

## A DAY IN WINTER AT KWANDWE



There's a quiet clarity to winter and early spring at Kwandwe. The days begin crisp, with golden light spilling across the open landscape. Game drives stretch a little longer, and sightings are often spectacular — not hurried, but unfiltered and deeply rewarding. In this season of stillness, each day at Kwandwe is unhurried and immersive. The bush is bare and beautiful, its silences profound. Here, every moment draws you closer — to the land, the wildlife, and a deeper sense of self.

### BREAKFAST

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Start your day with a relaxed breakfast as the sun rises over the landscape. Enjoy platters of fresh fruit and cheese, followed by a choice of warm dishes prepared to your liking — eggs, oats, waffles and more. It's a quiet moment to settle into the day, with time to enjoy the view and the company.

### MORNING GAME DRIVE

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Over breakfast, your ranger will chat with you about what you'd like to see. Then head out in an open 4x4 safari vehicle with your ranger and tracker team. This is a good time to look for Cheetah, Black Rhino or Elephant as the bush begins to stir — each drive shaped by what the land reveals, and what you're hoping to find.



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### LATE MORNING / LUNCH

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After your drive, take time to walk near your lodge, accompanied by your ranger, if you wish. These gentle explorations reveal the subtle details of the landscape — tracks, textures, and the quiet presence of smaller species. Lunch is a relaxed, seasonal affair. Dine wherever you choose — on the terrace, beside a fire, or in your private space — and savor fresh, locally inspired dishes made with care and simplicity.

### AFTERNOON TEA

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The winter sun softens in the afternoon, inviting rest. You may choose to unwind with a book, stretch out on a sunlit lounger, or enjoy a moment of stillness before your evening adventure. Afternoon tea is served as the light begins to shift — a moment to reconnect with your ranger and plan what comes next.

### AFTERNOON / EVENING EXPERIENCE

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Drives begin earlier in winter and stretch into the early evening, with longer sightings and softer light. Your vehicle moves through golden grasslands and open plains, pausing for sundowners in a wild and beautiful place. As night falls, the bush comes alive in new ways — spotlights may reveal the flicker of eyes or the quiet movement of elusive nocturnal creatures such as Aardvark or Aardwolf.

Alternatively, opt for a Big Game walking safari — tracking Elephant, Rhino, or Buffalo on foot, accompanied by an armed specialist ranger and tracker team. (Available at an additional cost.)

### DINNER

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Evenings are marked by warmth and comfort. Dine beside a roaring fire or beneath a starlit sky. Meals are thoughtfully prepared — hearty, seasonal, and deeply satisfying — offering a quiet close to a day shaped entirely around you.
