BACKGROUND

Wine at Londolozi is a constant work in progress. With South African wine improving every year it is a joy to be able to present a list of wines that is constantly challenged by next year's vintages and by the endless innovation happening in so many of the Estates in the Western Cape. Many of the old favourites simply get better with time, some wines are great this year and gone the next, while others arrive on the scene offering something totally new and original. When combined together we have the torrid, yet exciting challenge of finding the right balance between them all.

Apart from the French Champagne, wine at Londolozi is exclusively sourced from South African Estates. We feel that there is simply too much good wine in our own country to justify listing anything else from abroad and that we should be exposing you to what South Africa has to offer while you are travelling in our country. Furthermore, we have done our best to choose wines solely from family estates as it ties in with our family ethos at Londolozi and our intention of creating family networks around the world. Many of these family estates are small boutique wineries who have placed emphasis on low yield, high quality grapes which make best use of their cellar techniques and farm terroir, but whose independent specialities provide diversity in cultivar, region, complexity and style.

Ultimately however, wines have been listed for your enjoyment. Be it a bitterly cold glass of Bubbles or Sauvignon Blanc over lunch in the February heat or a big Bordeaux-style red, packed with flavour and complexity to match a great piece of fillet steak in the Boma, we are pretty sure that you will be able to find something that suits your palate. However, please feel free to chat to your Camp Manager, the lodge Sommelier, Kim, or to myself about particular recommendations.
