WHAT SETS US APART?

The camp, named after neighbouring trees with distinctive sausage-shaped fruit, was awarded “Best Location in Africa”, by the Safari Awards due to its remote position within the Lower Zambezi National Park. With panoramic views of the

Zambezi River comes an abundance of wildlife wandering along the riverbanks and sometimes even through the camp. Most importantly, every guest enjoys a private guided experience, whether on land or water.

LOCATION	Located in the heart of the Lower Zambezi National Park close to Jeki Airstrip.

AIR ACCESS	Access to Sausage Tree Camp is best by plane. Lusaka – Jeki Airstrip: 30 minutes Livingstone – Jeki Airstrip: 1 hr 5 minutes Mfuwe - Jeki Airstrip: 1 hr 15 minutes
ROAD & BOAT ACCESS	Lusaka – Sausage Tree: 5 hours. Journey includes both vehicle and boat transfers.
VISA	Most passports require a visa – can be obtained in advance or upon arrival at Kenneth Kaunda International Airport.
CURRENCY	Only USD notes issued from 2017 onwards are accepted. Torn, old, or damaged notes will not be accepted.
SEASONS	Seasons: Winter: May to July. Summer: September to October. Rainy Season: November to March.
RAINS	November to March.
MALARIA	Sausage Tree Camp is in a remote location, which minimises the risk of malaria. We also provide mosquito nets and spray, and encourage guests to bring their own insect repellent. However, malaria is still prevalent across Zambia, so please do consult your doctor for recommended prophylaxis.
YELLOW FEVER	Yellow fever vaccination is no longer required when transiting through South Africa.

Dining experiences include bush dinners, water lunches, and private dinners on your deck or in your room. We cater to most dietary requirements with prior notice.
