LOCAL ACTIVITIES

From ocean breezes to mountain views, Kommetjie offers a blend of tranquillity and adventure few places can match. Whether you're in the mood to explore, unwind, or indulge, there's something special waiting just beyond your door.

- Walk to The Kom & Lighthouse – Step right onto the sand from the hotel and take a scenic stroll along the beach to The Kom, a sheltered tidal pool and natural harbour beloved by locals. Continue a little further to the historic Slangkop Lighthouse—South Africa's tallest cast-iron lighthouse—for panoramic ocean views and picture-perfect sunsets.
- Kommetjie Coastal Hiking Trail – A breathtaking trail hugging the shoreline, where fynbos meets sea spray. Ideal for early morning or late afternoon walks, with frequent sightings of sea birds, dassies, and whales in season.
- Imhoff Farm – A charming local treasure offering horse rides on the beach, camel rides for children, boutique shopping, artisanal food stalls, and family-friendly attractions including a reptile park and petting farm.
- Cape Point Vineyards (Noordhoek) – Perched high on the slopes of Chapman's Peak, this estate pairs world-class wines with ocean views. Enjoy a tasting, a picnic on the lawns, or visit during their Thursday evening market for live music and sunset dining.
- Simon's Town Naval Museum – Discover the history of South Africa's Navy in this beautifully preserved museum overlooking False Bay. An insightful visit for maritime enthusiasts and families alike.
- Noordhoek Farm Village – A local gem offering farm-to-table restaurants, artisan bakeries, boutique stores, and live music. Perfect for a leisurely afternoon of food and browsing.

The Big Ones

- Shark Cage Diving (Simon's Town) – Experience the thrill of meeting a variety of sharks up close in their natural habitat. Reputable operators ensure safety and conservation-focused encounters that are both exhilarating and educational.
- Cape Point Nature Reserve – A scenic drive through the Cape Peninsula's most dramatic landscapes. Walk to the lighthouse, explore cliffside trails, and witness the meeting of two oceans surrounded by untamed beauty.
- Boulders Beach Penguins (Simon's Town) – Visit the famous colony of endangered African Penguins. A network of board walks offers excellent viewing while protecting their habitat.
- Chapman's Peak Drive – This world-renowned scenic drive connects Noordhoek to Hout Bay, offering sweeping ocean views, picnic spots, and endless photo opportunities.

BEST TIME TO VISIT LONG BEACH

Kommetjie has something to offer all year round. Peak season is during the summer months from November until April when temperatures can reach 30°C/86°F or more.

During the winter months, temperatures drop to an average of 18°C/64°F, offering you the opportunity to enjoy crackling fireplaces, red wine, and the many festivals hosted in the valley.
