NGARE NDARE FOREST

Just over an hour from Lewa Wilderness, journey into the Ngare Ndare Forest, a lush indigenous forest at the foothills of Mt. Kenya.

You will depart in the morning with your guide and travel to Ngare Ndare Forest, where you will meet a ranger from the Ngare Ndare Conservancy.

You will then be guided through the forest finding a beautiful array of different bird species and other wildlife. You will also discover six natural pools and waterfalls to swim in and East Africa's longest suspended bridge, where you can enjoy a bird's eye view of the forest, which ends on a high platform where one can view elephants and other wild animals drinking water from the swamp below.
