
ACCOMMODATION



GORILLA TREKKING

Gorilla Heights Lodge is set in the western sector of the Bwindi Impenetrable National Park and gives you the opportunity to embrace an extraordinary, once-in-a-lifetime wildlife encounter with the phenomenal mountain gorillas. The nearest trekking sector, called Nkuringo, is only 15 minutes away from the lodge and is home to four gorilla families. The Posho family has 17 members, the Nkuringo family is made up of 14 members, the Bushaho family has 9 members and the Christmas family, 8.

There is also access to two other trekking sectors, Rushaga and Mgahinga, from the lodge. There are 10 families living in the Rushaga sector, as well as the golden monkey species, habitating the Mgahinga sector. The gorilla trekking experience is led daily, at a maximum number of eight persons per family, per day. These expeditions take place over approximately seven hours.

NOTE:

- Participants must be 15 years or older to participate in the gorilla trekking experience.
- Participants are not allowed to interact with the gorillas but must maintain a minimum distance of 10 metres between themselves and the gorillas.



GUIDED HIKES AND NATURE WALKS

Embark on guided adventures by foot in Buniga Forest. Explore the region's breathtaking wilderness on our guided hiking and nature walks. Traverse ancient, mist-draped forests in the midst of a UNESCO World Heritage Site that is rich in biodiversity and displays stunning flora and fauna at every turn. Each experience is enriched by our knowledgeable experts, who share their insights for a truly memorable experience in the park's tranquil surroundings.



BIRDWATCHING AT GORILLA HEIGHTS LODGE

Enjoy the wonders of the avian diversity in the heart of Bwindi. Each moment is a discovery as you embark on an unforgettable bird-watching experience in this lush forest setting, renowned for its biodiversity, including a rich variety of bird life. As you trek through the dense forests, you'll have the opportunity to spot an array of colourful and rare birds from the 350 species that reside in the region. Guided by one of our expert rangers, you'll learn about the feathered habitants' unique characteristics and behaviours, ensuring an immersive and enriching experience.

GOLDEN MONKEY TREKKING AT MGAHINGA GORILLA NATIONAL PARK

Embark on an unforgettable adventure in the Mgahinga Gorilla National Park. As you trek through lush forests, you will have the opportunity to witness the endangered golden monkeys in their natural habitat, approximately two hours (52 km) from the lodge. An expert guide will lead you through this breathtaking terrain, sharing insights about the flora and fauna that make this area so special. The trekking experience takes place over approximately four hours.

NOTE:

- Participants must be 15 years or older to participate in the golden monkey trekking experience.
- Participants are not allowed to interact with the monkeys but must maintain a minimum distance of 10 metres between themselves and the monkeys. A full briefing will be given by the guides before the outing.



CANOEING AND BIRDWATCHING AT LAKE MUTANDA

Discover the splendour of the Kisoro District and its abundant birdlife from a unique vantage point. Lake Mutanda is an exquisite location for canoeing and birdwatching. Enjoy the tranquil setting, featuring stunning landscapes and vibrant birdlife.

This experience takes place approximately one hour's drive (22 km) from Gorilla Heights Lodge.

SUSTAINABILITY

We put the same effort into prioritising luxury and the comfort of our guests as we do into sustainability, community engagement and conservation practices.

Our desire is to maintain and care for the environment that makes Bwindi the incredible place that it is. We do so in the following ways:

- Conserving soil and trees: No trees were cut down during the construction of Gorilla Heights Lodge, in order to conserve the integrity of the area's rich volcanic soils. We also planted bamboo and fruit trees on site.
- Using sustainable energy sources: We use briquettes as an alternative source of energy to heat rooms and bath or shower water.
- Upholding eco-friendly waste management: We have a "no plastics" policy at the lodge, so we supply our guests with glass containers to drink water from. We have also put a waste management system in place that ensures no waste is dumped in the forest.
- Harvesting rainwater: The architectural design of our structures ties in with our conservation efforts. Our cottages' slanted roofs allow for the collection of rainwater, which is stored on site, treated, filtered and pumped back into the facility for use. We also encourage guests to use water sparingly.

We are also passionate about helping surrounding communities to enjoy improved livelihoods. We have done so and continue doing so in the following ways:

• Employing and empowering local workers: During the year-long process of constructing the lodge, we employed over 150 people from the community which impacted over 600 family members. We also worked with the community to extract black volcanic stones, known as "lkoro" from Kisoro and Nkuringo, for use on our structures. These stones are maintenance free, which also helps us conserve water. The rock extraction process also revealed fertile grounds where the community has been able to grow crops.

Distances:

Located within 10 minutes' walk from the starting point of gorilla trekking, Gorilla Heights Lodge occupies the axis of Nkuringo, a gently sloping hill that is at cloud level, 2 400 m above sea level and is the highest vantage point in the southern wing of Bwindi.

Fliahts:

From Entebbe Airport to Kisoro Airstrip takes 1 hour, then the transfer to the lodge is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes (38km).

Road access:

- 1. From Entebbe Airport, the transfer to Gorilla Heights Lodge in Kisoro takes 10 hours.
- From Kigali Airport Rwanda, the transfer to Gorilla Heights Lodge through the Cyanika border takes 4 hours 30 minutes.

TEMPERATURE

Average day temperatures:

Bwindi has a mountain forest climate. Average temperatures range from a minimum of 12°C to 20°C to a maximum of 24°C.

The area generally receives over 2 000 mm of rainfall every year, with peak rainy seasons from March to April and September to November.
