Description

“Feel the pulse of the city from the heart of the bushveld.” River Crossing is located approximately 5 km from Windhoek —only a five-minute drive from the city centre. Perched atop a koppie on a pristine 6,500-hectare reserve, the lodge offers sweeping views and unforgettable sunsets.

The lodge blends the charm of a bygone era of farm life with the comfort and convenience expected by today’s discerning traveller. The main building features a welcoming reception area with a postcard corner, a cosy lounge with fireplace, and a spacious dining area that opens onto a wooden deck and bar. A lap pool lies between the lounge and dining room, level with the deck and overlooking the reserve. A second guest pool is located a short distance from the main deck for more privacy and leisure.

From the deck, guests enjoy uninterrupted views of Moltkeblick Mountain and the twinkling lights of Windhoek below—an iconic River Crossing experience. The chalets and main lodge are designed in the style of traditional German farmhouses, each with its own *stoep* and *afdakkie* facing the natural surroundings.

River Crossing is also an ideal venue for conferences and celebrations. The conference room accommodates up to 65 delegates, while the boardroom seats 18. The lodge caters for weddings, anniversaries, birthdays, corporate events, and other special occasions.

Accommodation

The lodge offers **20 guest chalets**:

- **13 Twin Chalets**
- **7 Double Chalets**

All chalets include en-suite bathrooms with showers, toilets, and basins. Two chalets are designed for honeymooners and feature bathtubs instead of showers. All rooms include eco-friendly amenities, and the warm hospitality River Crossing is known for.

- 14 chalets face east with sunrise views of Moltkeblick Mountain

Game Drives: Morning and afternoon drives offer exceptional views, diverse flora, and a variety of wildlife species including giraffe, eland, zebra, wildebeest, oryx, and kudu, as well as the enigmatic leopard and cheetah, occasionally spotted along the way.

Guided Walks: Guests may explore the reserve on foot with a guide. The terrain is hilly, so a basic level of fitness is recommended.

Horse Riding: A quiet, eco-friendly way to get closer to wildlife.

City Excursions: For guests who prefer urban exploration, Windhoek's malls, markets, and shops are just minutes away.
