Guided by accomplished wildlife photographer, Francois Fourie, this private experience is designed for guests wishing to preserve their time on property in a way that feels personal, natural and long-lasting.



Whether documenting quiet moments in their villas, the atmosphere of the bush, or the wildlife encounters that unfold throughout a stay, the experience offers a refined and highly personalised way to remember Cheetah Plains.

Guests may choose between two bespoke photographic experiences. For those wishing to be fully present in the moment, the photographer may accompany them during their stay to capture candid, natural and styled imagery of their safari experience. From game drives and lodge moments to the details that make each journey unique, guests receive a curated digital collection that beautifully reflects their time in the wild.

For guests who prefer to step behind the lens, the experience may instead take the form of a guided wildlife photography session. During game drives and selected lodge experiences, the photographer offers hands-on guidance in composition, lighting, camera settings and visual storytelling, helping guests better understand how to capture wildlife and the surrounding landscape with confidence and intention.

Each experience is tailored according to the guest's level of interest, experience and expectations, with optional pre-arrival consultation to ensure a seamless and personal approach. All imagery is approached with discretion, sensitivity and respect for the privacy of each guest. Final image collections are professionally edited and delivered digitally, creating a lasting visual record of the safari experience.

The Cheetah Plains Photographic Safari is available as a private add-on experience and may be arranged prior to arrival, subject to availability and operational scheduling.
