About

Loldia House is an ideal spot to rest, taste the pleasures of Kenyan country life and explore the wonders of the Great Rift Valley.

Set amongst a family farm of 6,500 acres on the shores of Lake Naivasha, this charming property is steeped in history and dates back to 1943. Guests are invited to enjoy a gentle pace of life, relax by the pool, take in the views or head out on a game drive.

In the original family home, there is one en-suite double room. Close by are three guest cottages (each housing two separate en-suite rooms) and two luxury suites offering incredible views across the lake. Set amongst flower-filled gardens and soft lawns, the greenery surrounding Loldia House is grazed daily and nightly by resident wildlife; hippos, impalas, waterbuck, giraffes and warthog.

Loldia is ideally located to enjoy many different activities and discover the varying landscapes and wildlife areas of the Great Rift Valley. Dining is enjoyed in the warmly lit dining room, where stories of adventures can be shared. Lunches are enjoyed outside in the pretty gardens or as a picnic while exploring this fascinating region of Kenya.

ACCOMMODATION

ACTIVITIES

Day and night game drives

With plenty of wildlife on Loldia, explore the area with one of our highly experienced guides. After dinner, enjoy a thrilling night drive, looking out for all kinds of nocturnal activity. Included in the accommodation price.

Boat ride on Lake Naivasha

Boat rides on Lake Naivasha will bring you closer to the resident hippos and a multitude of birdlife. Included in the rate.

Crescent Island

Lake Nakuru National Park and Lake Elementeita

One of Kenya's most famed parks, Lake Nakuru National Park, is home to an abundance of game, including both black and white rhinos. Perhaps more famous is the seasonal flamingo population, a colourful sight to behold. Entry to the park is extra.

Between Lake Naivasha and Lake Nakuru lies another of Kenya's alkaline lakes – Lake Elementeita. The area is an important feeding ground for greater and lesser flamingos and a critical breeding site for great white pelicans. You can stop off here for a leisurely wander along the shoreline and enjoy the sight of beautiful flamingos in their thousands (seasonal) and other animals such as zebras, antelopes, eland and warthogs.


Eburru Forest

Eburru Forest crowns the geologically active Mt Eburru, a volcanic massif in the Great Rift Valley. Mt Eburru is key in influencing local weather patterns, creating a catchment for rains that feed Lake Naivasha and Lake Elmenteita. The biodiversity of Eburru is astounding, with some 60 species of mammal, including the critically endangered mountain bongo. Guests staying at Loldia House can explore the forest on a game drive-or guided walk. There is a small entrance fee into Eburru that guests must pay.

Mt Longonot, Crater Lake and Hell's Gate

For a more strenuous experience, a hike up and around the extinct Mt Longonot or around Crater Lake is enjoyable, with exciting wildlife and beautiful views. Hell's Gate National Park is known for its unique geology and the steam geysers. You can walk through Hell's Gate NP and its beautiful rocky cliffs and outcrops. Entry to these parks is extra.

Other available activities include horse riding, an I8-hole golf course, tennis, visiting a flower farm, or the local Loldia Primary School, which Governors' Camp Collection supports.



The Great Rift Valley

The Great Rift is a highlight of any trip to Kenya, where breathtaking natural scenery combines with some of Africa's most memorable wildlife.

A vast geological fault line, the Great Rift Valley, stretches around one-sixth of the Earth's circumference. Along its lengths are volcanoes, most now dormant. One of the rarest animals found here is the rhino, and living alongside it are millions of flamingos - the world's greatest concentration is around Lake Nakuru.

Lake Naivasha lies in the Great Rift Valley, flanked by dormant and extinct volcanoes, in a dramatic and undulating volcanic landscape. The variable topography has enabled a stunning variety of ecosystems and wildlife areas. Lake Naivasha is a freshwater lake that provides habitat to hippos, plains game, and numerous resident and migratory birds sustained by the lake's fish population. The shores are fringed by a mixture of wildlife conservancies and flower farms—producing one of Kenya's most famed exports, alongside coffee and tea.

Neighbouring Lake Naivasha in the Great Rift Valley are Lake Nakuru National Park and Lake Elementeita, each offering the opportunity for game drives and exploration. Lake Nakuru is famed for its black and white rhinos and flamingoes. Elementeita is also seasonally fringed with the pink colour of thousands of lesser and greater flamingos and great white pelicans - an incredible sight to behold.

Mt Longonot and Crater Lake offer enjoyable and vigorous hikes with wonderful views and encounters with plains game. Hell's Gate National Park offers mountain bike riding and fascinating walks through water-sculpted gorges.

GETTING THERE

Governors' Aviation: Daily scheduled flights from Nairobi Wilson Airport to Loldia Airstrip. Clients are met upon arrival and transferred by game vehicle to Loldia House (approx. 10 min drive). Departure flights leave Loldia via the Masai Mara and back to Nairobi.

Charter flights: Governors' Aviation provides charter flights from any airports/airstrips in Kenya to Loldia Airstrip. Please email res@governorsaviation.com for a quote.

Luggage restrictions: Maximum **15 kg luggage restriction per person** (inclusive of hand luggage), in soft bags, for small aircraft.

Road transfer: It takes approximately two hours (depending upon road conditions) from Nairobi. Please ask us for a road map ahead of your journey.

Weather

During May, June, July, August, September, October, and November, you are most likely to experience good weather with pleasant average temperatures between 20 degrees Celsius (68°F) and 25 degrees Celsius (77°F).

The warmest month is February, with an average temperature of I8°C (65°F). July has the lowest average temperature of the year, being I5°C (59°F).

Climate

- Altitude: Naivasha is 1898m above sea level.
- The climate in Naivasha is warm and temperate, with a significant amount of rainfall throughout the year. In our opinion, the best times of year to visit the Naivasha region for warm-weather activities are from early August to mid-October and from mid-December to early March.
