





Surrounded by the tranquil Blyde River and the majestic Drakensberg mountains, this thatched lodge is set in a private reserve, in an area famous for its panoramic scenery, birdlife, fauna and flora.

Nestled on the banks of the Blyde River, it offers travelers a unique bush experience whilst soaking up the beauty of the natural surroundings.

Places of water are places of life.

Not only are the water courses of the Blyde River Wilderness Lodge well populated with Hippo's and Crocodiles, but the reserve is also home to Giraffe, Zebra, Nyala, Impala, Wildebeest, Bushbuck, Duiker, Steen buck, Waterbuck, Bush pig and Warthog.

The lodge is situated along the famous Panoramic Route in the Mpumalanga/Limpopo Province and is just a 45-minute drive to the Kruger National Park- Orpen Gate.



A blend of Contemporary and African decor compliments the beauty of the lodge's surroundings as well as being set amongst large majestic Jackelberry and Fig trees, whose shade cascades over the pristine lawn areas.

Stylish rooms lead out on to the Blyde River and include ensuite bathrooms and tea trays. Scrumptious breakfasts are included, and candlelight dinners are by arrangement. Enjoy sundowners at the pool with the sounds of the bush to keep you company or take a stroll on the reserve with the resident giraffe, Zebra, Nyala, and Impala.

Accommodation comprises four (4) luxury double/twin rooms with air conditioning and en-suite bathrooms, two (2) standard Rondavels double/twin with air conditioning and ceiling Fans with en-suite bathrooms.

All rooms are tastefully furnished, and each room leads out onto the tranquil river settings where Crocodiles and Hippos swim by.

# LOCAL ATTRACTIONS



The Blyde River Canyon area offers an incredible array of activities, from hiking scenic trails with panoramic views of the canyon, Three Rondavels, and God's Window to exploring the vibrant wildlife at the Moholoholo Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre and Hoedspruit Endangered Species Centre.

Adventurers can enjoy quad biking, boat cruises on the Blyde Dam, and thrilling Big 5 game drives in private reserves, while the culturally curious can experience traditional tribal dance and drumming shows.

\For a breathtaking perspective, hot air ballooning, microlighting, and helicopter tours over the canyon provide an unforgettable experience.





### **BLYDE DAM BOAT TRIP**

The 90min interpretation tour by a tour guide that will take you to the rare living Kadishi Tufa Waterfall and the Three Rondavels. At 200m in height, the Kadishi Tufa Waterfall is the second tallest Tufa Waterfall on earth, resembling a face which is crying profusely, thus known as 'the weeping face of nature'.

Turn left up the gravel road and follow the trail signs. The route stretches along Blyde dam and the Rodille Peaks.

Turn back once Hippo Valley is reached. Permits need to be acquired at the visitors Centre.

Distance 16 km 5/6 hours.





We advise that you use the GPS Co-Ordinates in conjunction with our written directions.

- From Johannesburg and Pretoria: - Take the N12 from Johannesburg and the N4 from Pretoria, past Witbank and Middelburg to Belfast then turn onto the R540 to Dullstroom and Lydenburg (Mashishing).
- Take the R36 to Ohrigstad, through the Strijdom Tunnel and onto the R527 in the direction of Hoedspruit.
- Travel on the R527 for roughly 22kms from the tunnel. Opposite the road stall called 'Appelblaar' there is a sign for Richmond farms, Kimba Lodge, and Blyde River Wilderness Lodge etc. – turn left. The tar changes to a gravel road and splits – keep right.
- Go through the boom gate and follow the road for approximately 6 Kms. The road then splits again – keep left travel about 1 km going down the dip and halfway up the hill. On the right-hand side, you will find the entrance for the lodge and a sign saying **KIMBA LODGE** and **BLYDE RIVER WILDERNESS LODGE**- turn right here.
- The gate is either manned or left unlocked, please press button to open. Follow the signs to the lodge (3km). Please be advised that there are wild animals so please drive slowly.

- Arrivals between 19:00 and 20:00 will incur a surcharge of R250.00.
- No arrivals are permitted entry after 21:00. The booking will be marked as a no-show and 100% cancellation fees will apply

# DEPOSIT & CANCELLATION POLICY

## Deposit Policy

- A 50% deposit is required to confirm all reservations.
- The balance is due 30 days prior to arrival.
- Bookings made within 30 days of arrival require full payment to confirm.
- All payments must be made via secure EFT

## Cancellation Policy

- 0 - 21 days prior to arrival **100% of Booking price**
- 22 - 45 days prior to arrival **50% of Booking price**
- 46 - 60 days prior to arrival **25% of Booking price**
- Cancellation fees are only levied if damages are incurred as a result of the cancellation.
- Should the accommodation be resold, cancellation fees will be refunded less a 10% handling fee.
