Natural Simplicity & Ocean Serenity

Set within 50 acres of lush, tropical beachfront gardens on Zanzibar's pristine northwest coast, Kilindi is a spectacular sanctuary of "barefoot luxury."



Originally designed for Benny Andersson of the legendary 1970s pop group ABBA, Kilindi Zanzibar is a rare architectural masterpiece that beautifully blends Scandinavian minimalism with Middle Eastern and Swahili heritage. This unique style comes to life in the iconic, white-domed pavilions, which feature an eco-conscious, "open-to-nature" design. With large windows and wooden-slatted shutters, the architecture allows the gentle ocean breeze to flow freely, fully immersing guests in the sensory rhythms of the island.

Private Oases

Each standalone pavilion acts as its own private sanctuary, complete with a personal plunge pool, a dedicated private butler, and an annexed outdoor, sky-lit "rainfall" shower.

Adults-Only Tranquility

To maintain a serene, intimate environment perfect for honeymooners and couples, the resort operates under a strict adults-only policy.

Freedom Dining

There are no set dining times or rigid venues. Guests can choose to have their fresh, spice-infused cuisine served on the main alfresco terrace, beside the 25-meter infinity pool, or right on the beach.

Simple Perfection

The pavilion villas at Kilindi Zanzibar are a masterful blend of open-air design and understated luxury. Each spacious pavilion features a striking white-domed structure that frames panoramic views of the turquoise ocean, passing dhows, and lush tropical gardens. It is an immersive sanctuary where the ancient rhythm of the island meets the refined comfort of your own coastal hideaway.

Historical Stone Town Tour

Discover the atmospheric, narrow alleyways of this celebrated UNESCO World Heritage site. Wander past bustling bazaars and intricately carved wooden doors as your guide takes you on a journey through history, visiting iconic landmarks like the vibrant city market, the Sultan's Palace, and the Old Fort.

Spice Tour

Venture into the lush countryside to explore the exotic spice farms that gave Zanzibar its name. Touch, smell, and taste raw cinnamon, nutmeg, and vanilla, sample fresh tropical fruits, and discover historic ruins alongside the famous Kidichi Persian Baths.

Jozani Forest Tour

Traverse Zanzibar's last remaining indigenous woodland, a vibrant ecosystem of coastal bushland, mangroves, and salt marshes. Accompanied by an expert guide, you will spot diverse birdlife, butterflies, and the rare, endangered Red Colobus Monkey endemic to this forest.

Prison Island Tour

Take a scenic 20-minute boat ride from Stone Town to Changuu Island to meet its famous residents, the giant Aldabra tortoises. Learn about the island's history as a former slave prison and quarantine station before enjoying its beautiful beach and coral reef.

Nakupenda Tour

Spend a blissful morning on Nakupenda "I love you", a pristine, white-sand bank enveloped by crystalline blue waters. Perfect for swimming, snorkelling, and sunbathing, this exclusive excursion culminates in a sumptuous seafood barbecue lunch prepared right on the beach.

Sunset Dhow Cruise

Snorkelling

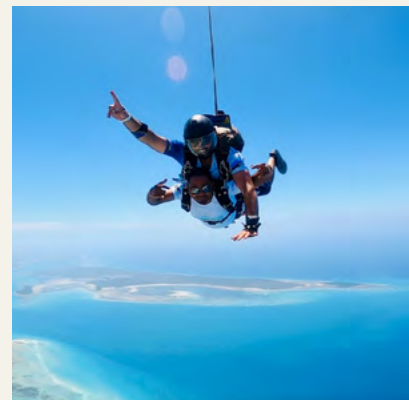

Safari Blue Tour

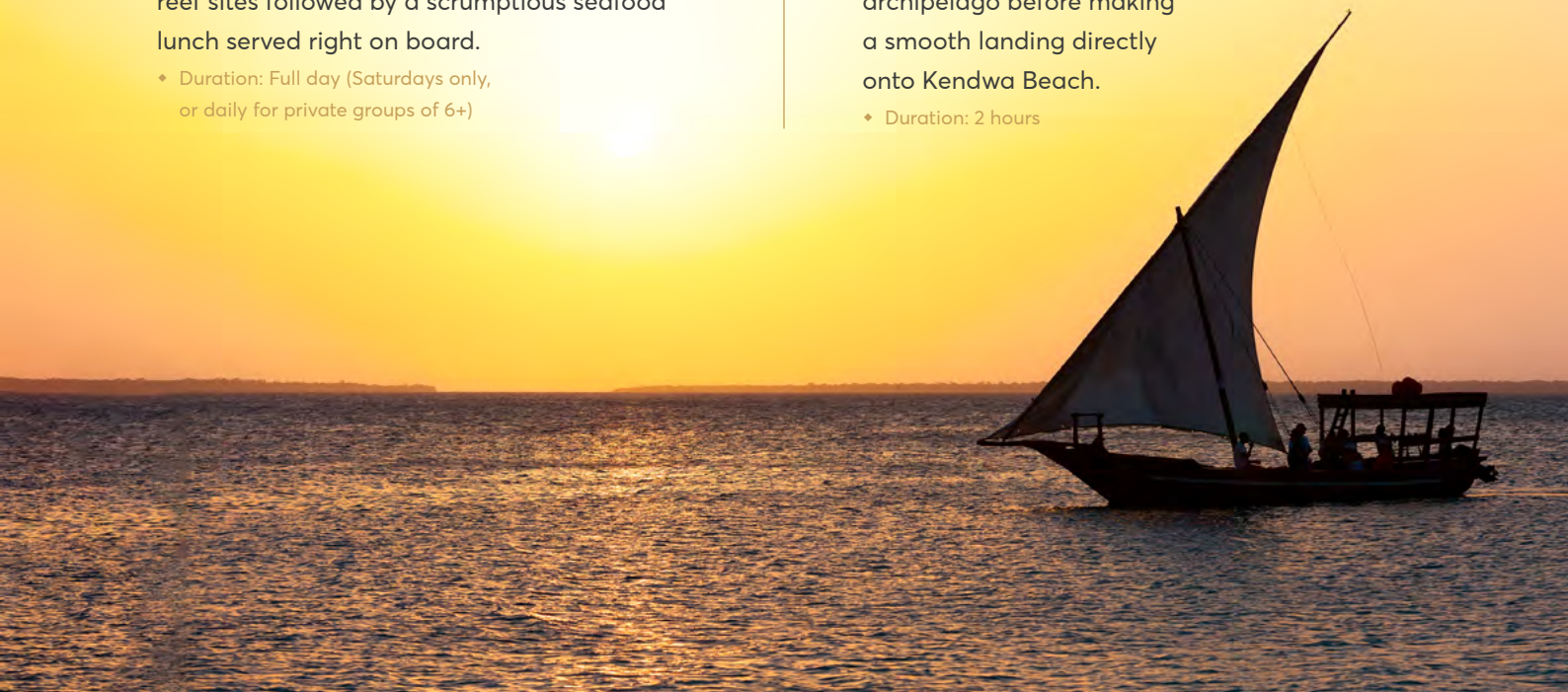
