



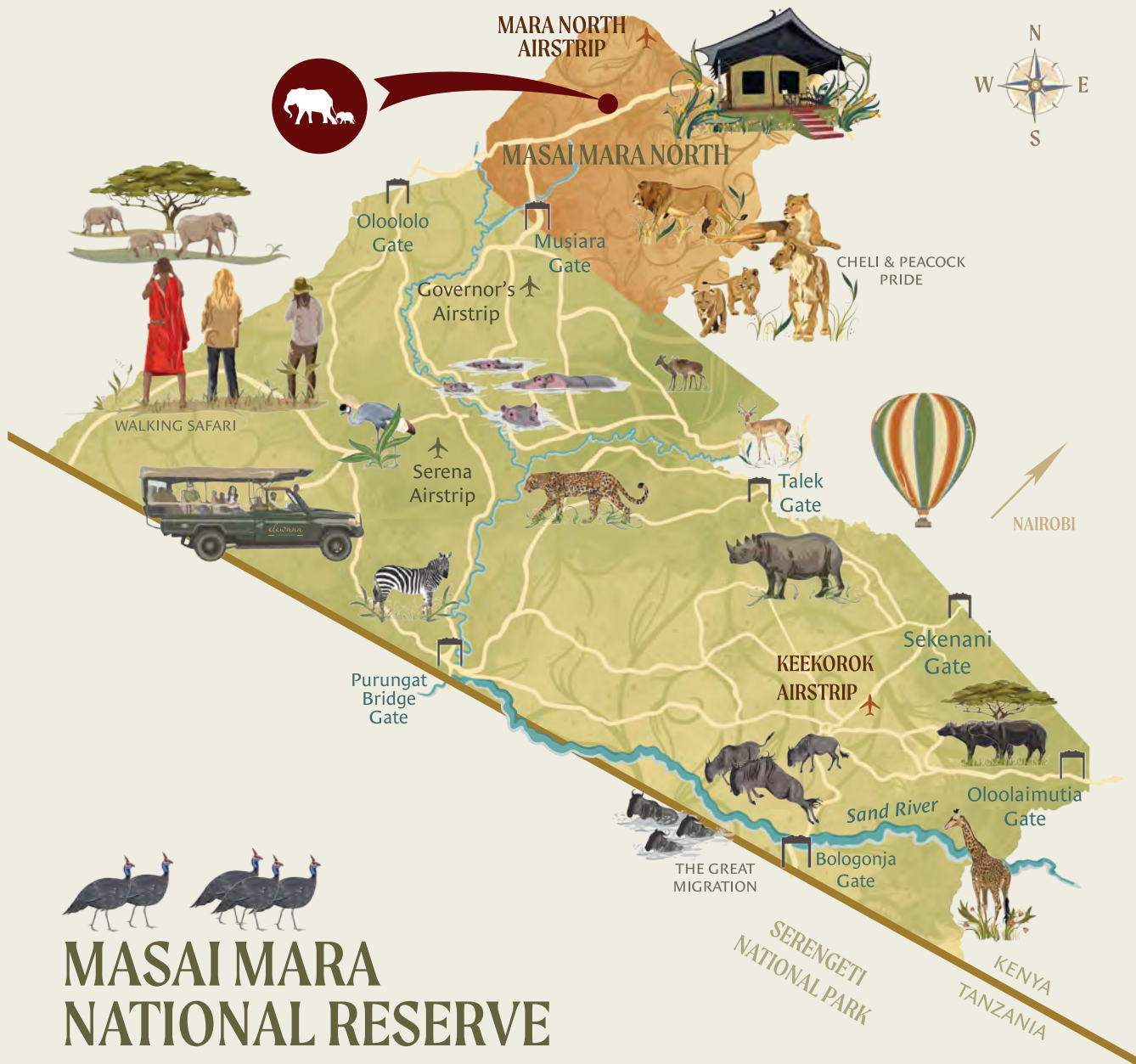

Private Mara North Conservancy

Situated within a premier private concession, the property offers exclusive access to the core of the Masai Mara ecosystem. Strictly controlled vehicle access ensures uncrowded game drives and privileged wildlife tracking throughout Leopard Gorge, the iconic territory made famous by the BBC's *Big Cat Diary*.

Interactive Youth Nature Programmes

The camp provides an exceptional environment for multi-generational families, encouraging younger travellers to unplug and engage directly with the wild. From afternoon lawn games to wildlife tracking and traditional Maasai archery, children enjoy a classic, educational, and active bush experience.

Prime Great Migration Integration

Secluded from high-density tourist traffic, the camp provides seamless access to the region's legendary wildlife spectacles. Full-day game drives with gourmet picnic lunches position guests to witness the dramatic river crossings in the main reserve.

The tents at Elephant Pepper are a masterful tribute to the traditional safari aesthetic, meticulously designed to offer privacy and rustic charm without compromising on modern luxury. Each expansive tent is beautifully appointed with hand-crafted furniture and private verandas that open out onto the surrounding wilderness. It is a refined sanctuary where the elegance of the interior design perfectly complements the wild, unscripted beauty of the Mara North Conservancy.

4 doubles and 4 twin tents (all tents can be made into doubles or twins and can each fit one extra bed)
- ♦ 2 Safari Suites (100.0m²)
Spacious en suite tents, which can comfortably fit two extra beds

The tents are thoughtfully spaced within the lush thicket to provide a sense of absolute seclusion, offering a peaceful vantage point to observe the wildlife that frequently wanders through the camp. Whether resting in the afternoon or drifting off to the sounds of the night, every tent provides an immersive and comfortable connection to the heart of the African bush.

Elephant Pepper Camp is an intimate sanctuary of soulful elegance, nestled like a secluded haven within the vibrant heart of the Mara North Conservancy. It is a place where the timeless spirit of the "Out of Africa" era meets the raw drama of the savanna, offering a peaceful vantage point over a landscape defined by ancestral traditions and world-class wildlife conservation

Walking Safaris

Mara at sunrise, taking in breathtaking aerial views before landing for a classic champagne bush breakfast.

Savour beautifully packed gourmet breakfasts and lunches out in the field, allowing for uninterrupted full-day safari adventures across the vast Masai Mara wilderness.

Night Game Drives

Spot elusive nocturnal species on a spot-lit evening drive, watching the African savannah transform into a fascinating world of nocturnal activity under the stars.
