MOUNTAIN CAMP

FACT SHEET

The original Swahili word **M'wane** means **"Place of God"**, and here you will find the true meaning of the words – peace and tranquillity.

LOCATION:

GPS: 20°30'16.60"S 14°25'21.80"E

Mowani Mountain Camp is located in the Uibasen-Twyfelfontein Community Conservancy in Damaraland. This is in the north-eastern region with the closest towns being Uis, approximately 122km south and Khorixas approximately 92km east.

Windhoek is 550km and is approximately 5 ½ hours' drive, Swakopmund is 320km and is approximately 4 ½ hours' drive. Transfers from Twyfelfontein Airstrip are approximately 20 minutes.

ACCESS:

Closest International Airports are Walvis Bay International Airport - 360km and Hosea Kutako International Airport, Windhoek - 590km

Closest Airstrip - Twyfelfontein, 15km

BEST TIME TO GO & WEATHER:

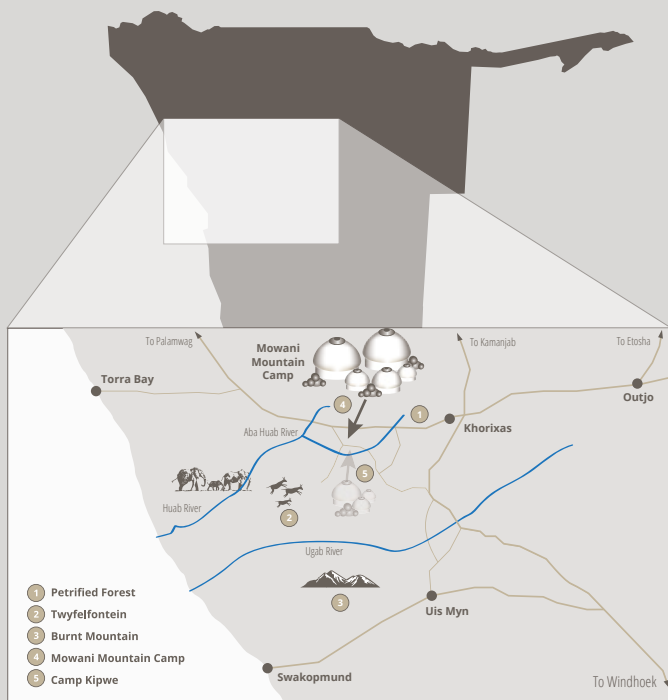
All year round is a great time to travel to this area! Always pack for hot & cold conditions all year round.

Midsummer temperatures can rise to approximately 38°C. In winter daytime temperatures can vary between 18-25°C while at night and in the morning, it can drop to below freezing.

The rainy season is from October/November through to March, however this area receives minimal rainfall and rain seldom lasts more than an hour or two at most.

LODGE FACILITIES:

- Swimming pool that has been skilfully carved out of the local boulders, blending in perfectly with the natural surroundings, with a view to compliment
- Lounge and dining room with sweeping views
- Outdoor boma area is an additional area for relaxing, and is used for dining on special occasions and three-night stays
- Bar
- Viewpoint & sundowner spot with 180 degrees of spectacular beauty
- Curio shop
- Limited Wi-Fi (Due to remote location)
- Limited cellphone reception
- Solar geysers and electricity with back-up generator. Plugs run on 220/240 volts. Outlets are round 3-pin 15-amp type, or 2 round-pin plugs
- Mastercard and Visa payment facilities. We also accept NAD, ZAR and US\$



Accommodation:

VIEW ROOMS: 12 Twin bedded rooms (can be converted into a King bed), with thatched roofs and en-suite facilities, air-conditioning and limited Wi-Fi.

Four Superior View Rooms face west with panoramic views.

Eight View Rooms offer varied outlooks: either a northern view across the valley or a more intimate perspective across a boulder-strewn valley facing east or northeast.

LUXURY ROOM: Situated behind large boulders, this west-facing room consists of a thatch roof, partly canvas walls, an air-conditioned room with kingsize bed, en-suite facilities and its own private deck with heated splash pool overlooking the valley below. Limited Wi-Fi and private dining are available in-room or on the deck. Being close to the main area, this room is ideal for guests with limited mobility. Laundry service included for stays of 2 nights or more.

ROCK SUITE: Cocooned within the rocks is this private thatched suite with splash pool. The lounge features satellite television and stocked minibar, before leading to an air-conditioned king bedded room and an en-suite open-air bathroom tucked into the rocks. Private dining is available either within the suite or on the outdoor decks which are also cocooned within the rocks. Limited Wi-Fi and laundry service included for stays of 2 nights or more.

MOUNTAIN SUITE: A private, luxury thatched suite with spectacular wrap-around views. The lounge offers satellite television and soundbar before leading onto an outdoor deck. Adjacent to the lounge is a bedroom equipped with king size bed, air-conditioning, separate bathroom and an outdoor deck featuring a heated splash pool, sala, bath and shower with uninterrupted views. Limited Wi-Fi, private dining, stocked minibar and laundry service included for stays of 2 nights or more.

ACTIVITIES:

- **Guided Nature Drive** – Usually departs at 06h30 and will go out for +/- 4 – 6 hours to explore the surrounding area in search of desert-adapted life, including the remarkable desert-adapted elephants. Drinks & snacks are included.
- **Twyfelfontein, Burnt Mountain and Organ Pipes Excursion** - this usually departs at 15h00 and will last for +/- 2 hours taking in the famous UNESCO World Heritage Site of Twyfelfontein to explore the rock engravings, along with seeing Burnt Mountain and the Organ Pipes.
- **Damara Living Museum** - guests are transported to the museum to learn about the traditional lifestyle, crafts, customs, and practices of the Damara people, while also engaging with them as they live today.
- **Self-Guided Nature Walk** – Guests are free to follow the short walking trail with information showing the names of different plants and trees on their own (or, depending on guide's availability they are welcome to ask the guides to take them on a longer walk.)

FAMILIES AND CHILDREN:

Mowani Mountain Camp is child friendly.

Children under the age of 3 stay free of charge.

Children aged 3 - 12 are accommodated in a children's tent or on camping beds in the room with their parents at a special child rate.

Please note that Mowani Mountain Camp have a limited number of camping beds. Parents are kindly requested to ensure their children behave accordingly as other guests need to be taken into consideration, especially on activities and when in the main dining and lounge area. Please note that there are snakes and scorpions in the area and the lodge is surrounded by boulders so parents need to make sure that their children do not put their hands in little nooks and crannies, and do not climb, jump and leap on the boulders. Special meal times and food preferences are to be advised in advance for adequate preparations to be made to accommodate the requests.

RATES:

All rates are quoted in Namibian Dollar (N\$).

Included are accommodation, breakfast, dinner, NTB Tourism Levy & VAT.

Excluded are the activities, lunch, drinks, curios and items of a personal nature.
