COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERING

We are committed to making a lasting, positive impact in the rural heart of South Africa; a region of immense beauty and resilience, but also among the least resourced in the country.

In partnership with the Ubunye Foundation, established in 2002 by Kwandwe and now operating independently, we work with communities across five rural wards surrounding the reserve. What began with a group of women working at Kwandwe who wanted to create local childcare centres has grown into a dynamic collaboration reaching over 35,000 people.

Ubunye's programmes focus on four key areas:

TOGETHER, OUR IMPACT INCLUDES:

- 45 childcare centres supporting more than 1,200 children with early education, nutritious meals, and safe sanitation
- 22 community health workers providing care across five rural clinics, reaching close to 35,000 people
- Over 46,000 women enabled to achieve financial independence through economic empowerment programmes
- 300+ employees (half of them women) working at Kwandwe and supporting more than 1,000 family members
- Housing and essential services for over 400 people living on the reserve
- Land donated for the development of an agri-village and the Mgcamabele Community Centre, a vibrant hub for education, wellness and opportunity

Mgcamabele Community Centre	Visit our crèche and pre-school to meet the children of Kwandwe and learn about the education initiatives supported by the Ubunye Foundation. It is part of Ubunye's Education Isisekelo (isi-Xhosa building a foundation) Programme. The centre offers a glimpse of the future we envision for every child in the area.
