CAMP SOSSUS SELF-DRIVE DIRECTIONS

GPS: 24°.69 45.40 S 16°.08 94.10 E

FROM WINDHOEK

Head south from Windhoek on the B1 and travel for 82 km to Rehoboth. Continue through the town and then turn right onto the C24, a gravel road, shortly after crossing a bridge. Continue along this road for 89 km, past before reaching a junction a few km past Klein Aub. Here you take the left fork to Rietoog (M47), and drive for around 20 km before turning right onto the D1206. You stay on this road for 28km before meeting the C14 where you turn left for a short distance, passing Bullsport Guestfarm, before turning right onto the D854. You follow this road for 72km before meeting the C19 where you turn left and drive for 11 km before seeing a sign to 'CAMP SOSSUS PICK-UP POINT 3 KM' on your left-hand side. Here you turn off to the left and travel for 3 km, ultimately arriving at the CAMP SOSSUS SELF-DRIVE PARKING. A radio for communication is placed at the shaded parking for you to contact the camp for pick up. Allow for about 20 minutes and use the time for any repacking you may need to do as your vehicle will remain here in the shaded parking for the duration of your stay, whilst you are transferred to Camp Sossus in a safari vehicle.

FROM WALVIS BAY

You depart Walvis Bay on the C14 and travel for around 220km to Solitaire, driving through the Kuiseb and Gaub Canyons. When you get to Solitaire you turn into the right onto the C19 and continue south on the C19 for 108 km, passing the turning to Sesriem on the right-hand side after approximately 71 km and then continuing for another 37 km beyond there. At this point you will then see a sign to 'CAMP SOSSUS PICK-UP POINT 3 KM' on your left-hand side. Here you turn off to the left and travel for 3 km, ultimately arriving at the CAMP SOSSUS SELF-DRIVE PARKING. A radio for communication is placed at the shaded parking for you to contact the camp for pick up. Allow for about 20 minutes and use the time for any repacking you may need to do as your vehicle will remain here in the shaded parking for the duration of your stay, whilst you are transferred to Camp Sossus in a safari vehicle.

FROM MALTAHOEHE

You travel through Maltahöhe from the east and continue through the town until you reach a T-junction where you turn left and continue to the next junction where you turn right onto the C19. This road eventually leads to Sesriem and Solitaire, and you travel on this for 111 km until you are around 37 km from the Sesriem

turning. At this point you will see a sign to 'CAMP SOSSUS PICK-UP POINT 3 KM' on your right-hand side.
