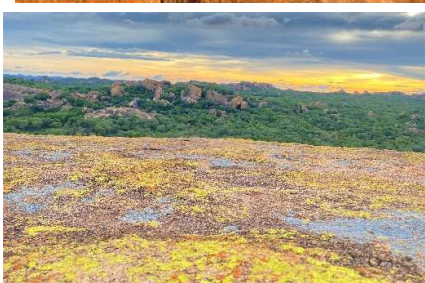
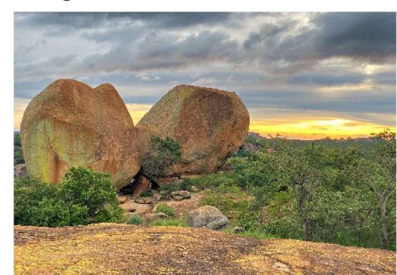
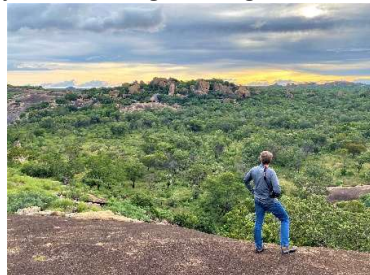


Activities on Big Cave Camp Estate:

[CONCESSION GAME DRIVE]: This activity combines plains game viewing and rock art, with spectacular scenery at 'Lightning Rock' for sundowners. Duration approx. x1.5 Hours. Price: US\$ 35.00 per person. Activity departs Big Cave Reception at 16h30/ 17h00



[CONCESSION WALKS]: Walks can be gentle or strenuous depending on the needs of the client. Bird watching, trees, shrubs, and rock art are some of the items that can be enjoyed on the walk. Duration approx. x1.5 Hours. Price: US\$ 25.00 per person per hour. Activity can be arranged with guides from the lodge.



[CONCESSION NIGHT DRIVE]: On Big Cave estate. The night drives allow guests the opportunity of viewing both nocturnal birds and mammals, such as night jars, bush babies, as well as the chance of seeing some of the cats. Our resident male leopard is always on the prowl at night! Duration approx. x1 hour. Departs at 20h30. Price: US\$ 35.00pp



[MOUNTAIN BIKING]: Mountain bikes are available for hire from reception for leisurely rides on Big Cave Camp's property, or book in advance (pending on Mountain Bike Guide availability) for a mountain bike activity tour into Matopos National recreational Park or Cultural Village tour rides. Hiring of Mountain bike: US\$18.00 per hour. Half day Mountain bike Activity: US\$60.00 per person (excl. National Park fees).



Activities into Matopos National Park

[RHINO WALKING / GAME DRIVE]: Game drives into the recreational park to view White Rhino, as well as plains game. Guests normally track the rhino on foot with a professional Big Cave Camp guide and Parks official. Duration approx. x3 hours. Activity Tour Price: US\$ 80.00 per person. Plus Rhino walking permit: US\$ 24.00 per person (for non-residents). Plus Park entrance fee at US\$ 18.00 per person per day (for non-residents).



[RECREATIONAL PARK DRIVE]: Recreational Park drive consists of the following: Rhodes Grave Monument, Nswatugi cave, and Maleme dam. This is a very scenic drive, and the view from Rhodes Grave well worth seeing! Duration approx. x4 hours. Activity Tour Price: US\$ 80.00 per person. Plus Park entrance fee: US\$ 18.00 per person (for non-residents) plus Monument fee: US\$10.00 per person (for non-residents).

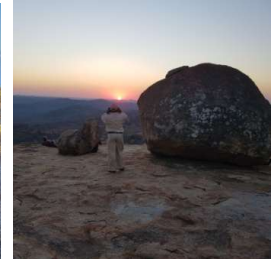

[RHODES GRAVE DRIVE]: Duration approx. x2.5 hours. Activity Tour Price: US\$70.00 per person excluding Park and monument fees. (Park fees US\$ 18.00 per person (for non-residents), plus Monument fees US\$ 10.00 per person (for non-residents)). This activity leaves Big Cave Camp reception at approx. 15h00.



HIKING TO FAMOUS ROCK ART GALLERIES

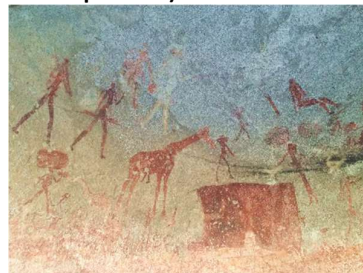
[NSWATUGI CAVE]: Degree of Hiking difficulty 2 out of 5 – Short hike with steps. Duration of activity approx. X3 hours. Activity Tour Price: USD\$65.00 per person excluding Park fees. Park fees US\$18.00 per person per day (for non-residents).



[BAMBATA CAVE]: Degree of Hiking difficulty 2.5 out of 5 – Approx. 3km hike each way with steady incline on granite. Bambata Cave Drive / walk through Whovi National Game Park to access the famous Bambata cave paintings, and the black eagle nest site. Duration approx. X4 hours. Activity Tour Price: US\$ 85.00 per person excluding Park fees. Park fees US\$ 18.00 per person per day (for non-residents). (Require Minimum X2 Pax per tour).



[SILOZWANE CAVE]: Degree of Hiking difficulty 5 out of 5 – Approx. 2km hike each way with steep incline on granite. Should be comfortable with steep ascents and heights. Silozwane Cave Drive / walk to the famous Silozwane cave paintings, with incredible views into the low veld. Duration of activity approx. X4 hours. Activity tour Price: US\$ 85.00 per person. Park fees not applicable. Highly Recommend: To shop from the local curio sellers at Silozwane car park. (Require Minimum X2 Pax per tour)

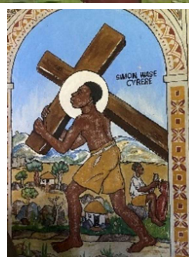
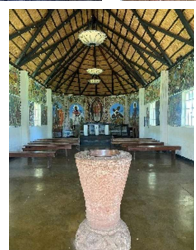
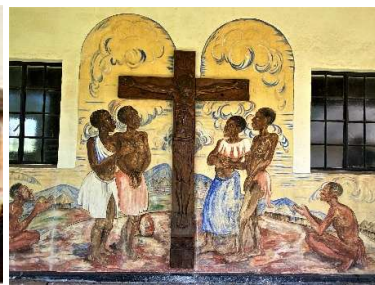


[INANKE CAVE]: Degree of Hiking difficulty 4.5 out of 5 – Approx. 12km around hike. Preferable to have previous hiking experience and comfortable to walk for a minimum of X4 hours with a fairly steep ascent to the cave. This is a full day hike (Includes packed lunch). Inanke Cave is renowned for the quality of its rock art. This world-renowned sight is not easily accessible but is well worth the effort. Duration of activity approx. X7 hours. Activity tour Price: US\$ 130.00 per person. Plus Park fees US\$ 18.00 per person per day (for non-residents). (Require Minimum X2 Pax per tour).



CULTURAL & HISTORICAL ACTIVITIES

[CYRENE MISSION]: Guided Drive to Cyrene Mission Cathedral. Cyrene is an Anglican mission school founded in 1940 with an artistic and historic outlook that is completely African; thatched chapel has its interior and exterior walls covered with colourful mural painted by students who used Biblical stories as the source of their inspiration. Some of these students were among the first professional African artistes in Rhodesia. Activity Price USD\$60.00 pp (incl. US\$5 donation toward the cathedral)

Ndebele Cultural Village and White Waters School

Activity price: US\$60.00 per person. Park fees not applicable. Duration: Half day activity

[INDEBELE VILLAGE DRIVE]: Guided Drive to Ndebele village, Whitewater's Secondary School, and the clinic. This is a very informative tour to give you a genuine idea of how the Matabele people live.



[WHITE WATER'S / NJELELE PRIMARY SCHOOL]: Guided Drive to visit either of the two schools. Take a tour of the school and meet with both pupils and teachers alike, to get an insight into the Zimbabwe education system.



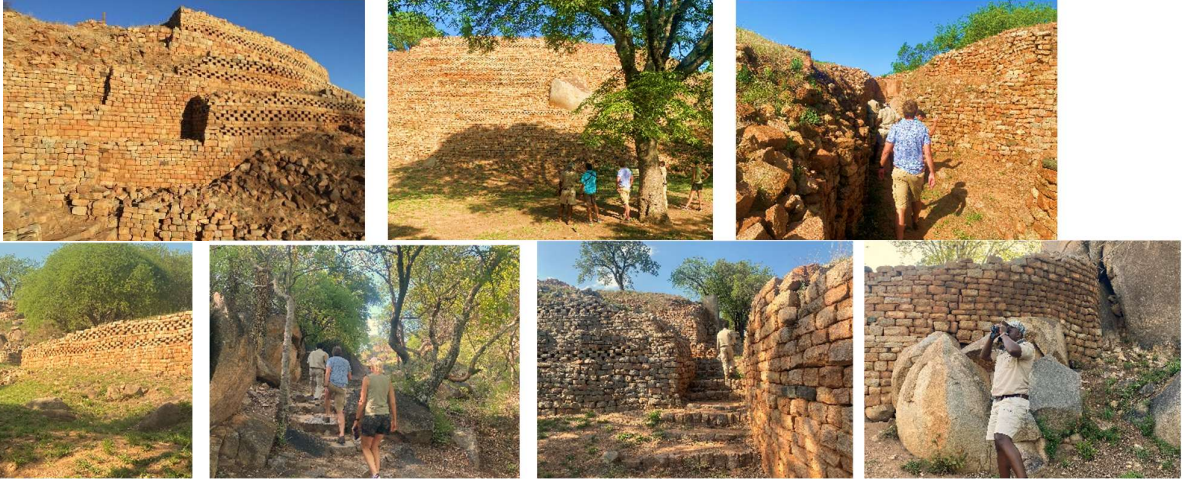

Bulawayo Activity Sheet 2026

Khami Ruins plus either the Natural History Museum or Railway Museum (half day activity)

[KHAMI RUINS]: Guided Drive to Khami ruins. Khami is the second largest stone-built monument in Zimbabwe. It was once the capital of the Kingdom of Butwa of the Torwa dynasty. It is now a national monument and became a UNESCO World Heritage site. Activity Price USD\$85.00 per person. Entrance fee: USD10.00 per person (for non-residents)



[Natural History Museum]: Guided Drive to Bulawayo Natural History Museum. Officially opened in 1964, the museum contains exhibits illustrating the history, mineral wealth and wildlife of Zimbabwe, including the second largest mounted elephant in the world, being the only natural history museum in Zimbabwe. Entrance fee: USD\$10.00 pp (for non-residents)



[Railway Museum]: Guided Drive to Bulawayo Railway Museum. The railway museum is located at Bulawayo railway station that houses several exhibitions on the history of the railway system in Zimbabwe formerly Rhodesia. Its oldest exhibits date back to 1987 and include Cecil Rhodes' personal railway coach. Entrance fee: USD\$5.00 pp (for non-residents).
