Snorkel for Conservation

Snorkeling takes place in our Marine Protected Area, a thriving ecosystem home to vibrant coral reefs and diverse marine life.

Join our 7 AM guided snorkel, led by experienced guides who will help you spot fascinating underwater creatures and share insights about the reef. All proceeds from this experience go directly toward protecting and preserving this delicate marine habitat.

Ngalawa Sunset Cruise

Set sail in a traditional Ngalawa with a local fisherman, gliding over the reefs as the sun sets. Enjoy the ride and a bottle of bubbly.

Ngalawas are hand-carved from a single mango tree trunk, with outriggers added for balance. Built using age-old techniques, they are the fishing boats of Pemba's coastline.

The Sandbank

A surreal experience—just you, pure white sand, and endless ocean. At low tide, this hidden gem appears, offering a private escape in the middle of the sea. The trip depends on tides, currents, and weather, so check with your service fundi. A cooler box with fruit and drinks is included. The boat ride takes about 15 minutes.

Spice Farm & Rainforest Tour

Discover why Zanzibar is called the "Spice Islands" with a visit to a local spice farm, where you'll experience the rich aromas and flavors of Pemba's famous cloves.

Then, take a guided 45-minute walk through the Ngezi Rainforest, a protected reserve home to endemic birds, vervet and black colobus monkeys, and diverse plant life. Your forest ranger will highlight the unique flora and fauna along the way.



Located at the northern tip of the island, the lighthouse offers incredible panoramic views of Pemba.

Just a 20-minute walk from Manta, your service fundi will accompany you. There's no charge, except for a \$5 entrance fee if you choose to climb the lighthouse and take a tour with the operator, who proudly shares his knowledge in nine languages, continuing a family tradition passed down for generations.
