



From Johannesburg (JHB)

- When coming out from the airport, take the Boksburg turn off (not Pretoria/Johannesburg) and travel for approximately 3kms and then take the N12 turnoff and travel past Benoni towards eMalaheni (Witbank), where it connects to the N4 coming from Pretoria
- Continue on the N4 towards Nelspruit (we suggest going via Schoemanskloof as it is very scenic and less trucks)
- Continue on the N4 bypassing Nelspruit towards Maputo (Mozambique), 61kms from Nelspruit pass through the town of Malelane, travel 3kms and turn left to the Malelane gate, Kruger National Park
- Enter the Kruger Park at the Malelane Gate
- Continue 4 km on the tarred road until you reach the S114. You will see the sign to Lukimbi on the left hand side of the road
- Turn right on to the S114. Continue for 7 kms then branch off to the right on the S25
- Take the S25 for 6 kms
- Cross over the Mlambane River causeway – this is the main watercourse
- A further 1.6 kms down the road there is a turn off to the left with the Lukimbi logo, as well as an official sign on the right hand side. This is the access road to Lukimbi. Continue on this road for 7 kms until you reach the entrance to the Lodge.

From Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport (KMIA)

Via the Malelane Gate of the Kruger National Park

- As you come out of the airport, drive to the T-Junction and turn left on to the R538 to Nelspruit. Continue on this road, cross over the 4 ways stop, until you see the N4 and turn left here to Malelane. The N4 is a toll road with a tollgate near Malelane
- Travel for 48 kms on the N4 to Malelane
- Pass the town of Malelane, travel for 3 kms and then turn left to the Malelane Gate, Kruger National Park.
- Enter the Kruger Park at the Malelane Gate
- Continue on the tarred road until you reach the S114. You will see the sign to Lukimbi on the left-hand side of the road
- Turn right on to the S114
- Continue for 7 kms then branch off to the right on the S25
- Travel for 6 kms on the S25
- Cross the Mlambane River
- A further 1.6 kms down the road there is a turn off to the left with the Lukimbi logo, as well as an official sign on the right-hand side. This is the access road to Lukimbi. Continue on this road for 7 kms until you reach the entry to the Lodge.

Points to remember: There are **three toll gates on the N4**. The first is at Middelburg, the second at Machadadorp and the final at Malelane (Nkomazi Plaza). There is an **entrance fee per person to the Kruger Park**. The lodge is 445kms from Johannesburg.

The lodge telephone number is +27 (13) 735 8000. If you have any problems, please telephone Sean or Shelley at the lodge and they will be able to help you. The lodge is in cell phone range.

If you need a toilet or coffee stop, Milly's is just before the Machado Plaza and is approximately 2 hours from Johannesburg.





From Skukuza Camp

- At the intersection, continue straight on the H1-1 and drive for 13 kms where you turn left on the H3 in the direction of Malelane and Berg-en-Dal.
- Continue for a further 25 kms until you reach the Afsaal picnic site.
- Travel for a further 1 km until you see a dirt road (H2-2) on your left.
- Turn here and travel for 8 kms until you reach the S114 "T" junction.
- Turn right at this point and continue on the S114 for 5kms passing the James picnic spot and the S118 will be on your right.
- Shortly after passing the S118, you will come to the S119 where you will turn left – towards Gardinia Hide.
- Travel on the S119 for a further 6 kms until the road meets the S25.
- At this point turn left and continue on the S25, cross the Mlambane River and a further 1.6 kms you will see a road to your left.
- This is the turn off to Lukimbi. (go past the no entry sign, you are over night guests).
- Turn on to this road and the lodge will be reached after 7kms.

From Crocodile Bridge Gate

- Enter the Kruger Park at the Crocodile Bridge Gate.
- Travel on the H4-2 for 2 kms then turn left onto the S25.
- Travel for 20km, pass the turn off to Biyamiti on the right and travel for a further 16 km.
- Then turn off to the right into the Lukimbi Safari Lodge access road, which has the Lukimbi logo as well as an official sign on the left hand side.
- Continue on this road for 7 kms until you reach the entrance to the Lodge.

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From Hoedspruit

There are two alternatives travelling from Hoedspruit to Lukimbi, either through the Park or going around:

Option 1 (Going around the Park)

- Travel 93 kms from Hoedspruit to Hazyview on the R40. Continue on the R40 for 47 kms to White River and then for 19 kms on the R537 to Nelspruit.
- In Nelspruit turn left onto the N4 and travel for 61 kms to Malelane – 3 kms past the town turn left to the Malelane Gate, Kruger National Park.
- Enter the park and travel on the tar road until the S114. Turn right onto the S114 and travel for 7 kms, then turn onto the S25 at the fork and travel 6 kms.
- Cross the Mlambane River causeway and after 1.6 kms turn left onto the Lukimbi access road. Travel for 7 kms to the lodge.
- The total distance is ± 245 kms.

Option 2 (Going Through the Park)

- Travel 93 kms to Hazyview and then turn onto the R536 and travel 42 km to the Paul Kruger Gate.
- Enter the Kruger Park and travel 12 kms on the H11 to the 4 way intersection. Turn right onto the H1-1 and continue on the H1-1 and drive for 13 kms where you turn left on the H3 in the direction of Malelane and Berg-en-Dal.
- Continue for a further 25 kms until you reach the Afsaal picnic site. Travel for a further 1 km until you see a dirt road (H2-2) on your left. Turn here and travel for 8 kms until you reach the S114 "T" junction.
- Turn right at this point and continue on the S114 for 5kms passing the James picnic spot and the S118 will be on your right. Shortly after passing the S118, you will come to the S119 where you will turn left.
- Travel on the S119 for a further 6 kms until the road meets the S25. At this point turn left and continue on the S25, cross the Mlambane River and after a further 1.6 kms you will see a road to your left.
- This is the turn off to Lukimbi. Turn on to this road and the lodge will be reached after 7kms.
- Total distance 135 kms outside the park and 84 within the park.



From Komatipoort Border Post (Mozambique)

Via the Malelane Gate of the Kruger National Park

- Travel 92 km on the EN4 toll road towards Ressano Garcia and the Lebombo border post.
- From Komatipoort, travel 41kms on the N4 towards Malelane/Nelspruit. 3 kms before Malelane, turn to the left off the N4, then left again and then right to the Malelane Gate, Kruger National Park. Enter the Kruger Park at the Malelane Gate.
- Continue on the tarred road until you reach the S114. You will see the sign to Lukimbi on the left hand side of the road.
- Turn right on to the S114.
- Continue for 7 kms then branch off to the right on the S25. Travel for 6 kms on the S25. Cross the Mlambane River.
- A further 1.6 kms down the road there is a turn off to the left with the Lukimbi logo, as well as an official sign on the right hand side. This is the access road to Lukimbi.
- Continue on this road for 7 kms until you reach the entry to the Lodge.

From Idube Game Reserve

Via the Paul Kruger Gate of the Kruger National Park

- Depart from Idube and travel to Newington Gate (7kms).
- Continue to tar road (12 kms) (R536).
- Turn left and continue to Paul Kruger Gate (4kms).
- Once inside the Kruger Park, drive for 12 kms until a 4-way intersection is reached. At the intersection, turn right on the H1-1 and drive for 13 kms where you turn left on the H3 in the direction of Malelane and Berg-en-Dal.
- Continue for a further 25 kms until you reach the Afsaal picnic site. Travel for a further 1 km until you see a dirt road (H2-2) on your left. Turn here and travel for 8 kms until you reach the S114 "T" junction.
- Turn right at this point and continue on the S114 for 5kms passing the James picnic spot and the S118 will be on your right. Shortly after passing the S118, you will come to the S119 where you will turn left.
- Travel on the S119 for a further 6 kms until the road meets the S25. At this point turn left and continue on the S25, cross the Mlambane River and after a further 1.6 kms you will see a road to your left.
- This is the turn off to Lukimbi. Turn on to this road and the lodge will be reached after 7kms.
- The total distance from Idube to Lukimbi is 102 kms and assuming an average speed of 40 kph, the journey will take 3 hours.
