The Wolwedans Collection comprises of Dune Camp, Desert Lodge, Boulders Camp and two exclusive villas, Mountain View Suite and Plains Camp. All are located in the private 220 000-hectare NamibRand Nature Reserve, an International Dark Sky Reserve. The NamibRand is famed for its red dunes, endless yellow plains, impressive mountain ranges, magnificent landscape and fascinating eco-system. Located only 60 kilometres from the coast, summer evenings are cooled by refreshing west winds, while winter mornings make for exceptional photography with layers of fog in the desert.

Vast and ancient landscape: The NamibRand is a 220 000-hectare private reserve and considered one of the most photographic destinations on the continent.

Weather	The NamibRand has a desert climate and average summer temperatures range between 34 and 38°C with almost no humidity. Although winter days are generally pleasant, nights can be rather frosty and temperatures can fall well below zero.				
Rainfall	The NamibRand has an annual mean rainfall between 70 & 80 mm. Most of the rain falls during summer months, but the reserve is on the edge of the winter rainfall area and occasionally receives a small amount of winter rain, though this is normally not more than a few millimetres.

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### DESERT LODGE

Positioned in one of the most enviable locations that the NamibRand has to offer, Desert Lodge has a stunning outlook over vast orange-hued dunes and craggy mountains. This magnificent vista is at the heart of the lodge, and all the rooms and guest areas are perfectly positioned to make the most of the stunning surroundings.

The 10 rooms (seven rooms and three family suites) are tented but provide the comfort and protection of a permanent building. All have private verandahs and “Wolwedans Chillers”. The main area consists of several decks atop the sand. There are two lounges, a number of sundowner decks, a tea deck, a library, a wine cellar and two dining rooms.

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### DUNE CAMP

Positioned on the edge of a 150-metre high dune, Dune Camp has the most extraordinary views across the NamibRand Reserve. With a unique charm, it appeals to travellers looking for a down to earth but stylish experience.

The 6 room tents are pitched on wooden platforms and are comfortable and spacious, including an indoor and outdoor bathroom. A generous deck outside the room allows for safe sleep-outs under the stars, and each has a “Wolwedans Chiller”, a small water-filled silo to cool off in. At the family suite, a short walk away from the main camp, there are two en-suite bedrooms, each with a children's sala with single beds, sharing the bathroom with adults. The suite has a main lounge & spacious deck, with two ‘Wolwedans Chillers’ outside the bedrooms. Meals are enjoyed at main Dune Camp, but the suite has a private guide & vehicle.

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### MOUNTAIN VIEW SUITE

The Mountain View Suite is built over 200 square metres of deck above the dunes. It is exclusive, romantic and utterly gorgeous, with ample space to relax while staring down the valley to the distant mountains – one of the most magnificent views in the reserve. The Suite is located within walking distance from Desert Lodge, but feels as if you are in your own private universe. The suite offers one en-suite bedroom (up to 2 adults), a private lounge, dining area and fire-pit, plus an outside bathroom, a sleep-out deck and a plunge pool. The main veranda has a "star-gaze" bed, which provides a wonderful sleep-out venue during summer.

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### PLAINS CAMP

The most exclusive villa in the heart of the reserve, Plains Camp is the perfect getaway for families and friends seeking uncompromising privacy and solitude. The unique structure is built from timber and canvas, creating a home that blends effortlessly into the surrounding desert plains with a seamless flow between indoor and outdoor spaces.

There are four spacious en-suite rooms (two master rooms and two luxury rooms), all with private 'Wolwedans Chillers', plus a sala room. At the main area, there is a spacious deck, swimming pool, and a central lounge area with a study, living room, dining area and a fully equipped kitchen. A private guide and vehicle as well as a villa manager and chef complete the experience.

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### BOULDERS CAMP

Boulders Camp is three hours south of the other Wolwedans camps, as far off the beaten track as you can be. Built around the base of an enormous outcrop of granite rocks and with enormous mountains towering behind, the camp looks out over an endless landscapes of gravel plains, dotted with the tops of submerged mountains.

The five bedrooms open up on three sides, allowing in the cooling afternoon breeze. Each has a separate spacious bathroom as well as a sala for afternoon siestas, and all the spaces are orientated to enjoy the endless views. Suites 2 & 3, and 4 & 5 respectively share a plunge pool, while suite 1 has its own private plunge pool. The main area consists of a dining and lounge tent, a breakfast deck, library, pool and an open fireplace.

- Children 7+ years are welcome (if the camp is taken exclusively, children of all ages are welcome).
