It is best to arrive before 15h30 for the afternoon game drive, although check-in time is from 14h00.

It takes approximately 6 hours to drive from Johannesburg to the lodge.

Please note the Thornybush Reserve gate is only open between 5:00 am (05h00) and 10:00 pm (22h00). Distances

From Johannesburg

- Take the N12 to Emalahleni (Witbank), where the N12 highway links up with the N4 highway
- Continue with the N4 in the direction of Mbombela (Nelspruit)
- Approximately 60km past Middleburg, take the R540 to your left
- Travel through the towns of Emakhazeni (Belfast) and Emnotweni (Dullstroom) to Mashishing (Lydenburg)
- Take the R36 (which becomes the R527) towards Hoedspruit, passing through Origstad, descending the Able Erasmus Pass
- Once in Hoedspruit, take the R40 south towards Bushbuckridge
- Travel 6.4km and turn left at the Eastgate Airport sign / Argyle Road (signposted Timbavati)
- Go through the boom gate (license disc will be scanned) and continue 16.9 km (along the tarred road) and turn right onto Guernsey Road (following the signs to Thornybush Game Lodge)
- After 9.2km on the gravel road, you will see the sign for the Thornybush Game Reserve/Lodge, turn left here
- Follow the signs to Saseka for a further 6.6km through the reserve, and the lodge team will be expecting you.

From Pretoria

- Take the N4 in the direction of Mbombela (Nelspruit)

- Drive 1km and take the Guernsey turnoff on your right. there is a large brown Thornybush sign on the left
- Pass through the security gate and travel for 7.3km on tar road and a further 3.9km on dirt road
- Turn left at the T-junction and travel another 6.3km to the Thornybush Private Nature Reserve gate on your right
- Follow the signs to Saseka for a further 6.6km through the reserve, and the lodge team will be expecting you.

From Swaziland

- From Jeppe's reef border post, follow the R570 north in the direction Malelane
- Take the N4 highway in the direction of Mbombela (Nelspruit) for 64 km
- On arrival in Mbombela (Nelspruit), turn right onto the R40 in the direction of white river
- Continue through White River, Hazyview, Bushbuckridge towards Acornhoek
- Passing Acornhoek, head towards Klaserie for approximately 8km and turn right onto the R40 heading towards Hoedspruit / Eastagte Airport / Phalaborwa
- Drive 1km and take the Guernsey turnoff on your right, there is a large brown Thornybush sign on the left
- pass through the security gate and travel for 7.3km on tar road and a further 3.9km on dirt road
- Turn left at the T-junction and travel another 6.3km to the Thornybush Private Nature Reserve gate on your right
- Follow the signs to Saseka for a further 6.6km through the reserve, and the lodge team will be expecting you
