

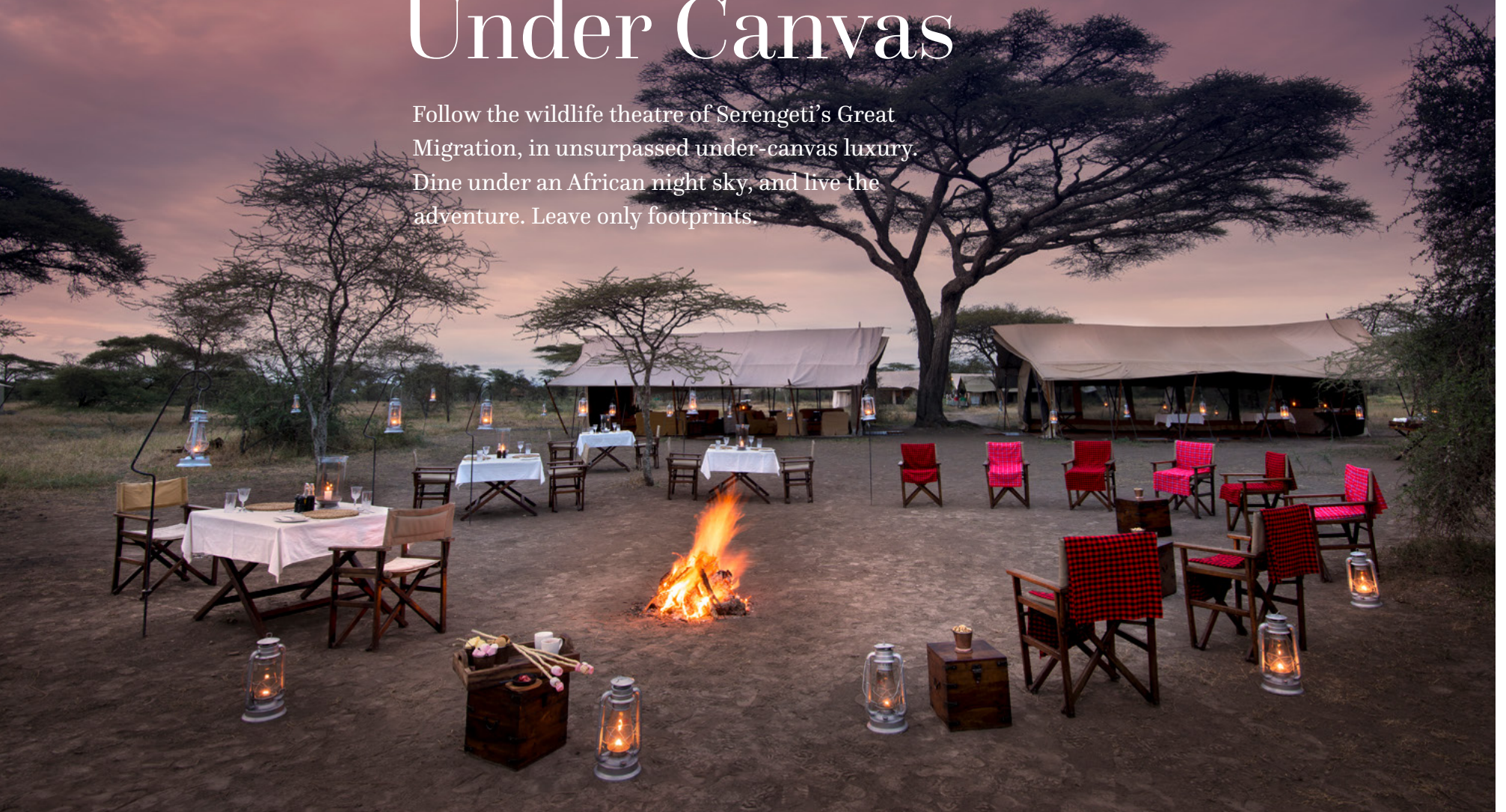

There is exceptional resident game year-round, big cat sightings where lion and leopard are frequently seen and unique wildlife, including a topi migration near Grumeti, rhino in the north, excellent cheetah sightings in the south and big elephant herds throughout.

3 MOST LUXURIOUS TENTS IN THE SERENGETI

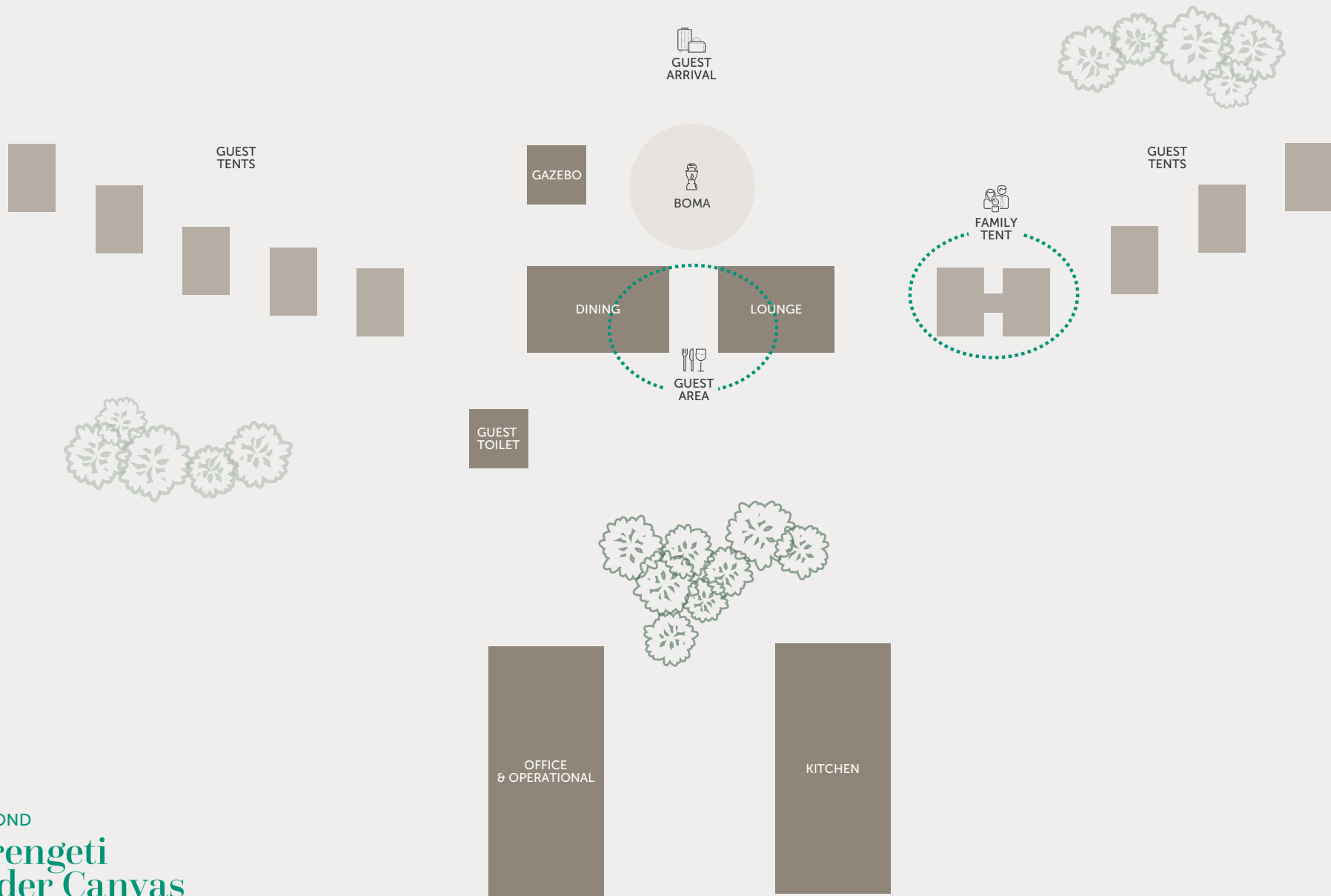

SAFARI GAME DRIVE

Game drives in the Serengeti are unforgettable due to the abundance of wildlife and the spectacular landscapes. Travellers can expect to encounter large numbers of animals year-round, with big herds of elephant, buffalo and other plains game. It is also common to see predator interaction. Game drives may last from a couple of hours to the whole day, with a picnic breakfast and lunch.

THE GREAT MIGRATION

The famous Great Migration is a year-round cycle in which 1.5 million wildebeest, 400 000 zebra, 300 000 Grant's and Thomson's gazelle, and 12 000 eland participate. These animals move from the dryer southern part of the ecosystem, the short-grass plains of the south eastern Serengeti, and head to the moister northern part, the northern Serengeti woodlands and the Masai Mara plains, and back again.

AL FRESCO DINING

Revel in the wide open landscapes of Africa as you savour a meal served outside (unless it is raining, in which case you are enjoying your meal in the dining tent). Your butler will always pick the perfect place for you, for example under a tree, next to the camp fire at night or the privacy of dinner for-two outside your tent.

HOT AIR BALLOON SAFARI*

Glide in a hot air balloon over the migration herds in the Serengeti on this captivating experience. Float in whichever direction the winds of the morning takes you. Marvel at the views of the sweeping plains below and wildlife dotted across the landscape. End off your experience with a delicious breakfast spread in the heart of the Serengeti plains.

STARGAZING

Explore the vast night sky and its stunning constellations gathered around a cosy campfire. Scan the velvet expanse and observe the northern and southern hemisphere stars in one place. Marvel at the infinite sky, which features the Big Dipper in the northern hemisphere and the Southern Cross and Pointers in the southern hemisphere.

OLDUVAI GORGE AND SHIFTING SANDS*

When the camp is in Ndutu, in the southern Serengeti, explore the breathtaking surrounds of the archaeological site of Olduvai Gorge, the cradle of mankind, best known as home of the earliest remains of Homo sapiens. Move on to the crescent-shaped volcanic ash dunes known as Shifting Sands, which slowly creep across the desert floor in response to prevailing winds.

Considered the most thrilling spectacle in the animal kingdom, this epic journey migrates from Tanzania's Serengeti to Kenya's Masai Mara.

2 THE WORLD'S LARGEST OVERLAND MAMMAL MIGRATION

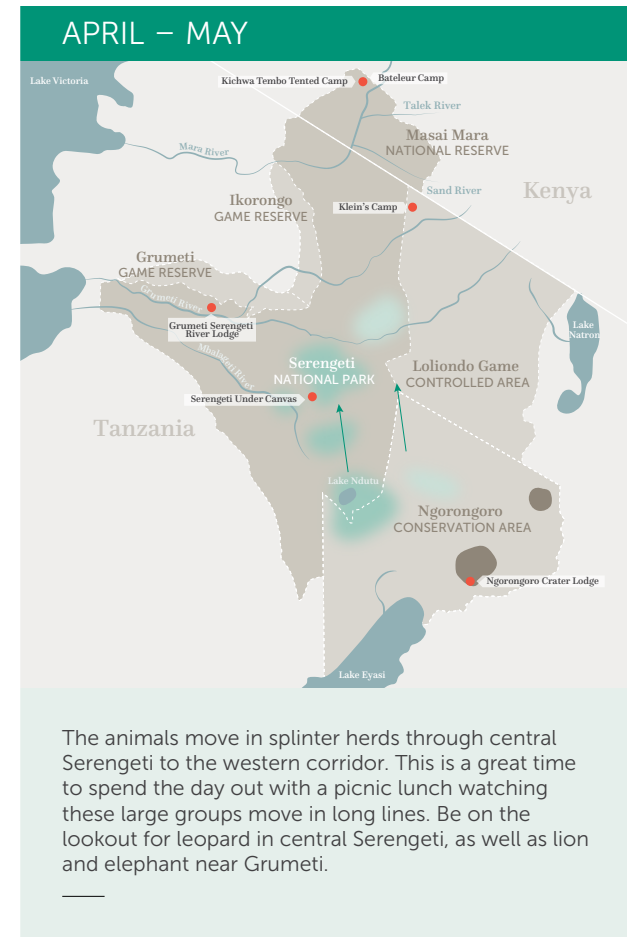
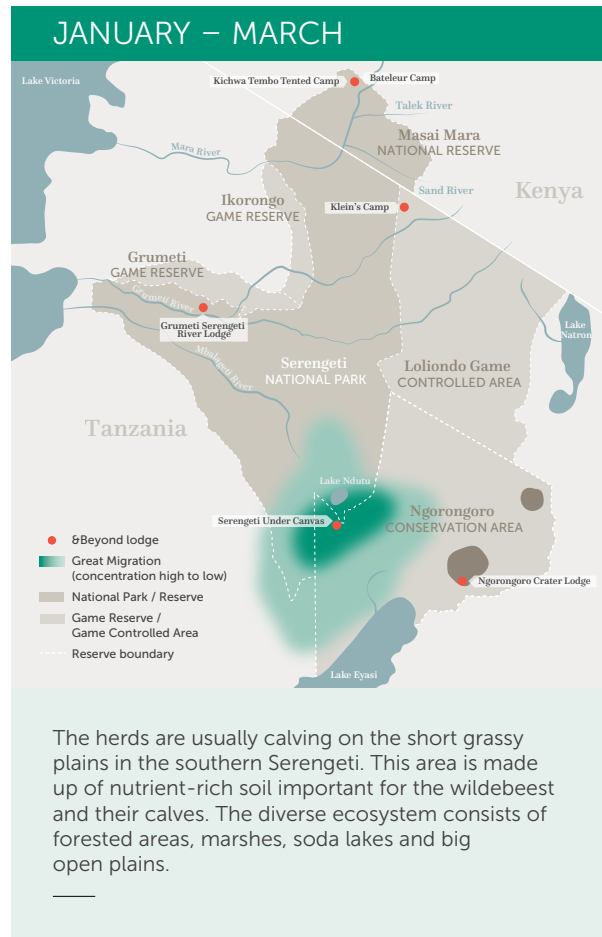
The annual movement of wildebeest and other herbivores across the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem consists of more than 1.5 million wildebeest, 500 000 zebra, 200 000 Thompson's gazelle and 18 000 eland.

3 THE ANIMALS MIGRATE OVER 800 KM (500 MI)

Due to the sheer size of the herd, the animals have to move to be able to survive. The herds generally follow the rain, as where there is rain, there is fresh grass. Once grass is depleted in one area, they will move to another grassy area.

It's estimated 500 000 wildebeest calves are born annually.

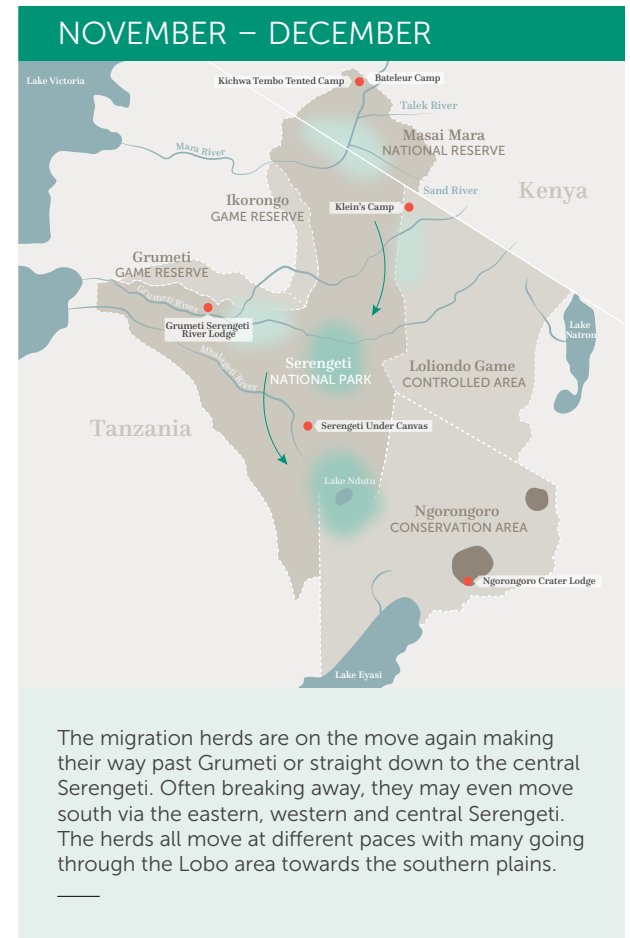
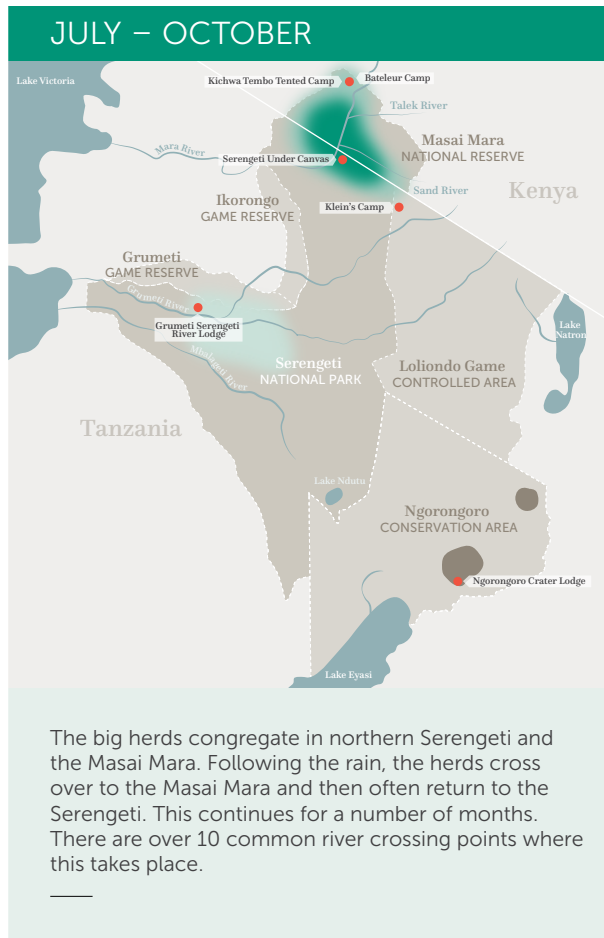
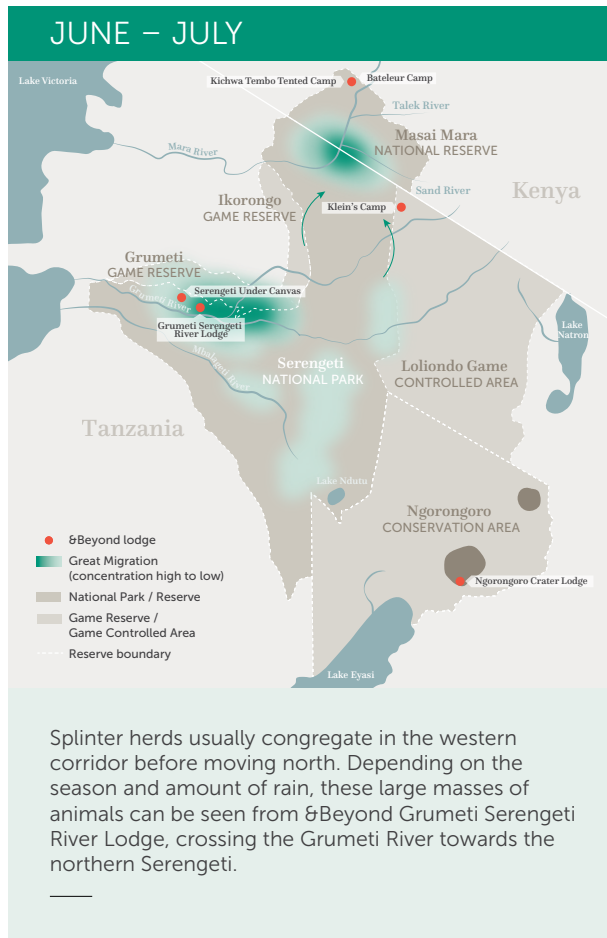
The annual movement of wildebeest and other herbivores across the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem is rarely the same in terms of precise timing and direction.

Travel to Tanzania is recommended for children eight years or older. Please note that due to the camp not being fenced off children are required to have an adult accompanying them at all times. Please note that no children under six years of age are allowed at BEYOND Serengeti Under Canvas.

BEYOND Serengeti Under Canvas cannot accommodate more than four children at the camp at any given time.

Sustainability initiatives

In partnership with Wild Impact*, our long-standing community and conservation development partner.



CARE OF Land

- 228 000 plastic bottles eliminated annually through on-site water bottling plants
- 684 000 litres of water saved (3 litres used to make a 1 litre plastic bottle)
- 4 265 kg plastic eliminated annually
- Zero plastic straws
- All guest amenities recyclable
- 728 000 kg CO₂ per year reduction in our Tanzanian carbon footprint since 2018
- Over 783 million TZS invested to ensure the minimum impact of our lodges



CARE OF Wildlife

- An average 2 100 community children per year receive conservation lessons, creating awareness through education
- USD 50 000 invested as a founding member of the Lionscape Coalition, a joint initiative between members of the ecotourism industry and the Lion Recovery Fund, in a collaboration dedicated to securing a future for Africa's wild lions
- USD 25 000 of the Lionscape Coalition investment has supported two powerful lion conservation programmes in Tanzania: KopeLion and the Serengeti De-Snaring Programme.

Visiting East Africa and travelling across this vast landscape requires much thought and attention. Contact your preferred travel specialist to assist with your travel plans.

GETTING TO THE SERENGETI

Coastal Aviation, Auric Air and Regional Air Services offer daily departures from Arusha and Dar es Salaam. These flight networks link all of the major parks, reserves and Beyond lodges.

Daily non-direct flights connect the same parks, reserves and Beyond lodges to Zanzibar.

Flight networks connect to the Masai Mara via two points, one via Kilimanjaro and Wilson Airport in Nairobi, and the other via Tarime and Migori.

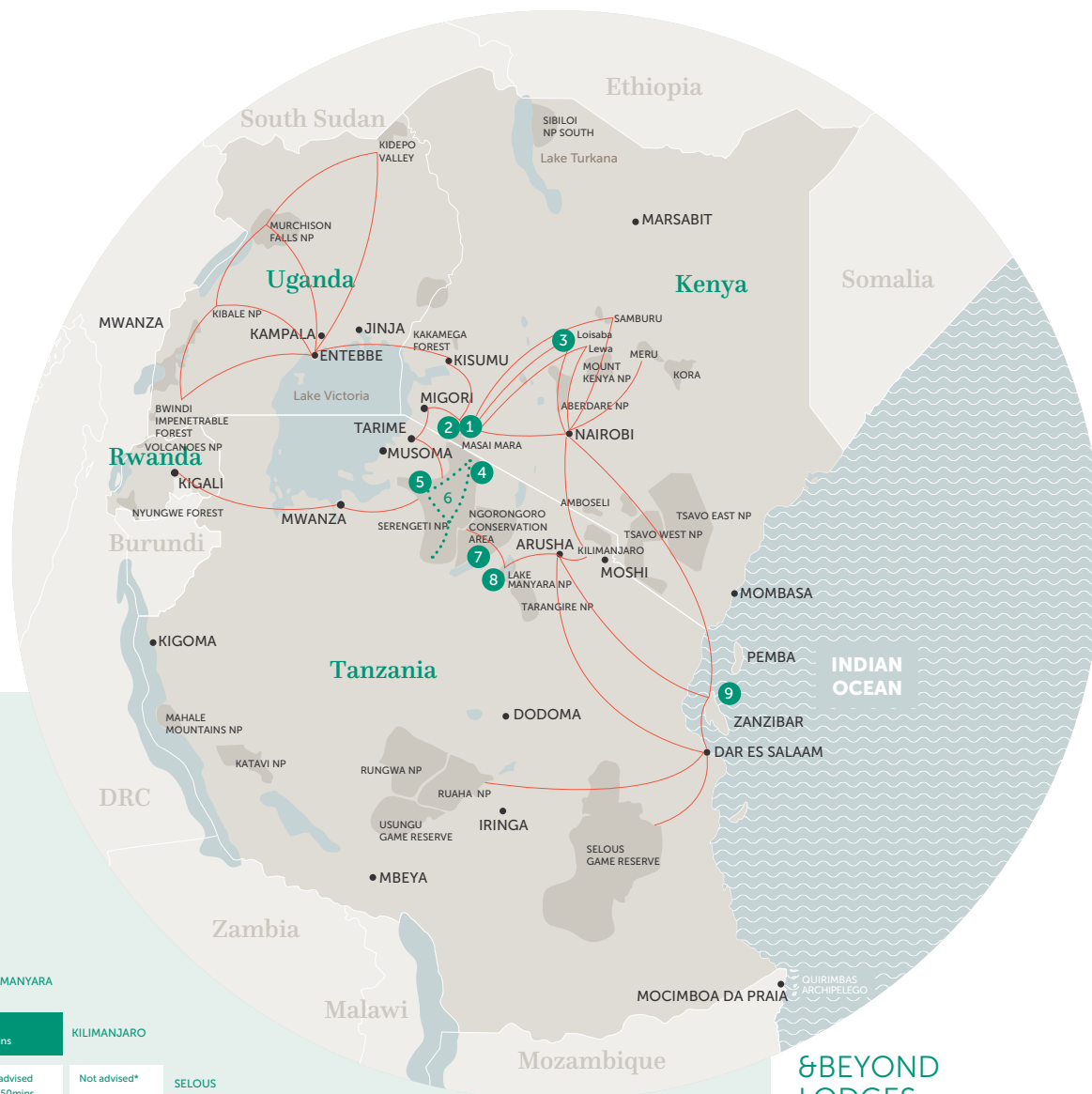
The Serengeti, Tarangire and Lake Manyara are accessible by road from Arusha.

Flights connect to Kigali via Mwanza and to Entebbe via Musoma.
