Travel Tanzania and beyond

Visiting East Africa and travelling across this vast landscape requires much thought and attention. Contact your preferred travel specialist to assist with your travel plans.

GETTING TO THE SERENGETI

Coastal Aviation, Auric Air and Regional Air Services offer daily departures from Arusha and Dar es Salaam. These flight networks link all of the major parks, reserves and Beyond lodges.

Daily non-direct flights connect the same parks, reserves and Beyond lodges to Zanzibar.

Flight networks connect to the Masai Mara via two points, one via Kilimanjaro and Wilson Airport in Nairobi, and the other via Tarime and Migori.

The Serengeti, Tarangire and Lake Manyara are accessible by road from Arusha.

Flights connect to Kigali via Mwanza and to Entebbe via Musoma.

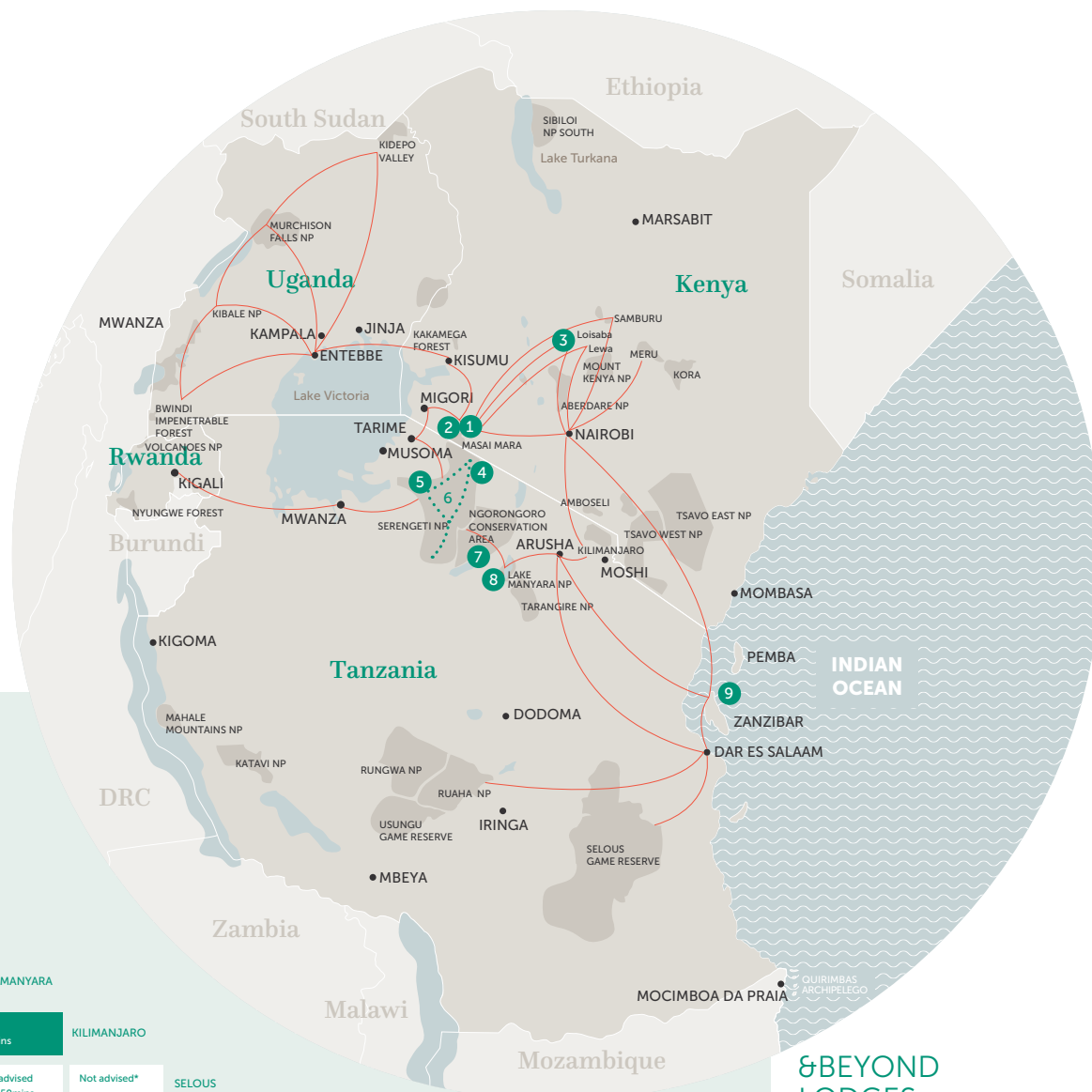

Considered the most thrilling spectacle in the animal kingdom, this epic journey migrates from Tanzania's Serengeti to Kenya's Masai Mara.

2 THE WORLD'S LARGEST OVERLAND MAMMAL MIGRATION

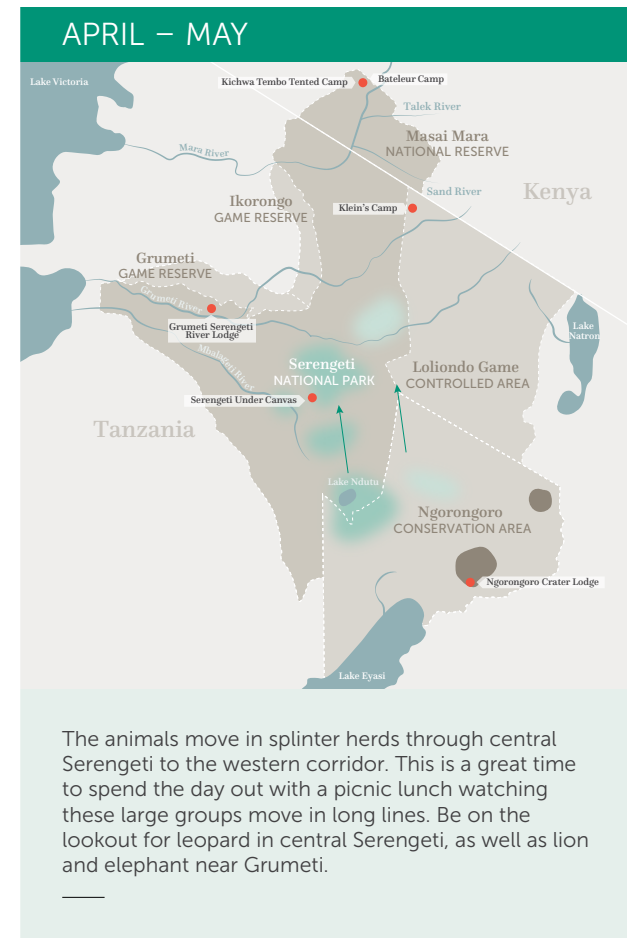
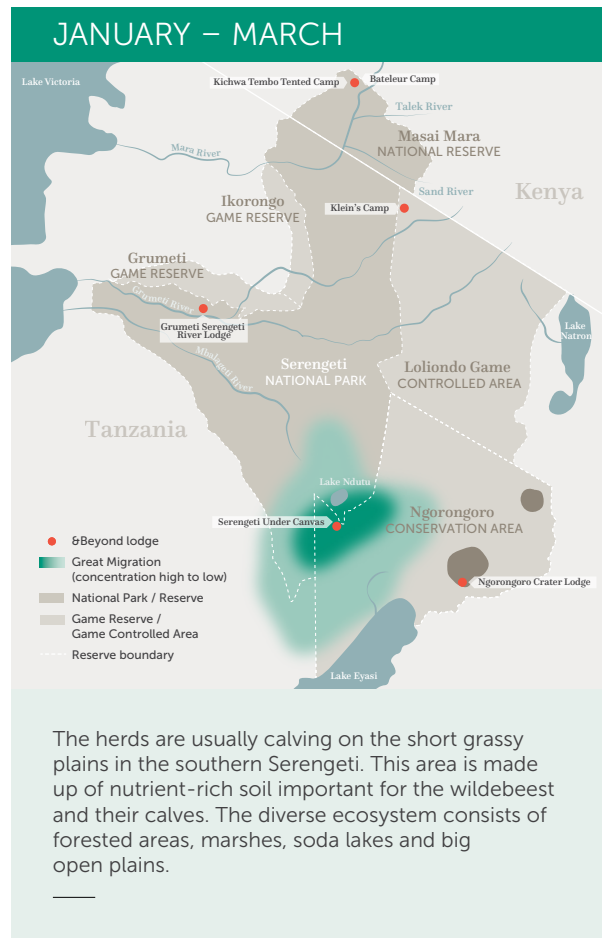
The annual movement of wildebeest and other herbivores across the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem consists of more than 1.5 million wildebeest, 500 000 zebra, 200 000 Thompson's gazelle and 18 000 eland.

3 THE ANIMALS MIGRATE OVER 800 KM (500 MI)

Due to the sheer size of the herd, the animals have to move to be able to survive. The herds generally follow the rain, as where there is rain, there is fresh grass. Once grass is depleted in one area, they will move to another grassy area.

It's estimated 500 000 wildebeest calves are born annually.

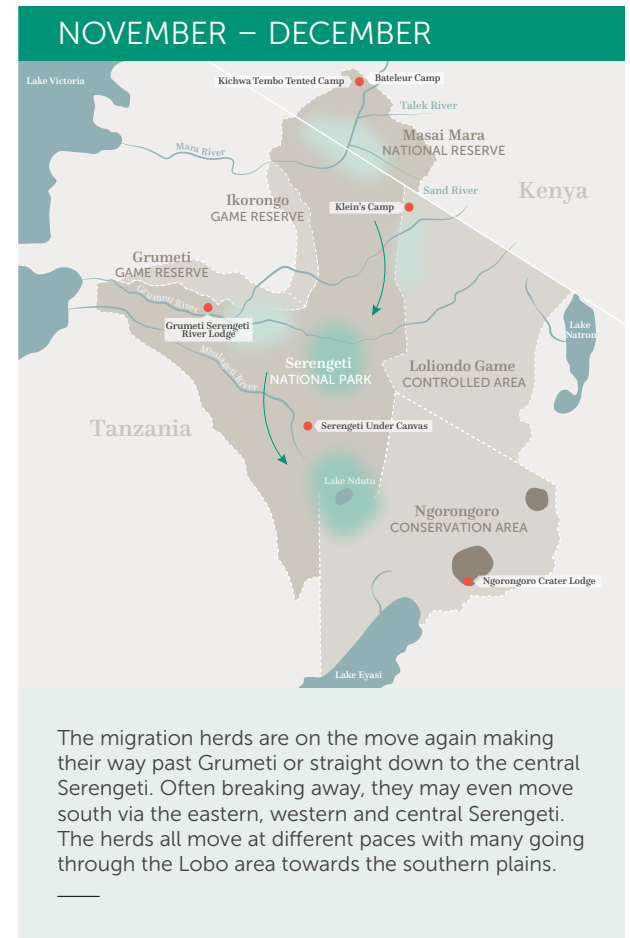
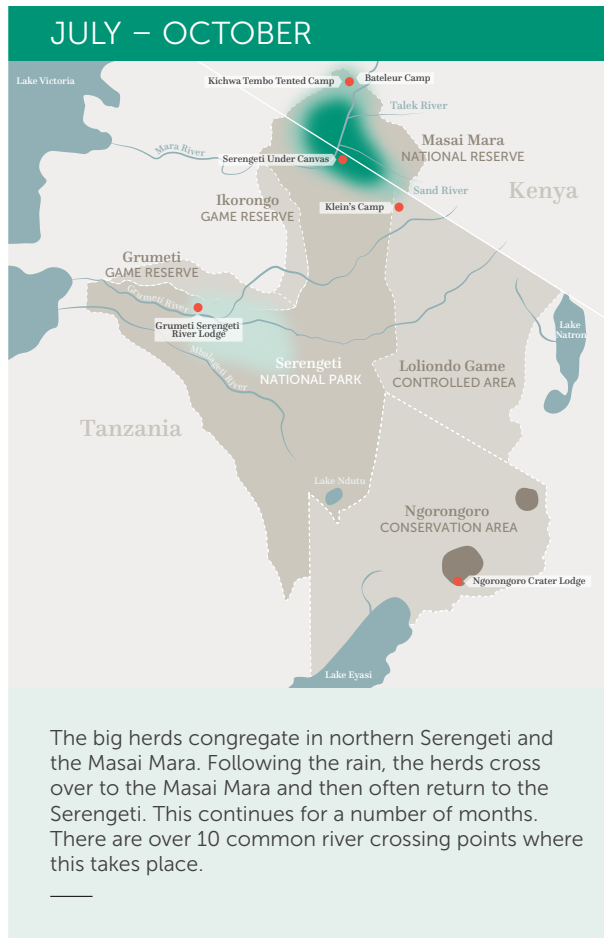
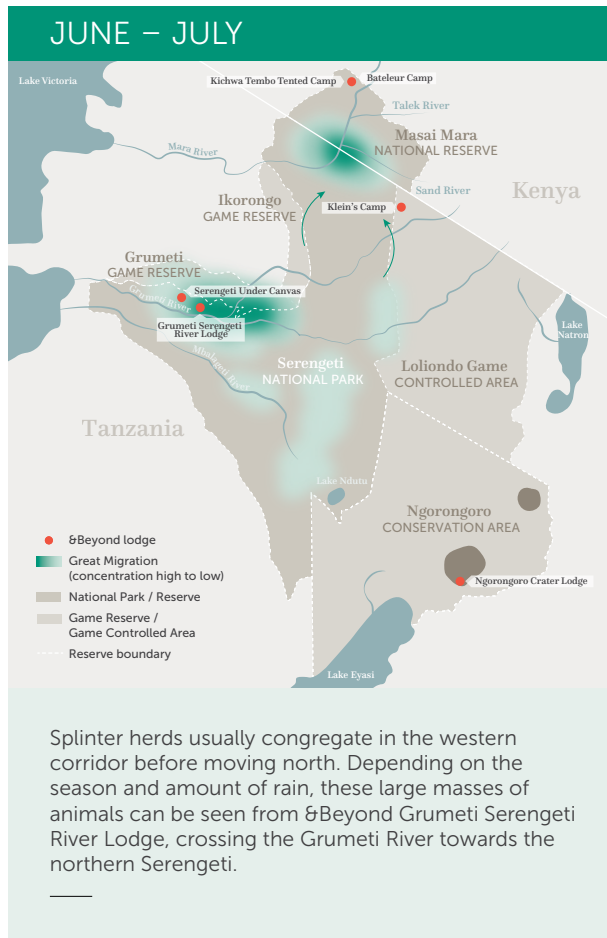
The annual movement of wildebeest and other herbivores across the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem is rarely the same in terms of precise timing and direction.



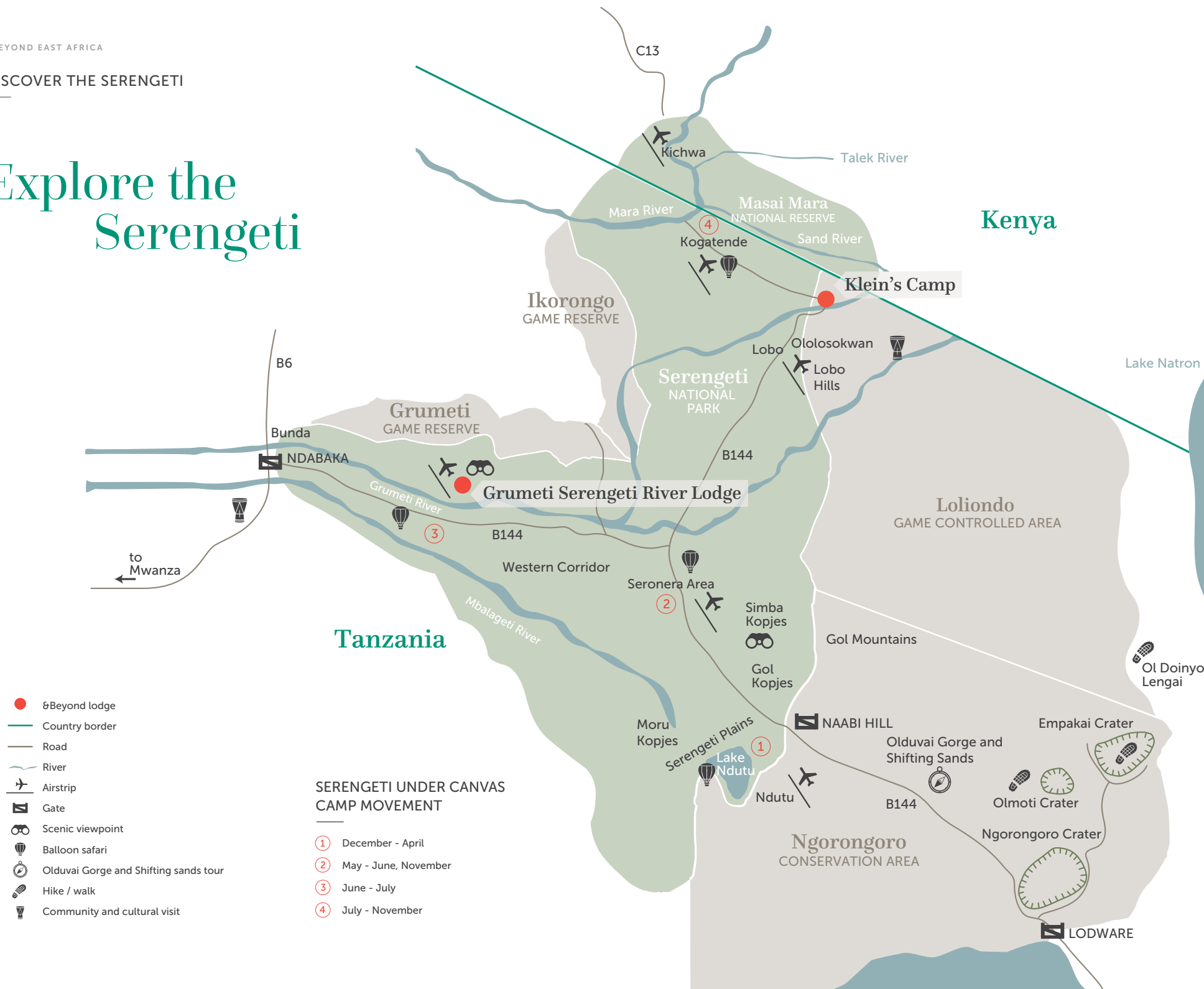

The three lodges have been specifically positioned and designed to capture the essence of the Serengeti in three extremely unique areas of the park, offering not only a varied experience, but also different accommodation options.

&BEYOND SERENGETI UNDER CANVAS

&Beyond Serengeti Under Canvas camps attempt to anticipate the movements of the Great Migration, bringing guests as close as possible to the wildebeest action, as well as exploring magnificent resident game. These camps are mobile and move five times a year. When staying here you will connect to the African bush, sitting round the camp fire at night and showering under the stars.

&BEYOND GRUMETI SERENGETI RIVER LODGE

The lodge is in the remote western reaches of the Serengeti, on the banks of a tributary of the Grumeti River. Due to its far-flung location, there are very few lodges in this pristine section of the park, which means that guests can expect the ultimate in exclusivity. This secluded part of the Serengeti has large resident lion prides and an annual topi migration, making game viewing experiences exceptional.

&BEYOND KLEIN'S CAMP

Deep in a remote corner of the game-rich Serengeti National Park, a 10 000 hectare (24 700 acre) wildlife concession leased from Maasai landlords offers guests the ultimate, exclusive Tanzanian safari. Night drives and walking safaris in the private concession allow guests to explore the nocturnal world of predators or to get an intimate glimpse into the details of the African bush.

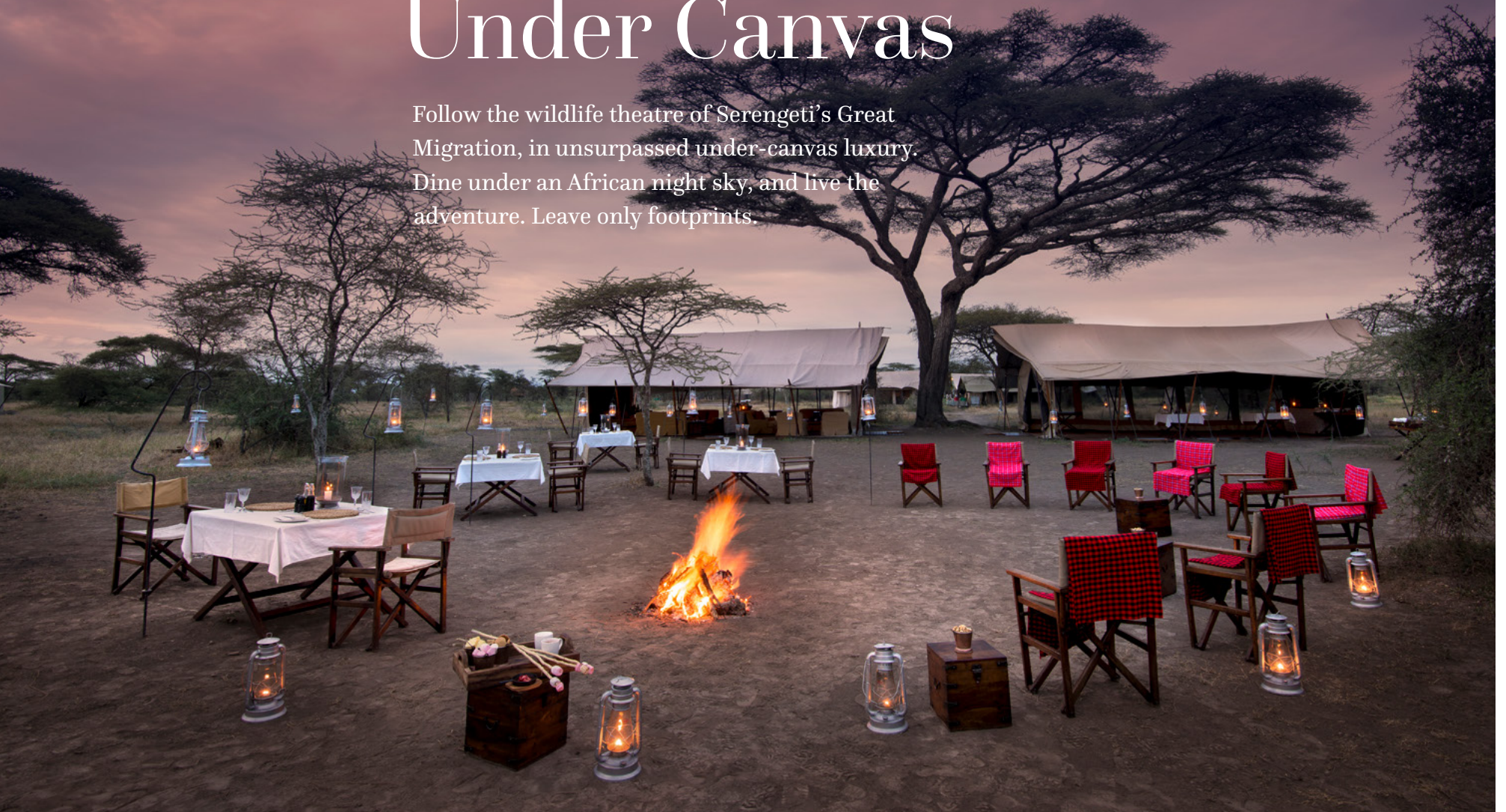

SAFARI GAME DRIVE

Game drives in the Serengeti are unforgettable due to the abundance of wildlife and the spectacular landscapes. Travellers can expect to encounter large numbers of animals year-round, with big herds of elephant, buffalo and other plains game. It is also common to see predator interaction. Game drives may last from a couple of hours to the whole day, with a picnic breakfast and lunch.



2

THE GREAT MIGRATION

The famous Great Migration is a year-round cycle in which 1.5 million wildebeest, 400 000 zebra, 300 000 Grant's and Thomson's gazelle, and 12 000 eland participate. These animals move from the dryer southern part of the ecosystem, the short-grass plains of the south eastern Serengeti, and head to the moister northern part, the northern Serengeti woodlands and the Masai Mara plains, and back again.

AL FRESCO DINING

Revel in the wide open landscapes of Africa as you savour a meal served outside (unless it is raining, in which case you are enjoying your meal in the dining tent). Your butler will always pick the perfect place for you, for example under a tree, next to the camp fire at night or the privacy of dinner for-two outside your tent.

OLDUVAI GORGE AND SHIFTING SANDS*

When the camp is in Ndutu, in the southern Serengeti, explore the breathtaking surrounds of the archaeological site of Olduvai Gorge, the cradle of mankind, best known as home of the earliest remains of Homo sapiens. Move on to the crescent-shaped volcanic ash dunes known as Shifting Sands, which slowly creep across the desert floor in response to prevailing winds.

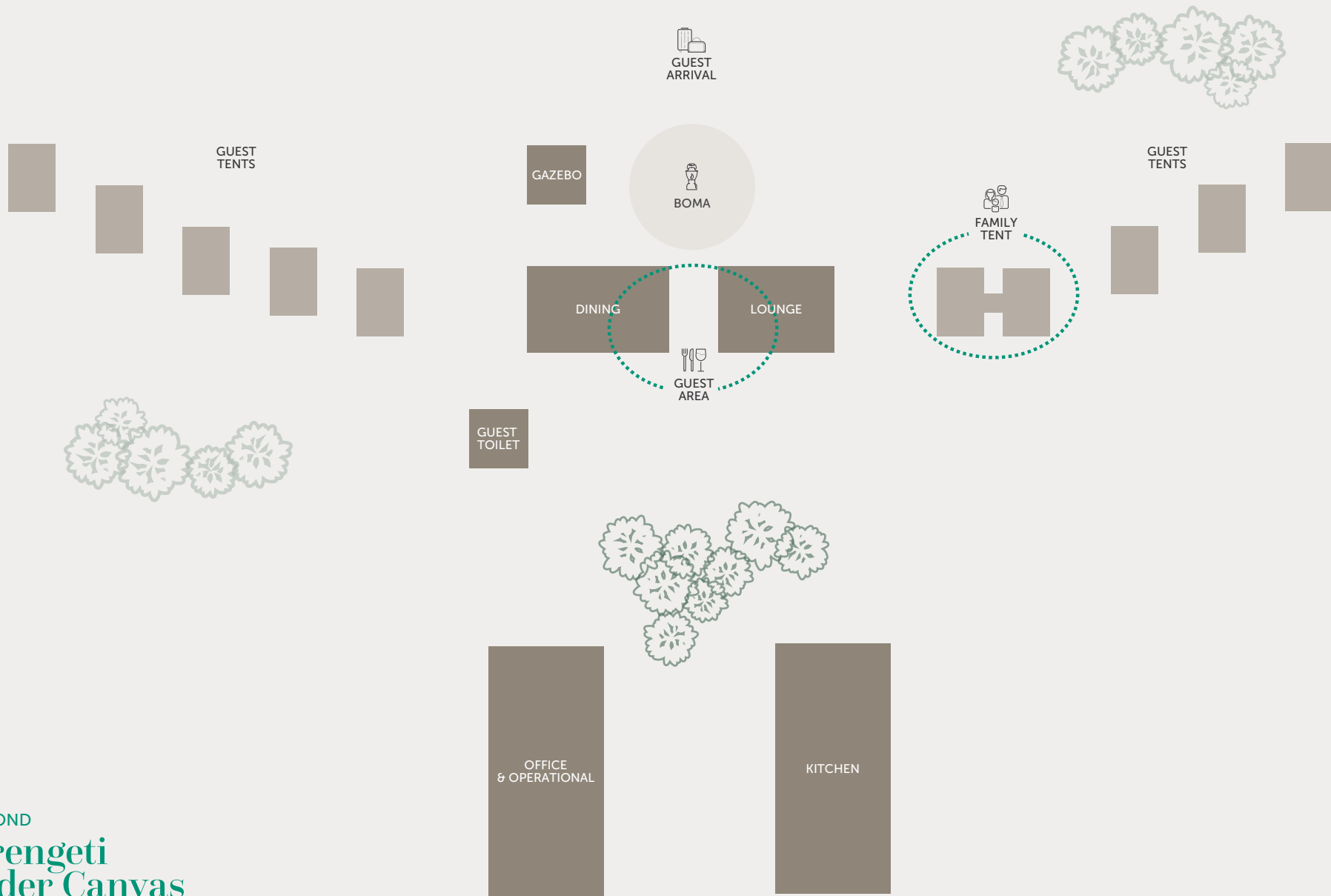

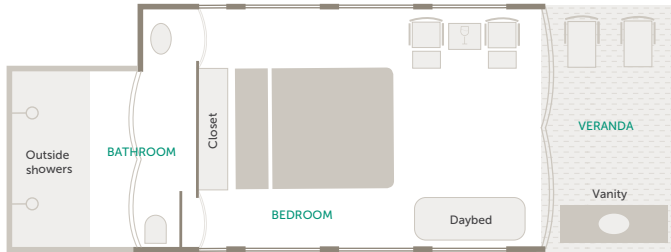

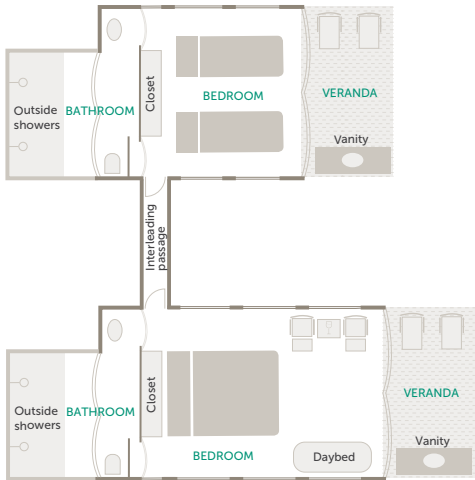

1 EXCLUSIVE AND EXCEPTIONAL YEAR-ROUND GAME VIEWING

Perhaps one of the Serengeti's best-kept secrets, wildlife lovers can enjoy their own private Serengeti in the western parts of the park. Remotely situated with far fewer crowds and vehicles, enjoy having the game-rich plains to yourself. Witness large resident prides of lion and an abundance of predators, hyena clans, buffalo, elephant, hippo and herds of plains game. This secluded area also has an annual topi migration, and the spectacular black-and-white colobus monkeys found nowhere else in the Serengeti.

2 MAGNIFICENT LION SIGHTINGS

Apart from its spectacular natural setting, this part of the Serengeti is known for its big lion prides. There are four resident prides in the area, consisting of between 20 and up to 60 lions. Our team on the ground continuously monitor the lion numbers, and you are assured excellent sightings. Not only are the opportunities for seeing lion a given, but you will more often than not find yourself viewing alone with ample time, as other vehicles are few and far between.

3 SITUATED ON THE BANKS OF A RIVER

The lodge is set in the remote western reaches of the park on a tributary of the Grumeti River. The permanent waters of the Grumeti and seasonal Mbalageti rivers attract an abundance of wildlife. Resident hippo grunt in the tranquil pools in front of the lodge while crocodiles lie, log-like, in the shallows. Meals can be enjoyed on the extensive deck with beautiful river views, while the dining area opens up to a traditional African boma, where dinner is served beneath a billion stars.

4 SUSTAINABLE DESIGN EDGED WITH LUXURY

Using the river's natural bow shape while paying homage to the circular forms of a traditional Masai Manyatta, the cultural homesteads of the Maasai people, the lodge unfolds to reveal an understated sense of luxury entrenched in sustainability. Touching the earth lightly and seemingly floating across the landscape, 10 nostalgically elegant, and very spacious, guest Suites await. Expect the ultimate in exclusivity, taking only beautiful memories home and leaving little to no footprint behind.

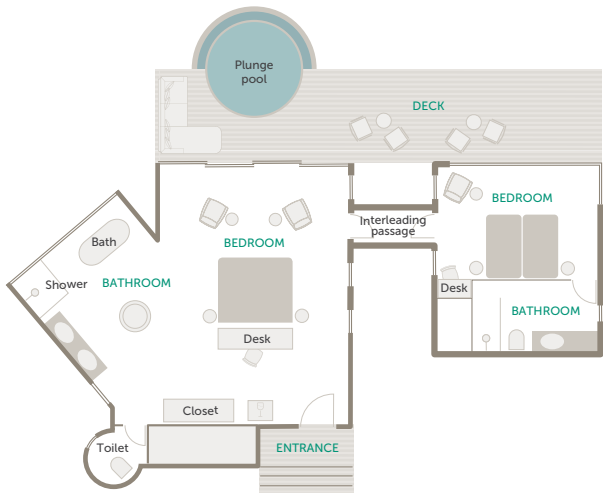

Sensitive off-road driving is permitted to allow for close wildlife viewing as well as bush walks and night drives. There are regular lion pride sightings, with no other vehicles around. 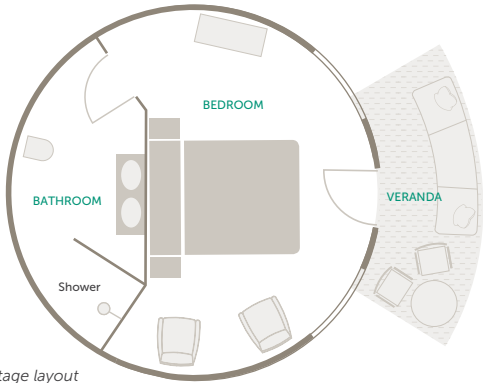

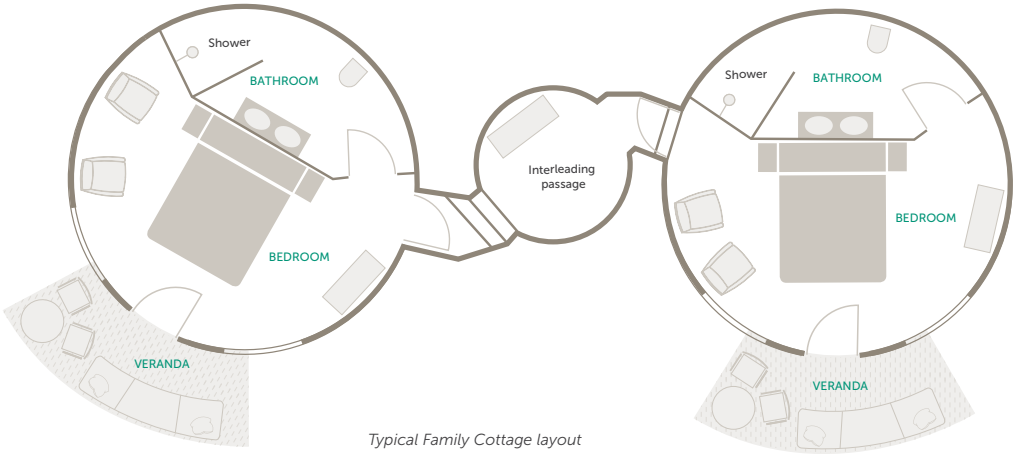
