The below pre-visit guide is designed to help you better prepare for your visit to Leopard Mountain!

CHECK IN TIMES:

Check-in: 14h00; Check-out: 10h00

We ask that you arrive no later than 14h00 as we wouldn't want you to miss your first evening game drive with us which generally starts from 15h00.

WHAT TO PACK:

As a general guide we suggest that you bring comfortable, casual wash and wear clothes. Muted colours are best for game viewing. Our game drives depart in the early morning and afternoon, which can be very cold, especially in winter.

The most practical items to pack for safari are:

Khaki, green, beige and neutral colours

Shirts with long sleeves (even in summer as protection from the sun)

T-shirts

Shorts or a light skirt

Jeans or safari trousers for evenings and cooler days

Jackets and sweaters are recommended for early morning and evening game drives

Lightweight water-proof jacket

Swim and beachwear

Comfortable walking shoes

Sun block, sunglasses, hat, moisturizer and lip-salve are all essentials

Strong insect repellent like Mozzie Guard (www.mosi-guard.com)

Binoculars and camera equipment

(Winter can be especially cold in the mornings so please keep this in mind.)

CLIMATE:

Summer – Dec to Feb

Autumn – March to May

Winter – May to August

Spring – Sep to Nov

We are lucky enough to enjoy a warm sub-tropical climate for most part of the year. Summer temperatures are hot and humid, from 24 - 30 degrees celsius, and winter temperatures average 20 degrees celsius. Winters are ideal and from March/April the temperatures vary from about 11 degrees at night to around 30 degrees in the day. The rest of the year has very hot days and high humidity levels.

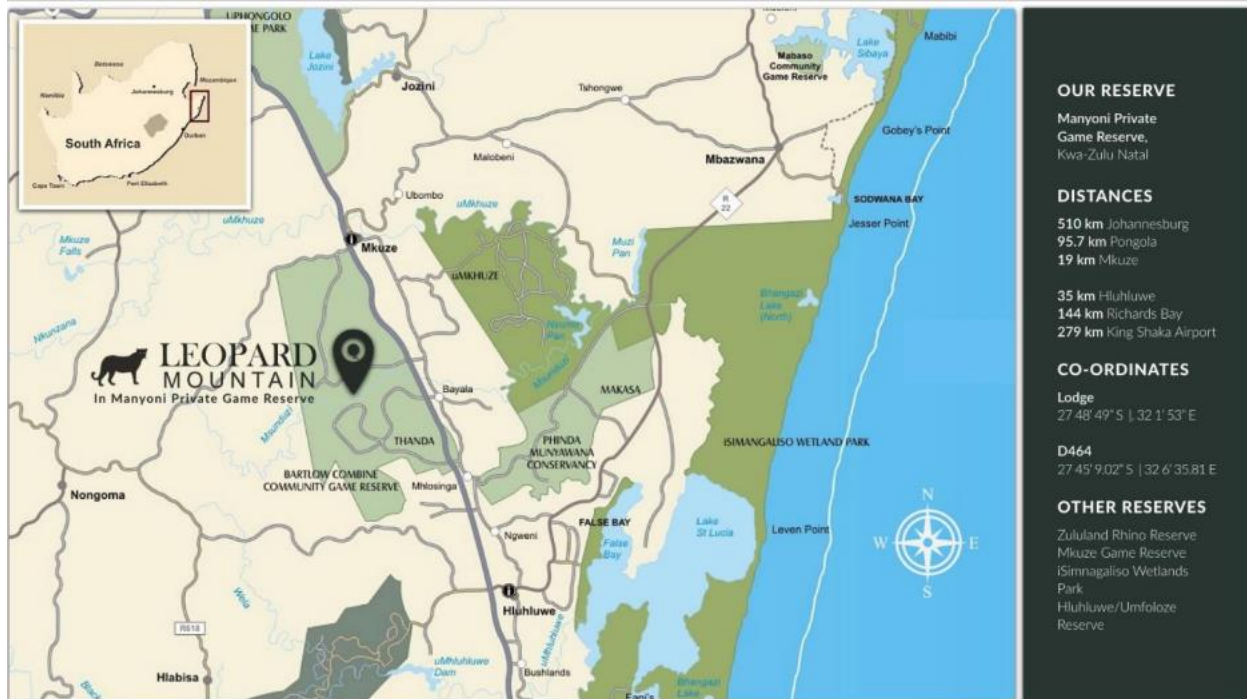
DIETARY REQUIREMENTS:
