1.1 WHO WE ARE

Madikwe Safari Lodge is a family-owned lodge set within the malaria-free Big 5 Madikwe Game Reserve in South Africa.

KEY USPS:

- **A one-of-a-kind luxury safari for every age, every moment, every season**

A highly flexible safari offering designed to accommodate families, couples, solo travellers, groups of friends, and exclusive-use bookings for any occasion, within one cohesive brand. As a non-migratory, year-round safari destination, Madikwe Safari Lodge offers rewarding game viewing and consistent safari experiences across all seasons.

- **Three distinct safari camps and one private villa under a single family brand**

Madikwe Safari Lodge offers a variety of accommodation options while maintaining consistent standards of service, guiding, and hospitality.

- **Industry-leading family safari offering**

Purpose-designed family safari experiences with age-appropriate game drives, dedicated children's spaces, and family-friendly lodge design, without compromising privacy for other guests.

- **Exclusive-use safari options within the lodge collection**

Kopano Camp, Dithaba Camp, and Elela Villa can be booked on an exclusive basis, allowing for private vehicles, tailored dining, and fully personalised itineraries. Or all camps can be combined for larger parties of up to 46 adult guests sharing (with up to 8 children in the Family Suites).

- **World class spa**

A dedicated spa facility with multiple treatment rooms, experienced therapists, and a strong focus on wellness and relaxation between game drives.

- **Highly personalised, intuitive service**

A warm, family-led hospitality style supported by long-standing staff, with a strong emphasis on personal connection, flexibility, and attention to detail.

1.2 WHERE WE ARE

ACCESSIBILITY:

Madikwe Safari Lodge is located in the **central-eastern region of Madikwe Game Reserve**, in South Africa's North West Province, bordering Botswana.


The reserve's location offers a rare balance of remoteness and accessibility. Madikwe is easily reached by road from Johannesburg or by scheduled and charter flights into the reserve's airstrip, followed by a short lodge transfer. This makes it a practical safari option for both short stays and longer itineraries, including combinations with Cape Town, Indian Ocean and other popular South African destinations.

The camps are positioned to take advantage of varied terrain, water sources, and low vehicle density, ensuring consistently strong game viewing and a sense of space throughout the safari experience.

FLIGHT & ROAD TRANSFERS:

BY AIR:

- Scheduled and charter flights available from **Johannesburg (OR Tambo)** to **Madikwe Eastern Airstrip**.
- Approximate flight time: **1 hour**.
- Scheduled flights operated by **Federal Air**.
- Short lodge transfer from the airstrip, arranged by Madikwe Safari Lodge.
- Ideal for short stays and multi-destination itineraries, maximising time on safari.

BY ROAD:

- Approximately **4 to 4.5 hours' drive** from Johannesburg to Madikwe Game Reserve.
- Allow an additional **30–40 minutes** for the internal reserve drive to the lodge.
- Accessible via main reserve gates, followed by well-maintained gravel roads.
- Suitable for self-drive guests or private road transfers.

1.3 WHY MADIKWE GAME RESERVE

A STANDALONE SAFARI DESTINATION:

Together, these factors position Madikwe Game Reserve as a standalone safari destination: ecologically diverse, conservation-led, uncrowded, and exceptionally well suited to a wide range of travellers.

- One of South Africa's largest protected wildlife areas, covering approximately **76,000 hectares (188,000 acres)**.
- The reserve sits within a **unique ecological transition zone**, where the Kalahari and bushveld biomes meet. This convergence creates a diverse landscape of open savannah, rocky outcrops, wooded areas, and riverine systems, supporting a wide range of wildlife.
- A **malaria-free Big Five reserve**, making it particularly appealing to families, first-time safari travellers, and guests seeking peace of mind without compromising on safari quality.
- A **popular destination year-round** - wildlife is non-migratory, allowing for rewarding game viewing throughout the year.
- A conservation success story. Once farmland, Madikwe was transformed through **Operation Phoenix**, one of the largest wildlife reintroduction projects ever undertaken in Africa. Today, it is home to thriving populations of endangered species, including African wild dog, and operates as a community-owned conservation model.



WILDLIFE:

Madikwe Game Reserve offers consistently rewarding game viewing throughout the year, supported by diverse habitats, permanent water sources, and non-migratory wildlife populations.

- Home to the **Big Five**: lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo and rhinoceros
- Strong populations of **African wild dog**, one of the reserve's most notable and endangered species
- Regular sightings of **cheetah**, **spotted hyena**, and **brown hyena**
- Large herds of plains game including **zebra**, **giraffe**, **wildebeest**, **eland**, **kudu**, **impala**, and **waterbuck**
- Over **350 recorded bird species**, with peak birding from **October to April**
- Wildlife is **non-migratory**, allowing for consistent game viewing throughout the year
- Occasional sightings of more elusive species such as **aardvark**, **aardwolf**, **honey badger**, **serval**, **caracal**, **bat-eared fox**, **porcupine**, **genet** and **pangolin**

WEATHER & CLIMATE:

Madikwe Game Reserve experiences a **semi-arid climate**, making it a comfortable and accessible safari destination throughout the year.

Summer (October to March)

- Warm to hot days, with average daytime temperatures ranging between **25–35°C (77–95°F)**
- Afternoon or evening thunderstorms are common, typically short-lived
- Peak season for **birding** and lush landscapes

Winter (May to August)

- Mild, dry days with daytime temperatures averaging **18–25°C (65–77°F)**
- Cooler mornings and evenings, with temperatures occasionally dropping below **5°C (40°F)**
- Excellent visibility and concentrated wildlife activity around water sources

Spring and Autumn (April, September)

- Transitional months offering moderate temperatures and balanced conditions
- Popular for guests seeking comfortable weather and strong game viewing

Madikwe's climate, combined with its non-migratory wildlife, supports **year-round safari travel** without a defined "off season."

SECTION 2 THREE CAMPS & A VILLA

2.1 INTRODUCTION

THE MADIKWE SAFARI LODGE COLLECTION:

Madikwe Safari Lodge comprises **three distinct safari camps and one private villa**, each offering a different experience while operating under one unified brand.

The camps and villa can be **booked individually or in combination**, allowing Madikwe Safari Lodge to accommodate a wide range of travel needs, from couples and families to larger groups and exclusive-use bookings.



Lelapa Camp, Kopano Camp, and Elela Villa are connected via a meandering walkway along an elevated ridge, allowing easy movement between shared spaces while maintaining a strong sense of privacy at each camp.

Dithaba Camp is positioned separately, set slightly higher on the hillside and accessed via a short walk, offering a more remote and exclusive camp experience.

All camps and the villa have access to the shared facilities at Lelapa Camp, including:

- Main swimming pool
- Waterhole and viewing decks
- Boma
- Wellness Spa
- Gym
- Safari Boutique

This layout allows guests to enjoy both the intimacy of their chosen camp and the broader facilities of the lodge collection.



2.1 LODGE OVERVIEW

LELAPA CAMP:

Lelapa Camp is the most family-oriented camp within Madikwe Safari Lodge, designed to accommodate guests of all ages in a relaxed and welcoming safari environment. Its layout, suite mix, and shared spaces make it particularly well suited to families and multi-generational travel, while remaining equally comfortable for couples and small groups.

The camp overlooks Madikwe Safari Lodge's signature waterhole, which attracts a wide variety of wildlife throughout the day and evening and forms a central focal point for the camp's main guest areas.

Accommodation

- **12 luxury suites**, each with a **private deck and plunge pool**
- Includes **4 Family Suites** designed for parents travelling with two children (accommodated separate bedroom)
- Maximum occupancy: **up to 24 adult guests** based on double occupancy, excluding children in family suites

Age Policy

- Suitable for **children of all ages**
- Family-friendly facilities and experiences available
- **Children under the age of 6 may not participate in scheduled adult game drives** unless their parents have booked exclusive use of a safari vehicle
- For younger children, kiddies' "bumble" game drives are offered close to the camp as an age-appropriate introduction to the wilderness, featuring a range of engaging, guided bush-based activities



Lelapa Camp Layout




Lelapa Suite Layout

KOPANO CAMP:

Kopano Camp is an intimate camp within Madikwe Safari Lodge, designed for guests seeking a quieter and more private safari experience while still having access to the shared facilities of Lelapa Camp.

With a limited number of suites and a refined camp layout, Kopano is particularly well suited to couples, honeymooners, solo travellers, and friends travelling together.

Accommodation

- **4 luxury suites**
- Each suite features a **private deck and plunge pool**
- Maximum occupancy: **up to 8 guests** based on double occupancy

Age Policy

- Suitable for guests aged **16 years and older**
- Children of all ages are welcome when the camp is booked exclusively

Facilities

- Main camp lounge and dining areas (indoor and outdoor)
- Viewing decks overlooking the reserve and Kopano waterhole
- Swimming pool
- Bar area
- Fire pit / boma
- Walking access to shared facilities at Lelapa Camp, including:

 - Safari Boutique
 - Eco-House Kids' Activity Centre (when applicable)


Kopano Camp Layout

DITHABA CAMP:

Dithaba Camp is perched on a hillside, offering **elevated panoramic views over the expansive plains of Madikwe Game Reserve**. Its remote positioning and thoughtful layout create a sense of privacy and understated exclusivity, making it a strong choice for couples, small groups of friends, or older families seeking a more secluded safari experience.

Though slightly removed, Dithaba Camp remains a short walk or drive from the other camps, and guests have full access to the shared facilities at Lelapa Camp and Kopano Camp.

Accommodation

- **4 luxury suites**, each with a **private deck plunge pool**
- Maximum occupancy: up to **8 guests** based on double occupancy

Age Policy

- Guests aged **16 years and older** are accommodated at Dithaba Camp
- Children of all ages are welcome when the camp is booked exclusively





ELELA VILLA:

Elela Villa is Madikwe Safari Lodge's private villa offering, designed for guests seeking maximum privacy, flexibility, and independence within a luxury safari setting. Positioned along the elevated ridge and closely connected to the other camps within the collection, the villa combines the benefits of a standalone safari home with access to the wider Madikwe Safari Lodge facilities.

Elela Villa is particularly well-suited to families, small groups of friends, or multi-generational travellers who value space, exclusivity, and a highly personalised safari experience.

Accommodation

- **3 bedrooms** (2 en-suite, while the third bedroom has a separate bathroom), with private decks

Age Policy

- Suitable for **children of all ages**
- Children under 16 are not able to use Kopano Camp's facilities, but are welcome at Lelapa Camp.


