



WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- Children must always be accompanied by an adult when travelling.
- Guides will always have the final say in whether a child is allowed to join a certain activity.
- If a camp accepts children under 6, they will be accommodated free of charge.
- A 50% discount applies to children between 6 and 18.
- Children aged 19 and over will be charged the full adult rate.
- A private guide/vehicle must be booked for families travelling with children 12 years and younger.
- Children aged between 0-18 must share a room with an adult or two, depending on the set up at each individual camp.
- Please consult your doctor for recommended vaccinations.
- Children's menus are available. *Please inform reservations of any dietary requirements or requests your child may have prior to travel – and confirm upon arrival with the Camp Management.*

MOBILE SAFARI EXPEDITIONS

- Children of all ages may join our Mobile Safari Expeditions.
- Children under 18 are not permitted to stay alone in their tent and must share with an adult. Children pay 50% of the adult rate.
- A max of two adults and one child sharing per tent. A child can be accommodated on a bed roll.
- Families travelling with two children under 18 years of age will be roomed as 1 adult and 1 child per tent.
- Mobile Expeditions accommodate a maximum of 14 guests on an exclusive-use basis.
- Only children 6 years and older may take part in a mokoro safari.
- Children of all ages may join a boat safari.
- Children under 12 must wear a life jacket on a mokoro or boat.

CAMP KALAHARI, JACK'S CAMP, SAN CAMP

- Camp Kalahari, Jack's Camp, San Camp accept children of all ages.
- Family tent (ONLY AT CAMP KALAHARI): 2 adjacent tents accommodating a max of 2 adults and 2 children. If the family tent is not available, families travelling with two children under 18 will be roomed as 1 adult and 1 child per tent.
- Twin/double tents: a max of two adults and one child sharing per tent. A child can be accommodated on a bed roll.
NB: At the NEW Jack's Camp, children will be accommodated in a second bed. There will be no bed rolls.
- Children of all ages may join the bushmen walks.
- Children aged 6 years and older may join the quad bike expeditions but children under 12 may not drive the bike.
- Children aged 8 years and older may partake in the horse riding activities; beginners are welcome.
- Horse riding safaris (set departures) are only available to children aged 12 years and older who are experienced riders.

MENO A KWENA

- Meno a Kwena accepts children of all ages.
- Family tent: 2 adjoining tents accommodating a max of 2 adults and 3 children in 1 x double bed and 3 x 3/4 beds.
- Twin tent: two queen size beds accommodating a max of 2 adults and 2 children sharing per tent.
- Children of all ages may join the bushmen walks.
- Children of all ages may partake in the boat safaris.

HYENA PAN

- Hyena Pan accepts children 6 years and older.
- Twin tent: a max of two adults and one child sharing per tent. A child can be accommodated on a bed roll.
- Hyena Pan accommodates a maximum of 16 guests.
- Only children aged 12 and over may take part in a walking safari.

SABLE ALLEY, TULUDI, THE JACKEL & HIDE

- All three camps accept children 6 years and older.
- Family tent (at Sable Alley & Tuludi): two adjacent tents accommodating a maximum of two adults and two children.
- Twin/double tent: a max of two adults and one child sharing per tent. A child can be accommodated on a bed roll at Tuludi & Sable Alley. Please note that no triples or bedrolls can be accommodated at The Jackel & Hide.
- If the family tent is not available, families travelling with two children under 18 years of age will be roomed as 1 adult and 1 child per tent.
- Only children aged 6 years and older may take part in a mokoro or boat safari.
- Children under 12 years must wear a life jacket on a mokoro or boat.
- Only children aged 12 years and over may take part in a walking safari (applicable for Tuludi & Sable Alley).

SKYBEDS

- Skybeds accepts children 12 years and older.
- Skybed: a max of two adults and one child sharing per Skybed. The child will be accommodated on a bed roll.
- Children are not to be left alone on the Skybeds and should be under adult supervision at all times.
- Skybeds accommodates a maximum of 6 guests.

MAPULA LODGE

- Mapula Lodge accepts children 6 years and older.
- Family tent: two adjacent tents, accommodating a maximum of two adults and two children.
- Twin/double tent: a max of two adults and one child sharing per tent. The child will be accommodated on a bed roll.
- If the family tent is not available, families travelling with two children from 6- 18 years of age will be roomed as 1 adult and 1 child per tent.
- Mapula Lodge accommodates a maximum of 20 guests.
- Only children aged 6 years and older may take part in a mokoro or boat safari.
- Children under 12 years must wear a life jacket on a mokoro or boat.
