



FACT SHEET

TUMAREN CAMP | LAIKIPIA | NO. 27.194 E36 57.444

Tumaren Camp is located on a 13,000 acre conservancy within the larger conservation and community area of Laikipia. The camp faces South West and overlooks a wide open plain with a waterhole and salt lick. Each group has their own guide throughout the stay.

FACILITIES

- Seven spacious, en-suite safari tents with private verandas.
- Three tents left of the communal area and four to the right.
- Private entrances with flexible bedding options, including baby cots are available upon request.
- Flush toilets and constant hot running water.
- Four tents feature interior dividers for added privacy.
- Main sitting room with guest toilet.
- Main dining room.
- Private dining & sitting room (Tent 8) for families or private meals.
- Tents 6 & 7 can be booked together with Tent 8 for an exclusive use area.
- 20 m swimming pool with large pool house, bar, changing room, bathroom and shower.
- Meals can also be served poolside.
- On-site shop.
- Private airstrip within walking distance of camp.
- Guest Wi-Fi available at the office Wi-Fi tent as we do not have Wi-Fi in the main camp.

ACCOMMODATION

- Tent 1 – Divider; 1 double + 1 single bed
- Tent 2 – 1 double bed
- Tent 3 – 1 double + 1 single + optional day bed
- Tent 4 – 1 double bed
- Tent 5 – Divider; 1 double + 2 singles + optional day bed
- Tent 6 – Divider; 1 double + 2 singles
- Tent 7 – Divider; 1 double + 2 singles

ACTIVITIES

- Guests plan each day with their guide (info pack in tents and communal area)
- Guided walks of any length with armed guide
- Camel rides and visits to the camel crèche
- Day and night game drives
- Top-rope rock climbing, beginner to advanced, with guides and gear
- Wildlife tracking on foot
- Birdwatching
- Swim in the 20 m pool or paddle in the river
- Picnics and sundowners / Bush Breakfasts, Lunches or Dinners
- Visits to local schools we support (We supplementally feed 1,100 children)
- Ultimate frisbee and football
- Jogging with a guide.
- Visits to local markets and homesteads
- Beading sessions

GETTING TO TUMAREN

Private charter to Tumaren airstrip - 2 min drive / walking distance to camp

Schedule flights: Loisaba - 1.5 hours and Nanyuki 2.5 hours

Drive: 2 hours from Nanyuki and 6 hours from Nairobi
