


Where the southern sky meets two glistening oceans, lies Cape Town, South Africa's most sought after tourist destination.







With waves against the walkway and seabirds in the sky, it's the playground of the young and restless, the old and the wise, offering a variety of activities facilities and endless entertainment.

























Beaches

Go further along the Atlantic Seaboard and meet the unmatched beauty of the affluent suburbs of Bantry Bay, Clifton and Camps Bay. White sandy beaches will welcome you and breaking waves will entertain you while breathtaking ocean and mountain views surround you.

Clifton Beach has something of a reputation of being a haven for international jet-setters. Together with its immaculate white sands and glistening water, the bronze bodies of the beautiful and the extraordinary grace of Clifton's 4th Beach - a picturesque gem well deserving of not only its see-and-be-seen reputation but also its blue flag status.

V & A Waterfront

One of South Africa's biggest tourist attractions, the Waterfront evokes historical images of the earlier activities of the harbour. Signal Hill

However, once you've climbed your way to the top, you'll realise that the mountain has many secrets, jealously guarded by the blanket of clouds often surrounding it.


