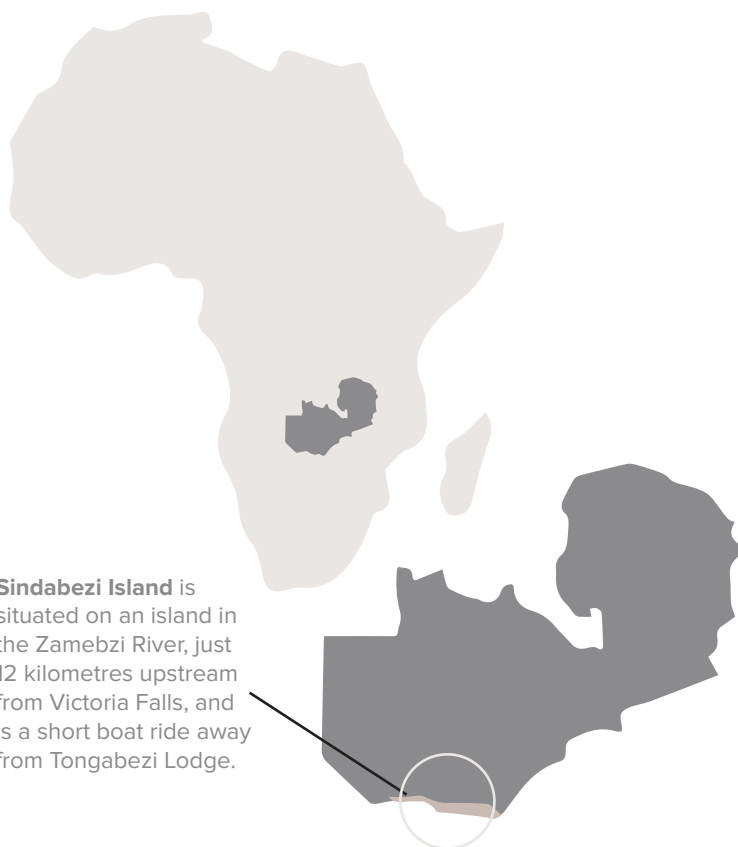

Combining the charm of a classic bush holiday with the essence of island living, Sindabezi Island Lodge offers a rejuvenating escape that's pure "nature therapy" for the soul.

Take in the stunning vistas of the Zambezi River floodplain and Victoria Falls National Park from your open-fronted Chalet, where the only company is the local wildlife. Relax in serene corners and the main camp, inviting you to unwind in the peaceful charm of this small island retreat.

As one of Africa's Top 10 Eco Lodges according to Fodor's, Sindabezi operates entirely off the grid, meaning the only marks you'll leave behind are your footprints in the island's soft sand.

Sindabezi Island is situated on an island in the Zamebzi River, just 12 kilometres upstream from Victoria Falls, and is a short boat ride away from Tongabezi Lodge.





AT A GLANCE

LOCATION	Sindabezi is an intimate camp situated on an island in the Zambezi River, 12 km upstream from Victoria Falls in Zambia. It's a short 15-minute boat ride from its sister lodge, Tongabezi.
GPS	17.8432° S, 25.7115° E
AIR & ROAD ACCESS	Several airlines have regional flights to Livingstone in Zambia (± 25 minutes by road), Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe (± 75 minutes by road), Kasane in Botswana (± 90 minutes by road and boat). Please contact reservations to arrange a transfer.
VISA	Most passports require a VISA. These can be obtained in advance or on arrival at the airport. Please note that minor's need birth certificates to go into Botswana and for Zimbabwe flight tickets need to be printed.
CURRENCY	USD cash is widely accepted in Zambia. However, banks do not accept notes issued before 2017 or any that are torn or damaged.
SEASONS	Summer: August to April. October is particularly hot. Rains: November to March. Winter: May to August (Warm days with cool evenings and mornings. Warm clothing is recommended during winter).
MALARIA	We provide mosquito nets and spray, and encourage guests to bring their own insect repellent. However, malaria is still prevalent across Zambia, so please consult your doctor for recommended prophylaxis.
YELLOW FEVER	No longer needed to transit through SA.

Established in 1992 as the smaller sister of Tongabezi, Sindabezi was created with enthusiastic collaboration from the local community. Guests can indulge in exceptional service from a dedicated, local team, knowing that every part of their experience contributes to the country, wildlife, community, and the future of this special place. Visitors are invited to explore and actively participate in Green Safaris' projects, including farming, reforestation, and education initiatives.

Sindabezi offers an exquisitely private retreat just a 30-minute drive from one of the Natural Wonders of the World. Despite the fact that Victoria Falls attracts around a million visitors each year, Sindabezi remains our best-kept secret and a cherished favourite among travel professionals.



LODGE FACILITIES

ROOMS & MAIN AREA 4 OPEN-FRONTED, THATCHED CHALETS.

- 1 open-front Honeymoon Chalet.
- All Chalets are Zambezi River-facing.
- Two Chalets have a bath and shower, three chalets can convert to a twin on request, and two chalets can take an extra bed if needed.

SECURITY	The island location itself is our security, we do have a boatman and manager on duty.



ROOM FACILITIES



EXTRA BEDS	Extra beds can be added in Chalets 4 and 5 (or converted to a triple room). Chalet 5 (Honeymoon House) can only be a double with an extra bed (no triple bed option).
FAN	Yes, in all rooms.
AC/HEATER	No.
MOSQUITO NET	Yes, in all rooms.
BATH & SHOWER	Depending on the room chosen, there is either an outdoor shower or an outdoor shower and bath.
MINI BAR	No, however, drinks and snacks can be ordered and delivered at all times (room service).
SAFE	Yes, in all rooms.
HAIRDRYER	We do not have these in all rooms due to our eco-friendly ethos, however, one can be provided on request.
LAUNDRY	Laundry services are available but may be weather dependent.
POWER	Yes. Charging plugs available.



ACTIVITIES

INCLUSIVE

- **Picnics:** Savour the stunning beauty of the Zambezi wilderness as you enjoy a delectable lunch spread or refreshing sunset drinks. Be sure to ask about our sandbar sundowners and e-Dhow lunches.
- **Boat Cruise:** At sunset or sunrise is a superb while you enjoy the stunning beauty of the Zambezi River.
- **Victoria Falls & Livingstone Island Tour:** Join us on a guided expedition where you can swim in Devil's or Angel's Pools (water-level dependent), experience lunar and daytime rainbows, and enjoy an onsite lunch. A boat will transport you to the island, where you'll embark on a guided tour. Discover its rich history, from its ancient use as a sacrificial site to its current UNESCO World Heritage status. Tours are available at various times.
- **Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park:** Game drives.
- **Fishing:** There are over 75 species of freshwater fish in this particular area (Fishing ban from 1 December to 28 February).
- **Maramba & Mkuni Village Market:** Vendors sell everything from fresh fruit and vegetables to chitenge (an African garment similar to the sarong).
- **Livingstone Museum:** During a tour of the museum, you will come across the most comprehensive memorabilia of Dr David Livingstone.

NON-INCLUSIVE

- **Microlight Flights:** 30-minute flight over the Victoria Falls.
- **Helicopter Flights:** Known as "Flight of Angels" over the falls.
- **White Water Rafting:** Full or half day options through the Zambezi gorge below the falls.
- **Chobe National Park:** A day trip to see some amazing wildlife in Botswana.
- **Rhino Walk:** A walking safari in Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park.

DOING GOOD

TONGABEZI TRUST SCHOOL

Tongabezi Trust School, also known as Tujatane—meaning “let us all hold hands together”—was established in 1996 with the generous support of contributors from around the world. The school relies entirely on donations, primarily from Tongabezi guests. Visitors are warmly invited to tour the school, interact with our 280 bright and talented students, and witness the impact of the free education and nutritious meals they receive. If you choose to do just one meaningful activity during your stay at Tongabezi, we highly recommend a visit to Tujatane.

TWAABANE CREATIVE CENTRE

The Twaabane Creative Centre, a project by the Tongabezi Trust School Team, is excited to showcase its vibrant and joyful space. Designed to impart creative, artisanal, and practical skills, the centre benefits both children and adults in our Simonga Community. Whether you're interested in learning sewing or sustainable farming, or if you have skills you'd like to share, we invite you to join a class or arrange a lesson in advance.

MUKUNI COMMUNITY FARM

Come and explore our 12.6 hectares of sweetveld, which is evolving into a fully sustainable, community-run organic farm. Our team is eager to share their knowledge of sustainable farming techniques, including alley cropping, grazing rotation, and the use of homemade fertilisers and organic pesticides. You'll have the opportunity to compare these methods with traditional farming practices and see firsthand the benefits they offer. This innovative approach not only reduces costs and benefits the environment but also yields higher harvests. Located on your way to Victoria Falls, the Mukuni Community farm is a great addition to other town-based activities.

SIMONGA VILLAGE

The tours within Simonga Village provide a joyous opportunity for guests to learn, engage and share stories with our wonderful community. One of our local team will lead the tour, which is conducted in a respectful manner, and will introduce you to people who they know are happy to chat with the group. We encourage you to take the time to get to know the people you meet and to listen to the stories that they have to tell. This is an unforgettable way to experience a small slice of local Zambian life.

WOMEN IN TOURISM IN PARTNERSHIP WITH AFRICAN BUSH CAMPS

The Women in Tourism Programme, offers a 9-month internship for young women from Livingstone aged 18–22. The initiative is designed to build practical skills, create employment opportunities, and empower women from disadvantaged backgrounds to pursue careers in the tourism industry.
