



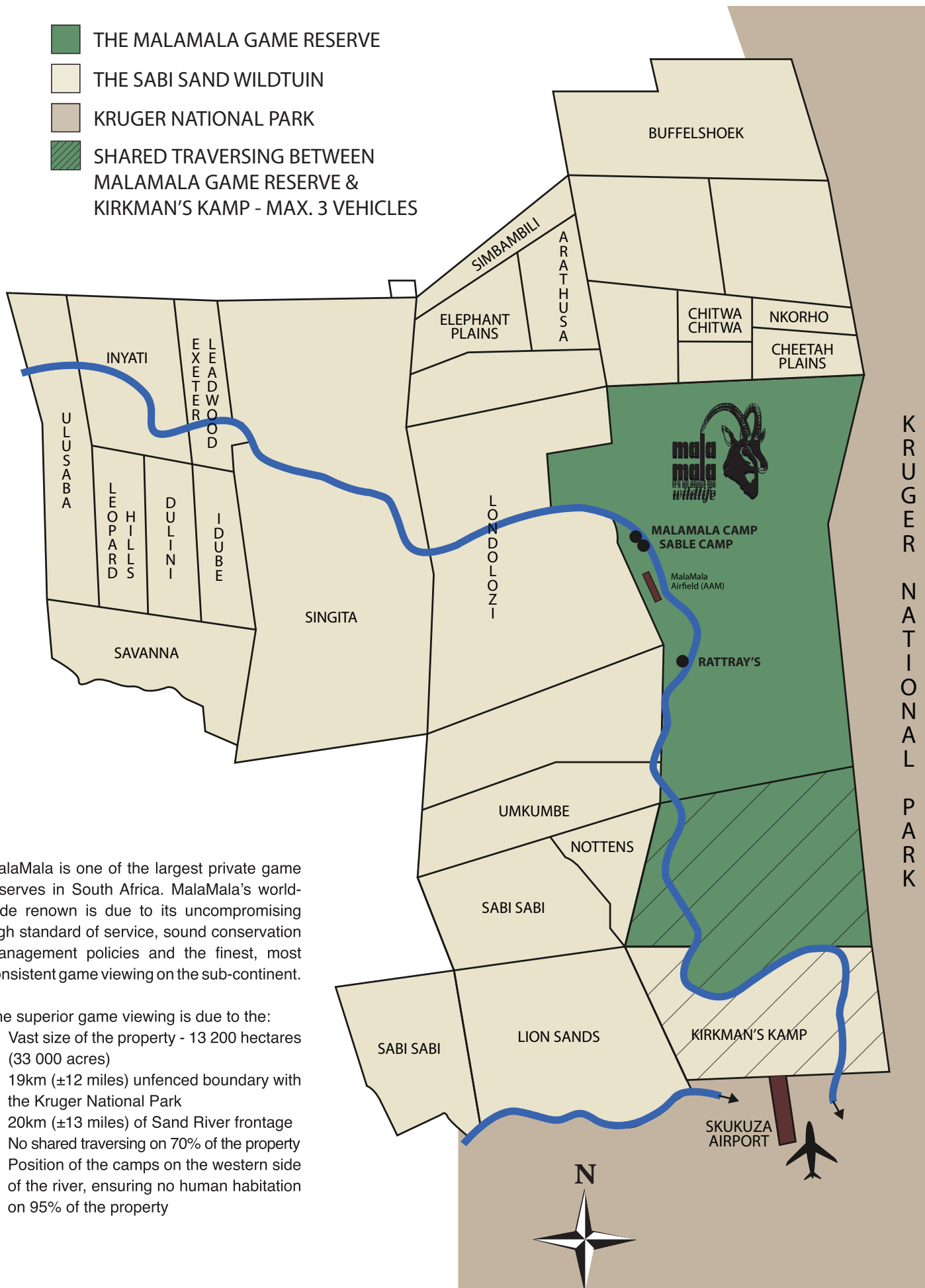

MalaMala is one of the largest private game reserves in South Africa. MalaMala's worldwide renown is due to its uncompromising high standard of service, sound conservation management policies and the finest, most consistent game viewing on the sub-continent.

The superior game viewing is due to the:

- Vast size of the property - 13 200 hectares (33 000 acres)
- 19km (±12 miles) unfenced boundary with the Kruger National Park
- 20km (±13 miles) of Sand River frontage
- No shared traversing on 70% of the property
- Position of the camps on the western side of the river, ensuring no human habitation on 95% of the property
