#### SOSSUSVLEI SAND DUNES

One of the oldest, driest and most pristine areas on earth forming part of the Namib Sand Sea, the largest dune field south of the Sahara, the Namib Desert is home to the spectacular Sossusvlei dunes. Standing over 230 m (750 ft) tall, and shaped by the wind, these breathtaking dunes are amongst the highest in the world.

#### **EXCLUSIVE TRANQUILLITY**

A place of wellness and holistic connectivity defined by heavenly night skies, infinite horizons and striking desertscapes, &Beyond Sossusvlei Private Desert Reserve is a 12 715 hectare (31 419 acre) private concession of iconic dunes and arid desert set in a vast place of nothingness. #### **DESERT-ADAPTED WILDLIFE**

Venture into the desert along eco-sensitive trails on foot, by bike or vehicle to explore the desert's ecology uncovering specially adapted fauna and flora that have managed to make this harsh environment their home. Known as the Living Desert, the dunes of the Namib abound with wildlife, including the elusive Grant's golden mole, and over 114 bird species.

## Travel Namibia and beyond

Travelling to Namibia requires careful consideration and attention to detail as there are a multitude of different transport methods to get to and around the country. Contact your preferred Travel Specialist to assist with your travel plans.

#### **GETTING THERE**

Fly directly from South Africa (Johannesburg and Cape Town) to Hosea Kutako International Airport in Windhoek.

From Hosea Kutako International Airport, take a 30-minute drive to Eros Airport in Windhoek for all scheduled flights within Namibia including to Sossusvlei Desert Lodge. Light aircraft flights link Windhoek to all major tourism areas such as Swakopmund, The Skeleton Coast, Damaraland, Etosha and the Namib Desert; and are operated on a scheduled seat-on-plane or private basis.

There are scheduled daily charter flights (1 hour and 15 minutes) from Windhoek's domestic Eros Airport to the &Beyond Sossusvlei Desert Lodge private airstrip followed by a short 10-minute road transfer to the lodge.

Namibia is an ideal self-drive destination (on good quality tar and gravel roads) although distances between areas may be considerable. All &Beyond guests begin their self-drive journey in Windhoek, and are given a comprehensive briefing by knowledgeable staff regarding road conditions, suggested sightseeing along the route and other relevant information.

For self-drive guests, it is advisable to use a 4x4 vehicle during the rainy season (from November to May). &Beyond Sossusvlei Desert Lodge is a 400 km (248 mi) drive from Windhoek and a 380 km (236 mi) drive from Swakopmund on good quality gravel roads.



\*\*While it is possible to route via Maun (Botswana) or Victoria Falls (Zimbabwe), this is not advised as these flights are not direct and will require a layover in Cape Town or Johannesburg (South Africa) with one or more overnight stops

A diverse array of captivating experiences and activities exploring the unique desert terrain can be adapted according to your preference and ability.



#### LIVING DUNE EXPERIENCE

Set out to the dunes on our private reserve, where the story of the desert's ecology is written in the sand. Explore the dunes on foot or by quad bike with a specialist guide learning about how the oldest and second driest desert on earth came to be, along with the many adapted creatures and flora that call it home.

#### E-BIKING

Easy-to-ride and super fun, these nifty e-bikes are fitted with a battery-powered 'assist' that gives riders a boost when pedalling. Ride across the rugged desert terrain with ease in awe of your surroundings. There are two routes to choose from: 19 km (11.8 mi) or 11 km (6.2 mi). You can also combine your cycle with a hike - we like to call it our 'bike and hike' adventure. Choose to do this activity with a guide or you can also explore the surrounds at leisure.



Literally feel the desert sand beneath your feet as you explore the lodge surrounds. There are two defined hiking trails to choose from: 2.2 km (1.4 mi) or 3.4 km (2.1 mi). Combine this with the e-bike self-exploration option on our 'bike and hike' adventure. Don't forget to take your time, and remember to sit in the stillness and revel in the views. This is a self-exploration excursion.



#### **BIG DUNE WALK**

Enjoy this exclusive experience at &Beyond Sossusvlei Private Desert Reserve, the only private reserve featuring the iconic star dunes of Namibia. Renowned for its dramatic landscape of dunes and mountains. one which mirrors that of Deadylei. but is also completely private and tranquil; take your time climbing the infinite rolling sand dunes before tucking into a well-deserved picnic breakfast.

This half-day adventure takes you into the Namib Naukluft National Park that features the UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Namib Sand Sea. Best seen when the light is still throwing shade over the ridges of the dunes; learn about the delicate ecosystem, Aeolian geological processes, walk to Deadvlei, perhaps climb a sand dune (or two), and for the fit and adventurous, conquer the towering 'Big Daddy'.

#### **DESERT PEOPLE EXPERIENCE**

Step back in time and bring to life the history of the area and its people. Strap on your walking shoes and follow your expert guide into the pristine and untamed Namib Desert scattered with San rock art waiting to be discovered and explored. Uncover heritage sites and gain insight into the culture and time-honoured traditions of the oldest inhabitants of Southern Africa, the San people.



#### **SCENIC DESERT DRIVE**

Ideally situated within the &Beyond Sossusvlei Private Desert Reserve, the lodge is surrounded by numerous distinct habitats and microhabitats. Be mesmerised by the magnificence of the desert on early morning or late afternoon to after nightfall desert drives. Explore four different habitat types and ecosystems, learn about fairy circles, how deserts are formed and function, and how animals have adapted to this desolate environment.

Explore the unique landscape on this fascinating geological excursion, in a vehicle and on foot. View the varied topography, exposed due to the upliftment events after the continent of Gondwana split into Africa and South America. With the nearest town over 140 km (87 mi) away, the reserve's sky is among the darkest ever recorded — best enjoyed from your in-room skylight or, when available, at the lodge's on-site observatory\*.

#### HOT AIR BALLOON OVER THE NAMIB\*

Gain a bird's-eye perspective over the spectacular scenery surrounding the lodge, in the company of other guests. While the balloons are unable to fly over the Namib sand dunes; you will still be treated to awe-inspiring views offering excellent photographic opportunities and lifelong memories. Watch as orxy shrink in size below you and spot the enigmatic fairy circles, which stand out as indented circular patches devoid of vegetation, an intriguing phenomenon of the Namib Desert.

#### **SCENIC HELICOPTER FLIGHTS\***

Take off from near &Beyond Sossusvlei Desert Lodge and hover over the spectacular sweep of the desert. From above, be captivated by rolling sand dunes, craggy mountain tops, solidified rock formations and enchanting fairy circles. There are three flights options available: scenic desert flight, Namib dune photographic flight and the scenic coastal flight. All helicopter adventure offers a truly unique way to experience Namibia's brilliant vista.

Children visiting the desert lodge can take advantage of the exciting WILDchild programme that offers a wide variety of activities:

- Enjoy San rock painting and make bookmarks and fridge magnets with san art designs. Potato printing for the younger kids in San art designs is also available
- Craft solar system mobiles, bottle lid planet hats (for children under 10), or stargaze (for older children)


#### **FITNESS AND WELLNESS**

- An ingenious roof design providing optimal shade plus maximum space for unobtrusive solar panels
- A fully independent solar hot water system
- A highly effective grey water recycling system per Suite (powered by the solar panels on the roof)
- A rainwater harvesting tank (also powered by the solar panels on the roof)
- A pool cover to be used as an evaporation control measure (when guest Suites are not in use)



#### POWERED FOR GOOD

- All Suites are beautifully cool, thanks to the air conditioning which is powered by solar energy
- Each Suite boasts an inviting private plunge pool.
   The water recycling system throughout the lodge generates more than 100 000 litres of grey water a month, which more than offsets the evaporation from the pool surfaces
- Each Suite's private outdoor rain shower, offering 180° views, is sustainably supported by the lodge's water recycling systems
- Room-freezer treats of ice-creams, desert cordials, and craft beer – another solar-powered benefit
- Privacy and extra shade, courtesy of the indigenous desert gardens being cultivated around the Suites, are irrigated by the harvested rain water and recycled grey water systems



#### NATURALLY IMPACTFUL

- By bottling water on site and using recycled glass bottles, the lodge saves a significant amount of CO<sup>2</sup> per month, absorbing the carbon footprint of the plastic water delivery truck
- All cleaning products used at the lodge are environmentally friendly and 100% biodegradable
- All energy used at the lodge is stringently tracked and reported on a monthly and quarterly basis
   this includes the use of wood, petrol, diesel, electricity, gas and paraffin
- In an effort to constantly conserve water, all guest Suites are designed without baths and all systems are regularly checked for leaks and water usage strictly monitored
- The lodge undergoes an annual sustainability audit to determine its environmental impact by monitoring and actively reporting on its carbon footprint
