RECOMMENDED ROUTE TO &BEYOND NGALA SAFARI LODGE

FROM JOHANNESBURG TO NGALA SAFARI LODGE

- Take the N12/N4 through eMalahleni (Witbank), then later left onto the R540 to eMakhazeni (Belfast) opposite the Engen fuel station.
- In eMakhazeni (Belfast), turn right towards Dullstroom and Mashishing (Lydenburg).
- In Mashishing (Lydenburg) look out for the information boards directing you to the R36 to Ohrigstad.
- Follow the signs to R36 Ohrigstad, Hoedspruit or Tzaneen. It is marked 47 km to Ohrigstad as you leave Mashishing. Stay on the R36. Pass through Ohrigstad, later over the beautiful Abel Erasmus Pass through the JG Strydom tunnel, following the signs to Hoedspruit.
- Once you have passed the Tzaneen turn-off but before Hoedspruit, turn right onto the R531 to Klaserie/Acornhoek/Orpen. Travel approximately 30 km to reach the R40.
- You will pass under a railway bridge and join the R40. A few kilometres after this, turn left at the Orpen sign. Take this road for about 40 km.
- You will reach a boomed gate at the entrance to the Kruger National Park. If asked, inform the guards that you are going to Ngala Safari Lodge – there is no vehicle entrance fee.
- Conservation fees do apply for the national park and should have been prepaid to the lodge. The exact fee can be confirmed at the time of reservation.
- Continue straight along the tar road until the road splits into a ‘V’ - there is a sign pointing to the left that says “*Ngala Tented Camp*”. Take this dirt road, keep right until you see Ngala Tented Camp in front of you and there will be a sign pointing to the right saying “*Ngala Safari Lodge*”.
- You will cross the Timbavati River over a cement crossing. After the crossing, keep left at the “*Ngala Safari Lodge*” sign.
- Follow the road for about 7.8 km through a series of small dips until you reach a large four-way crossing with a sign for “*Ngala Safari Lodge*” as well as a large radio tower on your right-hand side, continue straight for about 5.5 km.
- You will see a sign that says “*Ngala Safari Lodge*” pointing right.
- Go right here and follow the signs all the way to reception.

FROM NELSPRUIT TO NGALA SAFARI LODGE

- Take the R40 towards White River.
- Pass through White River and continue to Hazyview, past Bushbuckridge and on to Acornhoek. At the traffic lights in Acornhoek, go straight towards Klaserie. A few kilometres further along the R40, take the right turn at the sign marked Orpen. Follow this road for about 40 km.
- You will reach a boomed gate at the entrance to the Kruger National Park. If asked, inform the guards that you are going to Ngala Safari Lodge – there is no vehicle entrance fee.
- Conservation fees do apply for the national park and should have been prepaid to the lodge. The exact fee can be confirmed at the time of reservation.
- Continue straight along the tar road until the road splits into a ‘V’ - there is a sign pointing to the left that says “*Ngala Tented Camp*”. Take this dirt road, keep right until you see Ngala Tented Camp in front of you and there will be a sign pointing to the right saying “*Ngala Safari Lodge*”.
- You will cross the Timbavati River over a cement crossing. After the crossing, keep left at the “*Ngala Safari Lodge*” sign.
- Follow the road for about 7.8 km through a series of small dips until you reach a large four-way crossing with a sign for “*Ngala Safari Lodge*” as well as a large radio tower on your right-hand side, continue straight for about 5.5 km.

FROM HOEDSPRUIT AIRPORT TO NGALA SAFARI LODGE

- Exit the Hoedspruit Airport (Eastgate Airport) and turn right onto Argyle Road towards the R40. At the T-junction, turn left on the R40 (Klaserie Road) and carry on straight till you get to the next T-junction.
- At this T-Junction you will turn left again (remaining on the R40). About 2 km after this left turn you will see a sign marked Orpen.
- Turn left at this sign and then follow this road for about 40 km.
- You will reach a boomed gate at the entrance to the Kruger National Park. If asked, inform the guards that you are going to Ngala Safari Lodge – there is no vehicle entrance fee.
- Conservation fees do apply for the national park and should have been prepaid to the lodge. The exact fee can be confirmed at the time of reservation.
- Continue straight along the tar road until the road splits into a ‘V’ - there is a sign pointing to the left that says “*Ngala Tented Camp*”. Take this dirt road, keep right until you see Ngala Tented Camp in front of you and there will be a sign pointing to the right saying “*Ngala Safari Lodge*”.
- You will cross the Timbavati River over a cement crossing. After the crossing, keep left at the “*Ngala Safari Lodge*” sign.

• Nelspruit/Ngala	190 km /3 – 3.5 hours
• Hoedspruit/Ngala	86 km – 2 hours

PLEASE NOTE:

&Beyond Ngala Safari Lodge is accessed through the Orpen Gate of Kruger National Park.

If you are using a GPS, please enter Orpen Gate as your destination – not Ngala Tented Camp.
We recommend using GPS only on main roads. GPS maps rarely include dirt roads, so please follow the directions provided to reach the lodge.

The GPS co-ordinates for the Orpen Road turn off from the R40 are S24°33'17.50"; E31°02'18.00"
The GPS co-ordinates for the Ngala Tented Camp gate are S24°29'03.67"; E31°23'08.27"
Should you require assistance, kindly call the lodge on +27 87 655 1416/7 or alternatively Ngala Tented Camp on +27 10 040 8072.

Please note, South Africa’s vast road network is one of the largest and most interconnected in the sub-Saharan region, meaning roads are well-used and extremely busy. When travelling to &Beyond Ngala Private Game Reserve, please drive with caution and be aware of other motorists and trucks on the road, as well as poor road conditions and pothole deterioration in some areas. Please allow for additional travel time to the reserve and remember to take regular pit stops.

Avoid travelling after dark and be aware of the Orpen Gate closing times.

Once you pass through the national park boomed gate, you enter a Big Five wilderness area where wildlife moves freely. For your safety, please remain inside your vehicle at all times and obey the posted speed limits.

We recommend calling Ngala Safari Lodge as you pass through the Orpen Gate so we can prepare for your arrival and assist promptly should you experience any vehicle issues. Please note that mobile signal inside the reserve is limited.

Wherever possible and available, we do provide covered parking for guest vehicles. However, please be advised that we cannot be held responsible for theft, loss or damage while vehicles are parked on our premises.

As you will be entering reserves with wild animals, and driving over gravel roads, &Beyond recommends you take appropriate vehicle insurance cover and consider excess-waiver cover.
