

A ruby red color offers brooding earth tone aromas followed by bright fruit notes of cherry, pomegranate and plum, followed by spice notes of dried mint, caraway and anise. The palate is soft and rich with sweet, fine-grained tannins accompanied by lively acidity.

RED BLENDS

The classic pairings for this style of wine are red meats such as lamb and beef. That's because the tannins react with the protein in such meats to complement the flavour of both wine and meat alike. These blends will go exceptionally well with our rum-flavoured dark chocolate mousse.

2019 De Toren "Z" R1350

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★)

Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Petit Verdot play a supporting role in this exceptional blend with mocha choc and sinuous body. Rose petals, plum and blueberry on the nose. Soft firm tannins with delicate cinnamon notes.

2021 Bouchard Finlayson Hannibal R880

Walker Bay (Platter ★★★★★☆) (94 pts)

Sangiovese (39%) led blend with Pinot Noir (18%), Shiraz (18%) Nebbiolio (15%), Barbera (5%) and Mourvèdre (5%) Exotic toasted sesame aroma with black cherry compote, violets & Belgian chocolate spicing.

2021 Abingdon Resilience R875

Kwa Zulu Natal Lions River

The Prohibition is a blend of 48%Syrah, 41%Cabernet Sauvignon and 11%Petit Verdot. Picked during the covid pandemic during a hard lock down and complete alcohol ban. With no external team members allowed on the estate to assist, Jane, Ian and Laurie completed the harvest together as a family, just the three of them. The 'Resilience 2021' is a celebration of the ability to remain happy and hopeful in the face of difficulty.

2020 Spier Creative Block No. 5 R625

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★☆) (94 pts)

Creative Block is a collection of small, blank canvases that are transformed by established and emerging artists. Collectors buy one or a number of these, arranging and re-arranging them to create a larger artwork. Inspired by the winemakers selecting grapes from the various blocks of vineyards in the Cape and blending them together. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Malbec, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Subtle oak derived flavours of cinnamon and cloves.

2023 Hartenberg Doorkeeper Reserve Red R550

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★)

Medium to full-bodied fruit driven Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz blend. Smoky, plum aromas, accessible berry fruit with a plump grip.

2021 Warwick Three Cape Ladies R525

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★) (89 Pts)

Quintessential Cape Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (66%) Pinotage (22%) with a splash of Cabernet Franc (12%) Complex cherry and blackcurrant. Ripe, dark berry juiciness, smooth flesh with soft tannins. Dry with a little oak spice.

2020 Black Oystercatcher Triton R465

Agulhas (Platter ★★★★★)

As the name refers to a striking black bird that thrives on the coast, the pioneers of this vineyard established the first vines in this maritime ward of Elim. The sea breeze caresses the grapes constantly allowing them to open gradually, which results in an intense fruit flavour. Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz and Merlot blend with smoky sweet, soft tannins complimented by plump mouthfeel and a long finish.

2023 Reyneke Organic Red R375

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★☆) (93 pts)

The fruit is rich and pure, but it has an old-world feel in its savoury, meaty complexity and long, dry finish. Shiraz (98%) with Cabernet Sauvignon (2%)

DESSERT WINES

2018 Thelema "Vin de Hel" Muscat Late Harvest R225

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★)

A golden dessert wine with very typical Muscat characters on the nose. The wine shows upfront aromas of pineapple, citrus, apricots, a touch of honey and subtle floral notes. The palate is lush with the perfect balance between sweetness & fresh acidity.

2021 Paul Cluver Riesling Noble Late Harvest R220

Elgin (Platter ★★★★★)

Packed with dry apricot, spice and honey character on the nose, with superb balance on the mouth. Excellent with Apple Tarte Tatin.

2020 Jordan Riesling Mellifera R185

Stellenbosch (Platter ★★★★★)

Named after the Cape Honeybee, *Apis mellifera* Capensis, and inspired by the owners' son's unfortunate experience with them during the sweet wine's first press cycle. This Natural Sweet wine is only made in years when botrytis, or a small amount thereof, is found on the grapes.

2010 Bizoe Tiny Semillon Noble Late Harvest R165

Somerset West (Platter ★★★★★)

Distinguishable honey aroma to this Straw Wine that follows through to the pallet with a pleasant fruity and floral aftertaste.

2019 Nitida "Modjadji" Noble Late Harvest R145

Stellenbosch

Semillon derived from dark chocolate, candied orange peels, rounding off to hints of freshly picked forest truffles.

Rogue Fynbos Spirit Aperitif R60

Western Cape

Features a warm, spicy flavor profile with wood notes and a lingering sweetness, celebrating the Cape Floral Kingdom. Can be enjoyed neat, served over ice

Rivertown 'RUIN' Spirit Aperitif R60

Western Cape

A mix of (RU)m and g(IN). A unique Spirit Aperitif consisting of a blend of spicy gin and a touch of dark rum. An aromatic gin with a strong spice component with the added influence and colour of oak matured dark rum.

The gin component makes up the majority of the Spirit Aperitif and is based on the vapour infusion of 15 botanicals including Juniper Berry, Angelica Root, Orris Root, Sarsaparilla Root, Coriander, Cardamom, Sweet Orange Peel, Orange Blossom, Vanilla, Cloves, Cinnamon, Black Pepper Corns, Star Anise, Nutmeg and Ginger. Gin Verdant is floral and soft with a translucent golden-green hue. Delicate aromas reminiscent of elderflower and chamomile, lead to summer blooms, a touch of spice, subtle juniper, waxy lemon rind and alluring liquorice on the palate. Serve with cinnamon stick & slice of raw ginger.

Gin Amber is a rich and aromatic, amber coloured gin with fresh citrus, slight juniper, sweet toffee apples and delicate floral notes which intertwine to deliver a dry, woody finish. Serve with pink peppercorns, strawberries & orange zest.

6 Dogs Blue R50

Hex River Valley

This distillery started in a shed, housing 6 dogs & an old copper geyser converted into a still. The Blue variety contains Clitoris Ternatea (Blue Pea Flower), an antioxidant & aphrodisiac in traditional medicine.

Musgrave Pink R50

Cape Town

Maurice Boon Musgrave, grandfather of founder Simone Musgrave, left Plymouth in 1949 bound for Africa to start a new life exploring and discovering the people and land of Africa. Three months on a ship with a small baby, a measles outbreak and many a day of seasickness and the adventure that would change the shape of his family had begun. From then onward an African family would take on the adventure Maurice had started. The spirit of endeavour, adventure and courage lives on in granddaughter, Simone, guardian of Maurice's passion for the unusual. This is an artisan gin celebrated for its top notes of Cardamom, African Ginger and Grains of Paradise. Musgrave pink celebrates the flower of love and beauty with the source of the rose, rosehip, which complement Musgrave's spicy nature. It is then infused with rose water for its timeless perfume and romance.

Clemengold R50

Cape Town

The sweet and sun-ripened essence of ClemenGold, SA's leading mandarin, now treats gin aficionados to a classic Cape Dry style gin with subtle hints of citrus. Nine botanicals - with sundried ClemenGold peels taking the flavour lead - are used when distilling this superb gin in the heart of Cape Town. ClemenGold and orange peel, cinnamon, honey, ground almond, juniper berries, angelica and orris root, and coriander are macerated and vapour-infused. Serve with fresh thyme & orange peel.

031 D'Urban Scarlet & Dry R50

Durban

The world's first gin made with cascara (coffee cherries). This exciting gin is crafted in small batches using cascara sourced from Beaver Creek Coffee Estate on the KZN South Coast. Cascara is the red, fleshy covering around the coffee bean, and adds subtle berry notes to the gin without being overpowering.

Pienaar & Sons Empire R50

Cape Town

Situated a stones' throw from Parliament, this distillery has used newly, hand built, locally produced engineering principles to distill their special spirit. Made from South African maize, this gin shows fresh hints of citrus, pine notes of juniper & Angelica root. Serve with a dash of honey & star aniseed.

Triple 3 African Botanicals R50

Stellenbosch

It blends traditional juniper with seven indigenous botanicals—most notably rooibos and buchu—delivering a distinct Cape fynbos character.

Cape Town Rooibos Red R50

Cape Town

To make Cape Town Rooibos Red Gin, rooibos is added to the original gin's concentrate. It is left to stew for three hours (no longer, as rather than a warm amber, the colour goes all sorts of haywire) before being cut further with neutral spirit and brought back to bottling strength. To taste, there is a smoky tea flavour that whips its way around the tongue, holding all of the other botanicals in the gin hostage. The spice, though, is light and bright - catching in the back of the throat and burning all the way down. The tea infusion is to the star anise what E-numbers are to a five-year-old. The spice runs around like a lunatic, loud and fast, dizzy and silly. Serve with rosemary or cucumber.

Geometric R50

Riebeek-Kasteel

Geometric Gin is distilled from neutral spirits and fine grape spirit, resulting in a textured, silk-like gin. Fresh juniper is underpinned by citrus and cardamom, followed by heathery fynbos, our post-modern definition of Classic Cape Dry Gin. Serve with cardamom pods.

Flowstone Marula R50

Cradle of Humankind

Marula, the iconic fruit of Africa, has been enjoyed by man and elephants alike over the millennia. These majestic Bushveld trees produce an abundance of fruits in the African mid-summer months of January and February. The antics of elephants that have overindulged in fallen fermenting Marulas are legendary. (but

not necessarily true!) Clear tangy edge with a rich, almost citrus flavour of the Marula fruit. Serve with a slice of lime & a sprinkling of Acacia blossoms.

Sugarbird Pino & Pelargonium R50

Cape Town

A floral gin inspired by the resurgence of traditional gin, their hope is to share a distinctively Cape Town made, crafted product with the world. Mastered with indigenous ingredients and creativity growing at the heart of the gin movement in South Africa. The rich punch of colour from the Pinotage grape skins partnered with the fragrant floral flavours from Pelargonium set this rosy refreshment apart.

De Vry Rooinek Cherry R50

Free State

Eight botanicals are infused with vapour to deliver a crisp dry gin with lingering citrus, pepper and floral notes. Die Droë Rooinek Dry Gin owes its unmistakable taste to a combination of juniper, coriander, angelica, chamomile, khaki bos, pink peppercorn, lemon and orange. Cherry variety is made from handpicked and gently crushed cherries, which are then macerated in the dry gin before being filtered and bottled. Die Soet Rooinek Cherry Gin bursts with the flavour of ripe fruits, almonds and spices. Both spirits made from sorghum base.

Cape Fynbos R50

Cape Town

Quadruple distilled from the finest white grape spirits in small batches. This is then infused with premium juniper berries and elements from 33 indigenous botanicals, sustainably hand harvested for their bark, roots, berries, flowers, stems, peels or leaves. Most of these botanicals are members of the fynbos group of plants for which the region is world famous. Deep and complex herbal aromas with hints of orange essence, cloves and white pepper, honey and wild Fynbos all overlaying a perfectly smooth palate make this into a gin to treasure.

Die Mas R50

Kalahari

Kakamas boasts unique climatic conditions, where the waters of the powerful Orange River & the clear African skies bring to life the rich soil of this semi-desert region. Grapes grown & picked here are distilled to form a gin with rounded notes of juniper, delicate spiciness from traditional botanicals & a welcoming lemon & citrus finish.

Mothers Ruin R50
