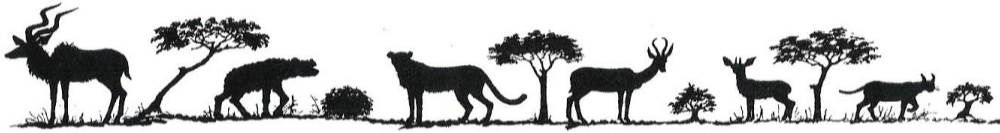


Magari Safari Lodge - Fact Sheet



INTRODUCTION

Magari is a beautiful boutique safari lodge situated within the private Jembisa Game Reserve in the heart of the Waterberg wilderness. Set in a spectacular position with breath-taking views above a sweeping bend of the Palala River over savanna and woodland to a backdrop of hills. Guests experience a safari for the soul, enjoying the relaxation, health and well-being benefits of this remarkable, unique bush villa.

LODGE ACCOMMODATION AND FACILITIES:

Sleeping up to 10 guests in 5 rooms, Magari is available on an exclusive, private use basis or non-exclusive, sharing basis. Three of the rooms have outdoor decks with views of the valley and hills, two have outdoor showers from which the incredible view can be admired, and three are garden rooms. Wi-Fi is available in all the rooms.

The main lodge at Magari is beautifully appointed and has a boma in which to enjoy sitting around a campfire in the evening, a sunbathing terrace and a swimming pool with spectacular views.

CHILDREN AT MAGARI:

Children over the age of 6 are welcome at Magari and can enjoy exciting safari activities on the reserve.

WEDDINGS & CONFERENCES:

The spectacular position and views from Magari lend itself perfectly as a romantic safari wedding venue. Each wedding is crafted individually in consultation with the bridal couple. The wedding ceremony and celebration can be conducted anywhere around the lodge and on the reserve.

ACTIVITIES:

There are a wide range of activities to suit all ages and interests, including day and night game drives, guided bush walks, wildlife camera trap setting, bird watching, camp outs under the stars, Junior Ranger programmes, swimming, fly-fishing, visits to Bushman painting and Iron Age sites on the reserve and massage treatments for those looking for more relaxation. Many guests enjoy the opportunity to keep fit here, including the freedom to go running on the reserve, mountain biking and hiking. We also offer some interesting activities nearby such as safari horseback riding, Big 5 game drives, safari golf, shopping at African curio art shops, adventurous zip lining and cultural tours (subject to availability and additional costs).

WILDLIFE:

The landscape provides a wide variety of habitats, resulting in a high diversity of animal and plant species. The reserve offers 69 animal species and over 400 bird species. Night drives are a favourite where guests can search for the more elusive nocturnal animals such as bush babies, porcupines, aardvark, caracal, leopard and brown hyena.

MEALS & DIETARY REQUIREMENTS:

All meals are freshly prepared by our chef who makes use of fresh, local and seasonal ingredients, many from the lodge vegetable garden. We will gladly cater for any special dietary requirements and offer a variety of exciting dining venues both at the lodge and in the bush. Special occasions can be celebrated in style.

Magari is easily accessible by road. From Johannesburg airport it is a 3 ½ hour road transfer. Transfers can be arranged.

**RATES INCLUDE:**

Rates include exclusive or non-exclusive use of the lodge, all meals, selected alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, game drives and bush walks, sundowners, camp outs, all activities on the game reserve, laundry service and VAT/taxes.

RATES EXCLUDE:

Rates exclude road transfers to and from Magari, additional local excursions, transport to and from local excursions, curios, massages, and telephone calls.

HEALTH:

Magari is located in a malaria free reserve. There are doctors, a paediatrician, and a pharmacist in our local town of Vaalwater which is 40 minutes' drive away. We recommend that you seek general medical advice from your doctor prior to travel and have full medical insurance cover while travelling.

Our staff follow strict health and safety protocols including the washing of hands and regular use of the hand sanitiser provided for staff and guests, lodge cleansing, hygiene education and local government protocols. While we cannot guarantee that any guest will not contract an illness or have an accident while at Jembisa Private Game reserve, we make every effort to ensure that this does not occur.

PAYMENT & CANCELLATION POLICY:

A 25% non-refundable deposit is required to secure the reservation.

Full and final payment is required 60 days prior to arrival.

61-120 days prior to arrival 25% cancellation fee

31-60 days prior to arrival 50% cancellation fee

0-30 days prior to arrival 100% cancellation fee

*All cancellations must be received in writing.

INSURANCE:

We highly recommend that all guests take out comprehensive travel insurance including full medical cover, as well as cancellation and curtailment cover. All guests are required to sign an indemnity form against loss, harm or illness on arrival, the details of which can be made available on request.
