Exceptional Game Viewing

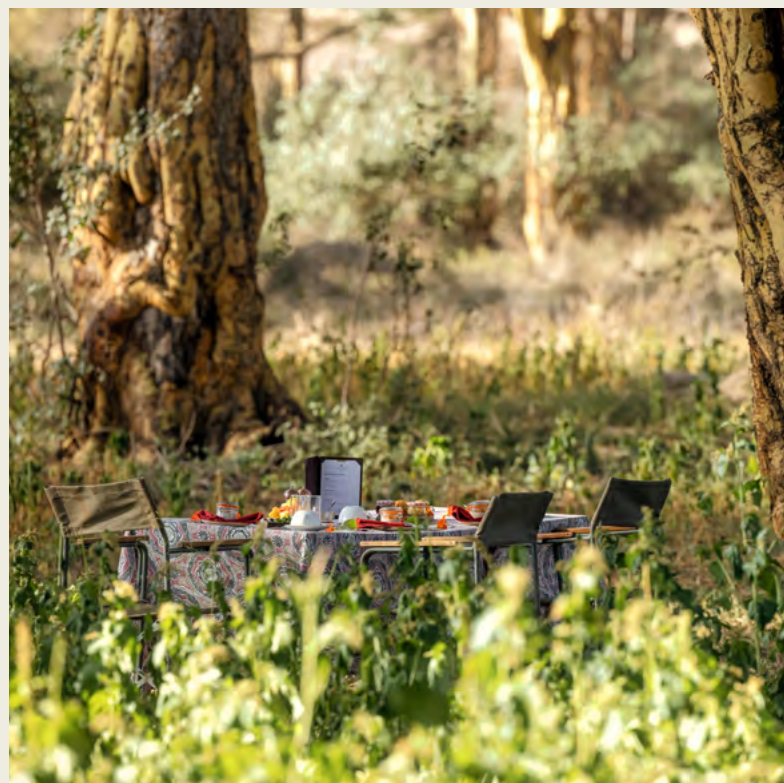
Lewa is home to over 10% of Kenya's black rhinos and 15% of its white rhinos, alongside the world's largest single population of the critically endangered Grevy's zebra. The conservancy offers unparalleled game viewing, including frequent encounters with the iconic Big Five.

Re-crafted with quiet intention

The camp's recent refurbishment enhances guest comfort while thoughtfully preserving its authentic safari character. Elegant interiors are inspired by the warm colours, natural textures, and timeless spirit of the surrounding plains.

Low-Density Tourism Model

Strictly controlled vehicle access throughout the conservancy ensures a low-density, highly exclusive safari experience. This careful management eliminates crowding at wildlife sightings, providing a pristine and unhurried wilderness environment.





Classic Safari Sophistication

The tents at Lewa Safari Camp are a masterful blend of traditional canvas charm and modern luxury, set on raised concrete bases finished with elegant Herringbone Mazeras stone beneath the shade of ancient trees. Designed to offer an immersive connection to the landscape, each spacious tent features thatched roofs and private verandahs that invite the sights and sounds of the wild. It is a refined sanctuary where the adventurous spirit of the plains meets the quiet comfort of a classic safari home.

- ◆ 11 Safari Tents (27m²)

Spacious en-suite canvas tents featuring private verandahs - comprising 8 doubles/twins and 3 triples.

- ◆ 2 Family Suites (64m²)

Generous family layouts consisting of two en-suite safari tents linked by a shared verandah.

The tents are strategically spaced to ensure maximum privacy, allowing cooling breezes and the distant calls of the conservancy to create a soulful backdrop to your stay.

Lewa Safari Camp is an iconic sanctuary of authentic luxury, nestled in the heart of the pioneering Lewa Wildlife Conservancy. It is a place where the storied history of Kenyan conservation comes to life, offering an unparalleled perspective over a landscape defined by its thriving rhino populations and rare northern wildlife.



Track a pride of lions across the rolling plains,
witness the rare Grevy's zebra gathering at the
waterhole, or enjoy a sunset cocktail in the
bush as the golden light fades over the peaks of
Mount Kenya.



Activities

Select activities and excursions require advance booking and may carry additional charges. Should you have any questions or require further information, our team is available to assist.

Game Drives

Set out on morning or evening drives with expert guides across Lewa's rolling plains, tracking the Big Five and rare Northern Special Five in world-class conservation territory.

Walking Safaris

Discover the intricate details of the bush on foot alongside armed guides, learning to track wildlife, identify indigenous flora, and read the subtle language of the land.

(Minimum age 16 years).

Meet the Tracker Dogs

Go behind the scenes with Lewa's renowned anti-poaching unit to see how highly trained tracker dogs play a vital role in protecting the conservancy's species.

Ngare Ndare Forest Walk

Explore ancient indigenous canopy walks, suspended bridges, and hidden waterfalls in Ngare Ndare Forest, with opportunities to swim in crystal-clear pools and enjoy forest picnics.

Sundowners

Relax with chilled cocktails and gourmet bites at a scenic vantage point as Mount Kenya's shadow stretches across the horizon during a classic safari tradition.

Night Game Drives

Spot elusive nocturnal species on a spot-lit evening drive, watching the conservancy transform into a world of bustling activity under starlit skies.

Horse & Camel Riding

Traverse the plains on horseback to quietly blend in with plains game herds, or enjoy a charming, traditional camel ride across golden grasslands for a unique view.

(Minimum age 12 years).

Wellness & Relaxation

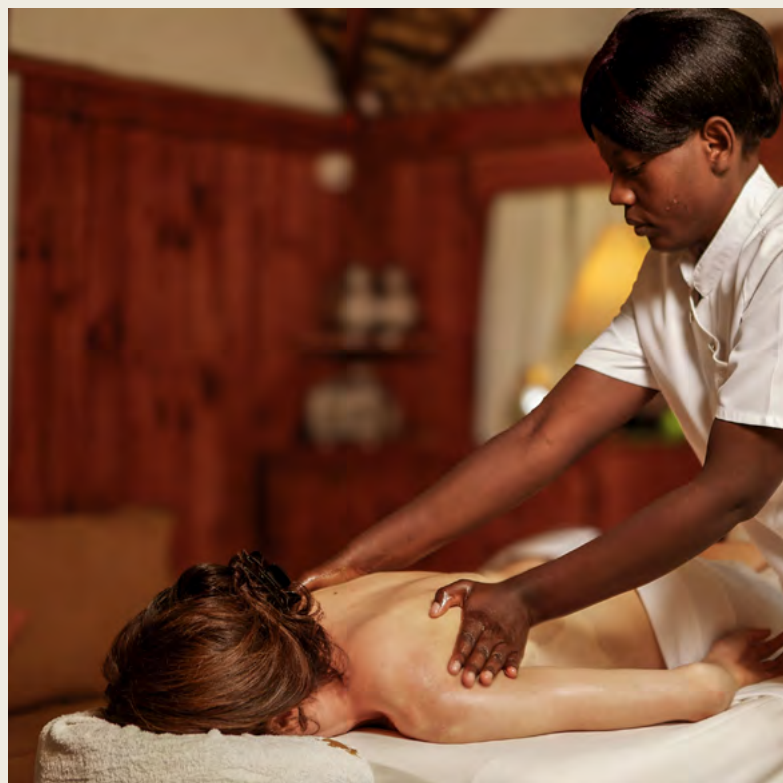
Unwind in the swimming pool overlooking a private waterhole, or indulge in soothing massage treatments framed by the peaceful sounds of our manicured gardens.

As dusk falls, evenings center around the roaring campfire where chefs prepare sizzling snacks over a traditional Jiko fire. The day concludes with elegant, candlelit dinners under a dazzling canopy of African stars, sharing stories of the day's safari adventures.

Sustainability & Conservation

Lewa Safari Camp operates as a low-impact safari camp driven by solar energy, circular waste management, and deep community partnerships across the Lewa Wildlife Conservancy.

Environmental Stewardship

- ♦ **Accreditations:** Certified with a Gold Eco-Rating by Ecotourism Kenya, anchored by solar energy with carbon tracking and traditional low-impact refrigeration.
- ♦ **Resource & Circular Waste Management:** Zero-tolerance single-use plastic policy, off-site solid waste recycling via TakaTaka Solutions, and on-site composting to fertilise our organic culinary gardens.
- ♦ **Wilderness Protection:** Partnering with the Lewa Wildlife Conservancy to protect endangered wildlife and maintain low-impact safari operations across the landscape.



Community & Local Legacy

- ♦ **Healthcare & Clean Water:** Collaborating with partners and the conservancy to support vital rural healthcare initiatives, school supplies, and women's micro-enterprise programs.
- ♦ **Lewa Safari Marathon & School Support:** Sponsoring races at the annual Lewa Safari Marathon while donating indigenous tree seedlings and medical supplies to clinics.
- ♦ **Youth & Conservation Mentorship:** Conducting school mentorship talks, environmental education, and interactive conservation days for local students to empower the next generation of leaders.
