WHERE *REMOTE* TAKES ON NEW MEANING

In the extreme north of the Serengeti, close to the border with neighbouring Kenya, the Mara River slices through one of the most far-flung corners of Tanzania where rolling green hills dotted with acacia trees open into wide, grassy savannahs. This is where the great wildebeest migration meets its biggest challenge at its peak between July and October each year - crossing the Mara, a river with some of the highest concentrations of crocodiles in Africa. It's also where you'll find Nimali Mara - a lodge literally on the edge of the action...

GETTING HERE

BY AIR:

- Kogatende airstrip is a 35-minute game drive away.

BY ROAD

- Nimali Serengeti is a 4-hour game drive

LOCATION & ACCESS

The Serengeti National Park sits in the north-central region of Tanzania and borders Kenya to the north, close to Nimali Mara. The area around Nimali Mara is one of the most remote in the northern section of the Serengeti, making it exclusive and intimate, especially outside of the Great Wildebeest Migration, which peaks between July and October each year.

The diversity and proliferation of wildlife in the northern Serengeti is great all year round, with some of the highest concentrations of elephant, lion, leopard, cheetah and hyena in the Serengeti, guaranteeing exceptional year-round Safaris for the Senses.

Nimali Mara is just 35 minutes by road from the Mara River. The Camp has been strategically located away from the hustle and bustle of safari vehicles whilst retaining easy access to the river and views of the amazing wildebeest migration crossings.

THE LODGE

Nimali Mara is an intimate, boutique tented camp offering a sense of sophisticated elegance and timelessness through a blend of natural materials, contemporary design, and safari opulence. Hidden away on a small kopje, the camp sits amongst trees and boulders with an infinity pool set inside a natural cave. The lounge and dining areas offer spectacular views of the Serengeti plains.

The natural kopje rock has been merged with organically inspired décor that includes copper fittings to create a warm ambience.

Nimali Mara has eight tented suites and two honeymoon suites that have a private plunge pool and lounge area that can convert into an area for children when traveling as a family.

The external walls of the suites are canvas while the fronts are glass in order to maximise the views of the Serengeti plains and allow guests to immerse themselves in the environment around them. The tented suites have fixed wooden doors, twin showers, a double vanity with copper basins and a beautiful large copper bathtub, with a window that opens up on to the plains.

TRAVEL INFORMATION
SEASON: Open all year round.
WEATHER: Temperatures are generally pleasant and range between 13°C / 55°F to 29°C / 84°F. Our short rains take place between November and December. Our long rains take place between April and May. The dry season lasts from June to November.
