

BIG CAVE CAMP

LODGE ON THE ROCKS

FACT SHEET

LOCATION: Bordering the Matobo National Park, within a World Heritage area. 46km from Bulawayo turnoff.

SETTING: On top of a granite ridge (kopje). Bushman paintings, caves and grain bins surround the lodge, 1000-hectare concession.

LIGHTING: Electric lighting in lodges, 220 v mains power, Inverters and Solar. Hurricane lanterns and candlelight.

CHALETS (sleeps up to 24):

8 x Twin / Double chalets with en-suite flush toilet, shower and basin with hot water. Doors open onto a private deck. Can be set up as king size bed, or alternatively as twin beds. All have stunning views across into the Matobo National Park.

1 x Family room: King size / Twin bed and double bunk bed) with en-suite flush toilet, shower and basin with hot water. Doors open onto a private balcony, with superb views to the valley below. Stunning views across into the Matobo National Park.

2 x Honeymoon / Family suites: King-size / Twin bed, lounge area, with en-suite flush toilet, shower and double basin with hot water. Doors open onto a private deck. Stunning views across into the Matobo National Park.

BAR/DINING ROOM: Enclosed. A huge rock is incorporated into the room, with trees growing through the roof. Guests all sit around the dinner table with staff and managers. Relaxed, cosy atmosphere. Good home cooking, x3 qualified chefs. Bar is fully stocked with local and imported drinks.

LIBRARY: Quiet area with fireplace and substantial local reading material as well as Wi-fi in public areas.

MANAGEMENT: Managers: Warren Mills & Desnee Joseph. Assistant Lodge Manager Shepherd Mpofu. Front of House Manager Adelaide Dube. Three qualified guides on the property, Shepherd, Sandile and Mthabisi. Specialist guides available on request.

VEHICLES: 3 Toyota Hilux and 1 X 3.5-ton Isuzu 4X4 22-Seater (Open safari vehicles) fitted with comfortable bucket seats and seatbelts. All licensed for the Matobo National Park. Toyota Regius Luxury Minibus for transfers.

ACTIVITIES: Rhino tracking, walks, game drives, bird watching, hiking, bush lunches / breakfasts. Visits to caves, rock art galleries. Rhodes Grave tours. Ndebele village, school, clinic visits and Cyrene Mission. Moonlight walks and open-air dinners (weather permitting). Bulawayo Natural History Museum, Khami Ruins, Bulawayo Art Gallery.

MEALS: Table D'hote. Special meals available by prior arrangement.

CHILDREN: Under 12 years and sharing with parents less 50% on accommodation. Children under 6 years are free.

TRANSFERS: To/from Bulawayo Airport, Train Station and Bulawayo surrounds, Hwange, Vic Falls, Great Zimbabwe.

Driver Transfer Accommodation and Meals: Booked and paid by tour operator.

GUIDE/DRIVER POLICY: Basic accommodation unless otherwise requested. Pays for meals only.

CHECK IN/OUT: Check out 10am. Check in 2pm

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
