

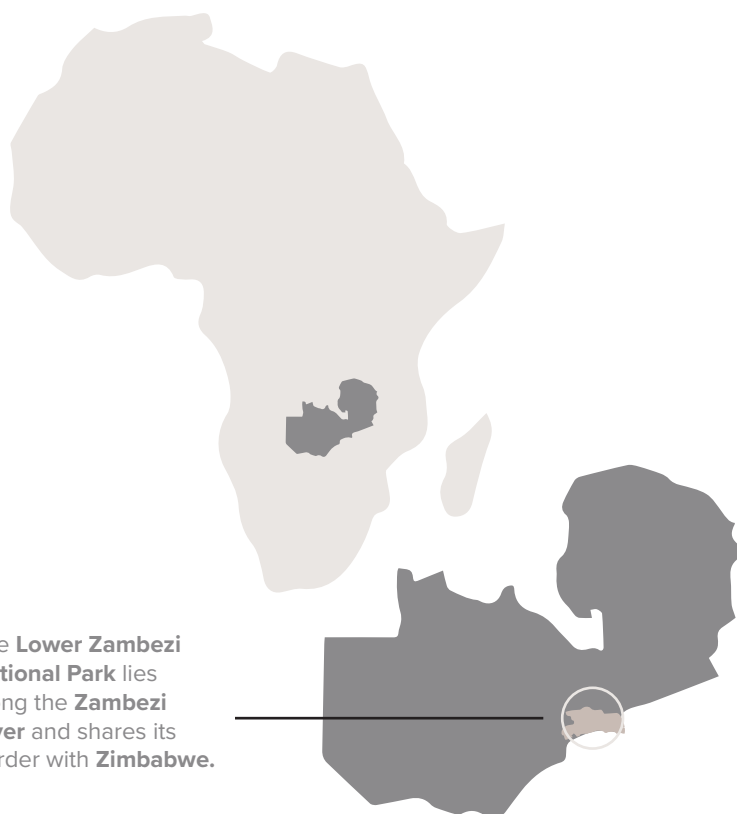

WHAT SETS US APART?

Named after the iconic trees bearing distinctive sausage-shaped fruit, Sausage Tree Camp is set in a truly remarkable location—recognised as “Best Location in Africa” by the Safari Awards for its remote setting within the Lower Zambezi National Park.

Overlooking the Zambezi River, the camp offers sweeping views and a constant presence of wildlife, often seen along the riverbanks and occasionally moving through camp itself. Above all, each guest enjoys a fully private, expertly guided experience—whether exploring by land or water.

AIR ACCESS	Access to Sausage Tree Camp is best by plane. Lusaka – Royal Airstrip: 30 minutes Livingstone – Royal Airstrip: 1 hr Mfuwe - Royal Airstrip: 1 hr 10 minutes
ROAD & BOAT ACCESS	Lusaka – Sausage Tree: 5 hours. Journey includes both vehicle and boat transfers.
VISA	Most passports require a visa. These can be obtained in advance or arrival at Kenneth Kaunda International Airport.
CURRENCY	Zambia Kwacha (ZMW). USD cash widely accepted in Zambia (no older than 2016).
SEASONS	Seasons: Winter: May to July. Summer: September to October. Rainy Season: November to March.
RAINS	November to March.
MALARIA	We provide mosquito nets and insect repellent for your comfort and peace of mind, and we recommend bringing your preferred repellent along. As malaria is present throughout Zambia, we strongly advise consulting your doctor ahead of travel to discuss suitable prophylactic medication.
YELLOW FEVER	Yellow fever vaccination is no longer required when transiting through South Africa.

DINING & BAR AREA	Our open-air dining area and deck overlook the Zambezi River. Breakfast is served buffet-style, offering both continental and cooked options. Lunch features a selection of à la carte dishes, afternoon tea includes a variety of sweet and savoury treats, and dinner is also offered à la carte, accompanied by a curated selection of South African wines. Dining experiences include bush dinners, water lunches, and private dinners on your deck or in your room. We cater to most dietary requirements with prior notice.
PRIVATE DINNER	Various locations available on request. Meals can also be served in your tent on request.

SECURITY	We have 24-hour security personnel on site, including a night watch team who escort guests to and from the main areas after dark.

SAFE	Yes, available in all tents at Sausage Tree Camp.
HAIRDRYER	Yes, available upon request.
LAUNDRY	Laundry service available. Detergent is provided for small personal items.
POWER	The camp is fully solar-powered with a backup inverter system, ensuring 24/7 electricity and charging availability.

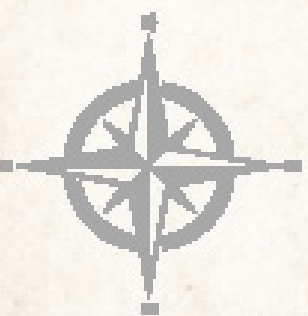
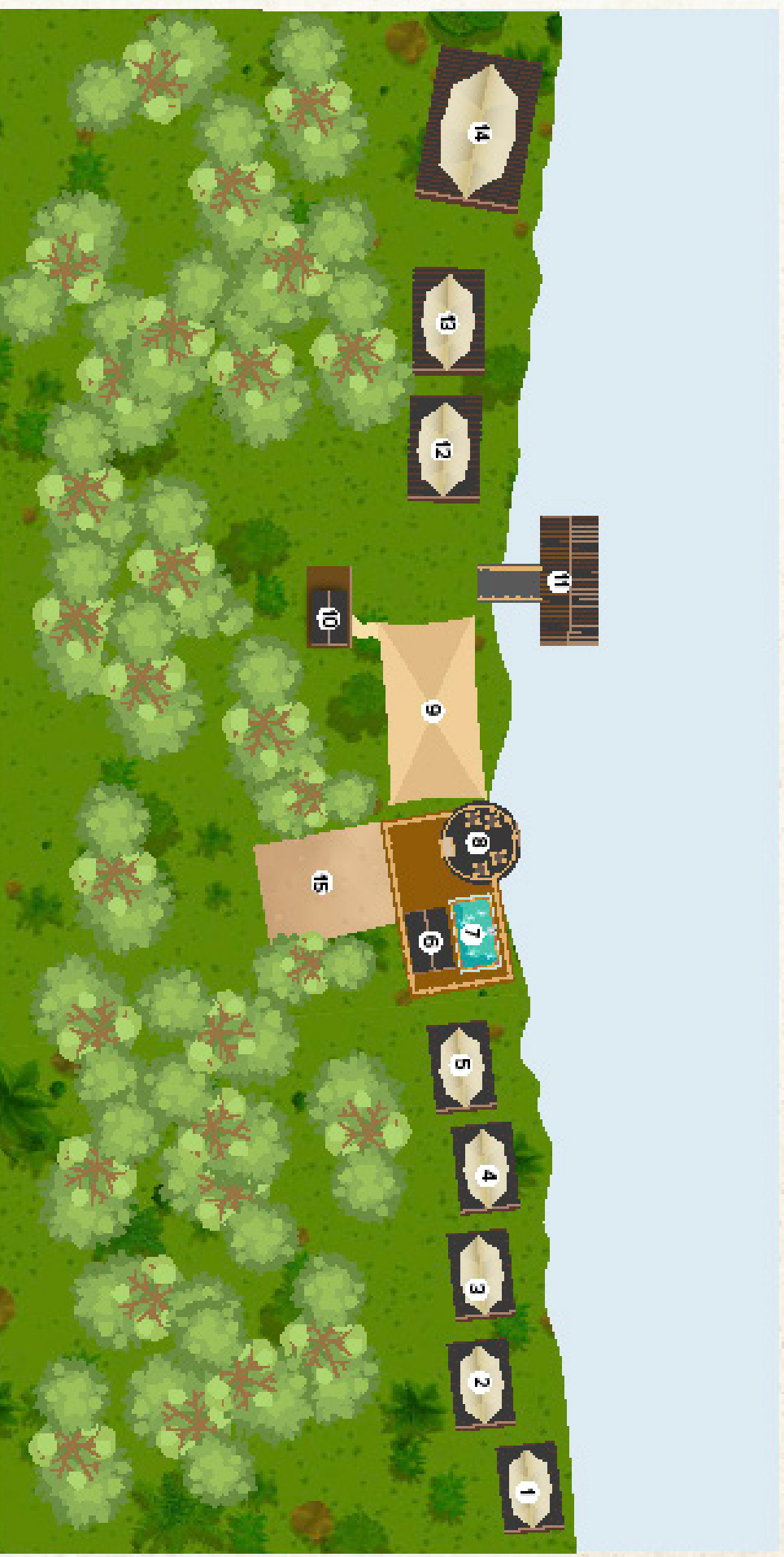
Some of our other initiatives include Game Rangers International, Panthera, Hack the Poacher, Zambian Carnivore Project, and South Luangwa Conservation Society.
