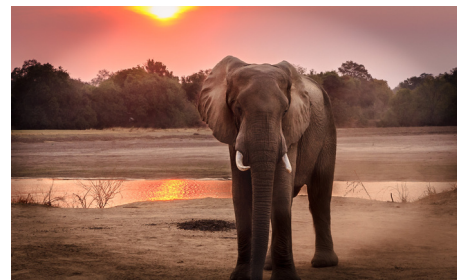


MANYELETI SAFARI

Big 5

The Manyeleti Game reserve is a 23,000-hectare game reserve which borders the Kruger National Park. There are no fences between the Kruger and the Manyeleti so the game can roam freely, however, the volumes of people are significantly less here so you can enjoy a quieter game viewing experience. Morning Manyeleti drives depart at 5am and return around 10am in time for breakfast at the lodge, Afternoon Manyeleti drives depart at 2pm return you to the lodge in time for dinner. Don't forget your binoculars!

The Panorama route is home to the Blyde River canyon which is the third largest canyon in the world. After collection at Kingfisher Creek your tour begins at the spectacular 3 Rondawels, overlooking the canyon and from there, you slowly work your way along the various scenic beauty sights that encompass the Panorama route.

For those seeking adventure an additional stop can be requested in Graskop Gorge (ADDITIONAL COST) to experience The Viewing Lift & Forest Walk, The Big Swing, The Zipline or the suspension bridge.

QUAD BIKE SAFARI

Join us for a 1.5hr Quad bike trail at Buffaloland, a Big 3 reserve. The track will take you through various landscapes with amazing views of the local plains and wildlife. Animals that can be observed on this journey include Buffalo, Leopards, Lions, Giraffes, Kudu, Wildebeest, Ostriches, Baboons, and an abundance of birdlife. Drivers need to be 16 yrs + for this trail. Passengers welcome up to 16 years. Closed on Mondays & Tuesday's except public holidays.

BLYDE CANYON BOAT CRUISE

Blyde Canyon Safaris, offer scenic boat trips on the Blyde Dam. 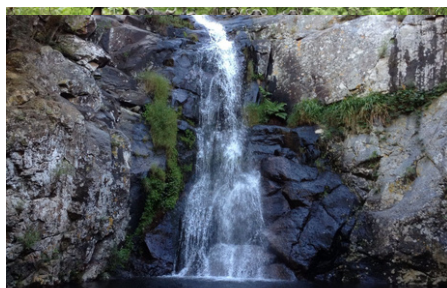


BLYDE CANYON COMBO EXPERIENCE

HOT AIR BALLOONING

Experience the magic of lighter-than-air flight near the foot of the Drakensberg Escarpment. We will meet you about 45 minutes before sunrise. Tea & coffee will be served while you watch the balloons being inflated. The flight will be approximately 1 hour in duration. The terrain is a mixture of farmland and riverine forest. The mountains provide a scenic backdrop and shelter from the prevailing winds.

HELICOPTER FLIGHT

Choose from a Blyde Canyon Flight or Greater Kruger Wildlife & Scenic Flight.

The Blyde River Canyon is one of the most spectacular scenic flight destinations in South Africa. Helicopter flights provide unmatched views of the canyon, cliffs, rivers and surrounding landscapes. The Robinson R44 allows safe access to areas of the canyon that cannot be seen from the ground.

Scenic helicopter flights across the Greater Kruger National Park region provide the opportunity to view wildlife areas from above. This aerial perspective offers a unique view of the terrain, vegetation and wildlife habitats

With Gerry's conservation background, flights are conducted safely and with full awareness of wildlife and conservation sensitivities.

SCENIC FLIGHT

Choose from a 30-minute game viewing flight on a Bantam and feel the wind in your hair or feel as free as a bird in a Jabiru and take a 30-minute flight over the Blyde River Canyon or 60min game viewing flight. Flights are operated in the mornings from Hoedspruit Civil airport in town and the maximum weight limit is 100kg for the Bantam and 120kg for the Jabiru . Flights are operated with 1 pilot and 1 passenger.

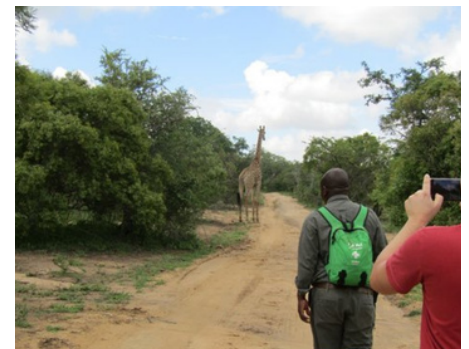
BIG 5 - GUIDED BUSH WALK

COURSE INFO

Duration: 3 hours

Appropriate for children aged 6 – 15 years.

Our junior ranger course is an interactive and practical course, suitable for children from 6 upwards. The course lasts approximately 3 hours and is led by experienced field guides.

It is an exciting and fun introduction to understanding the South African bush. **Topics covered include:**

ANIMAL TRACKING

We will take a short walk into the bush, identifying and following animal tracks.

ANIMAL IDENTIFICATION

Looking into the famous 'Big 5' and the many species of plains game and birds found on Guernsey Nature Reserve.

ANIMAL BEHAVIOUR

Learning how animals communicate and interact with one another as well as observing animals safely.

ANIMAL CALLS

Africa's birds and animals have some of the world's most distinctive calls. While out on our bush walk we will try to identify a few of these.

DUNG IDENTIFICATION

Investigate various types of animal dung discovering what the animal eats and find out which animal it belongs to.

INSECTS

Observe species such as termites, butterflies and some of the 'Small 5' such as the 'Ant lion' and 'Rhinoceros beetle'.

TREES AND PLANTS

Have you ever made your own toilet paper or toothbrush from a tree? Join us on the course to find out how!

BUSH NAVIGATION

How to find your way in the bush using the sun and natural indicators.

SMALL SURVIVAL SKILLS

How to find water and food in the bush as well as 'bush medicine'.
