BLYDE DAM BOAT TRIP

The 90min interpretation tour by a tour guide that will take you to the rare living Kadishi Tufa Waterfall and the Three Rondavels. At 200m in height, the Kadishi Tufa Waterfall is the second tallest Tufa Waterfall on earth, resembling a face which is crying profusely, thus known as 'the weeping face of nature'.

The dam and surrounds is home to a range of wildlife such as kudu, duiker, hippo's, crocodiles, Fish Eagle and the ever-elusive African Finfoot.

QUAD BIKE TRAIL AT FRANKLIN PARK

Quad bike trails begin at Franklyn Park in Hoedspruit at the foothills of the Mariepskop Mountain. The track will take you through riverine forest and savannah grasslands with spectacular views. Small antelope, baboons and an abundance of birdlife makes part of this trip. You have to be 14 years and older to drive a quad bike. Under 14 years of age can join as a passenger. Closed shoes are required.

GAME VIEWING QUAD BIKE TRAILS

Trails begin at Buffalo land Safari's, a Big 3 reserve. You have to be 16 years and older to drive a quad bike. 5 to 15 years can join as a passenger. Closed shoe are required.

AFRICAN DREAM TOURS

Clay pigeon shooting, or simply "clay shooting," is a thrilling outdoor sport that's growing in popularity. Instead of live quarry, participants shoot at specially designed clay targets, which are launched into the air from a machine known as a trap.

To properly shoot a bow, you should turn 90 degrees away from the target and stay with your feet at shoulder width.

While drawing the bow you should align your shoulders and keep them level.

Draw to a consistent point on your face and make sure to keep your bow hand and arm steady while you shoot.

HIKING THE CANYON

Peninsula Trail

Start at the visitors Centre at Blyde Dam. Follow this circular trail through the bushveld along the Origstad River portion of the dam. Hike up the peninsula and complete the route at the parking area of the Centre.

- Distance: 2.3 km approx. 1, 5 hr.

Waterfall Trail

Begins diagonally opposite the Nature Conservator's office near the bridge.

Follow the trail through the riverine forest and an ecotone to the waterfall and back. Matumi, Mitzeri, Sycamore fig and Forest Fever Trees are common.

- Distance 2,1 km approx. 1hr15 min.

Bushpig, Kudu and Vervet Trails (Swadini Forever Resort)

These one-way trails stretch along the Blyde River near the Blyde River Canyon Lodge.

Riverine forest trees like Matumi, Water Elders and Wild Date Palms are abundant. Kudus, Bushbuck, Duiker, monkeys, and baboons can also be seen.

- Bushpig Trail: 2.2 km
- Kudu Trail: 1.4 km
- Vervet Trail: 1.0 km

Hippo Valley Trail (NB Permit required)

Start at the bridge across the Blyde River. Walk towards the dam wall. Turn left up the gravel road and follow the trail signs. The route stretches along Blyde dam and the Rodille Peaks. Turn back once Hippo Valley is reached. Permits need to be acquired at the visitors Centre.
