



## LOCATION

Coral Lodge is situated in the Northern part of Mozambique, **Nampula Province**, in close proximity to Ilha de Mozambique (Mozambique Island), the only UNESCO World Heritage site in Mozambique.

The lodge lies in an area called **Mossuril Bay**. The nearest airports are **Nampula, Nacala, and Lumbo (Airstrip)**.



The most frequently used airport is Nampula, which is approximately 2 1/2 hours drive to the Island of Ilha de Mozambique, from which we continue with a 30 - 40 minute boat ride to Coral Lodge.

### ABOUT LAGOON VILLAS

The **100m<sup>2</sup> elegant Lagoon Villas** are **perched above the crystal-clear waters of the lagoon** that winds itself through the mangroves below. Each Villa has a **King size bed**, which leads onto an open plan lounge area, and a **private deck**. The en-suite bathroom has a **separate bath and shower**, with his and hers basins, as well as an **additional outdoor shower**.

The Lagoon Villas enjoy the **perfect position to watch the sun set** upon paradise. A nature lover's ideal location.

### ABOUT BEACH VILLAS

The **100m<sup>2</sup> elegant Beach Villas** are both spacious and airy, with **ocean views that stretch for miles**. ### WHALE WATCHING

If you are interested in learning about the Macua people of northern Mozambique. We can take you to visit the three local communities: Cabaceira Pequena, Cabaceira Grande and Chocas. Most of Coral Lodge staff live in Cabaceira Pequena and walk or canoe to the Lodge each day. You can visit one of their houses, the Vasco da Gama Well and the graves and ruins of an Arab community from the 12th century.

### VISIT ILHA DE MOZAMBIQUE

A visit to Ilha de Moçambique is a 'must' during your stay at Coral Lodge. The former capital of Mozambique built by the Portuguese, it still has echoes of its colonial past. There are views of Sao Sebastiao Fort (1558) on the north of the island from Coral Lodge. This fort and many other colonial buildings are remnants of a bygone era, but still preserve that history. Explore the city at your own pace or let our local guide show you around and explain the island's controversial past.

## SUSTAINABLE TOURISM

Coral Lodge prides itself on being a sustainable tourist destination and wherever possible, attempts to put better practises in place in order to reduce its carbon footprint while supporting the local community.



### SOLAR TECHNOLOGY

In partnership with Ecolibri, Solar Power technology was introduced to Coral Lodge. We have successfully introduced solar lighting & solar-powered air-conditioning.

### WATER DESALINATION AND FILTRATION

We have installed a motor pump near the ocean which directs the water to the filtration tanks for desalination. After the last desalination step has been completed, the water is stored for use throughout the lodge.




### LOCAL COMMUNITY EMPLOYMENT

The presence of Coral Lodge has a hugely positive impact on the surrounding communities, especially Cabaceira Pequena. We currently employ many staff members from the community, most of whom support a minimum of 6 – 15 people each.

### FRESH PRODUCE

We have carefully tended our garden to provide fresh vegetables and herbs for our meals. We equally support the local communities in sourcing seafood and other goods. When dining with us, you know your food is sourced responsibly.

### DO I NEED A VISA?

While some countries are exempt from needing visas, please check the e-Visa website (<https://evisa.gov.mz>) to see whether you will require a visa or not.

### SHOULD I TAKE MALARIA TABLETS?

Mozambique is an area at risk for Malaria, so we recommend that you take precautions.

### IS THERE WIFI?

Complimentary Wifi is available in the Main Lodge areas including the bar and restaurant, but not available in the villas.

### CURRENCY AND CARDS

Mozambican currency is Meticals, however, US Dollars are widely accepted. At Coral Lodge, we accept Meticals and US Dollars only. Visas and Mastercard accepted only.

### DRESS CODE AT CORAL LODGE

Coral lodge enjoys a relaxed atmosphere with no dress code. However, as it is a majority Muslim country, we do suggest respectable clothing during visits to Ilha de Mozambique or the local community of Cabaceira Pequena, taking other cultural beliefs into consideration. In addition, you are advised to bring along comfortable clothes and sandals as you may need to wade through shallow waters on arrival.




