AT A GLANCE

LOCATION Situated in the Lupanda Game Management Area (GMA), along the banks of the Luangwa River, our location offers convenient access to both the park and the Nsefu sector for exploration.

AIR ACCESS The most convenient way to reach Shawa Luangwa Camp is by taking a one-hour flight from Lusaka to Mfuwe International Airport, followed by a one-hour transfer drive to the camp. The last leg of the drive, which lasts 30 minutes, offers stunning views of the Lupanda GMA.

ROAD ACCESS Lusaka to Luangwa: 9.5 hours (Mfuwe – South Luangwa National Park)

VISA Most passports require a visa. These can be obtained in advance or arrival at Kenneth Kaunda International Airport.

CURRENCY Currently Cashless.

SEASONS **Summer:** August to November with October and November being very hot with chances of rain.
Winter: May to August with cool evenings and very cold mornings.

RAINS November to March. Rains are sometimes experienced in April.


MALARIA We provide mosquito nets and spray for your comfort and protection, and we encourage guests to bring their own insect repellent. However, malaria is present throughout Zambia, so we strongly recommend consulting your doctor for advice on appropriate prophylactic medication before your visit.

LUXURY TENTS

All four luxury tents are elevated and have expansive views of the Luangwa River and the park. Each tent features an en suite bathroom with a bathtub, a separate toilet cubicle, and double vanity with brass and copper fittings. There is an outdoor private shower for an immersive experience in nature.

There are three luxury double tents that can easily convert to twin beds for flexible arrangements. Two connected tents, one with a king bed and the other with twin beds, form a family tent, separated by a 5-meter elevated walkway. Each tent has a private deck for guests to relax and soak in the surroundings.

Guests can enjoy filter coffee, a variety of tea, and cookies provided in the tents. Hot water is delivered in the early morning via flask and can be requested at any time throughout the day.

Our open-air dining room offers picturesque views of the Luangwa River, where guests can enjoy breakfast, lunch, afternoon tea, and dinner daily. Our menu features expertly prepared homestyle meals with a modern twist, and we are happy to accommodate requests for local dishes. While we offer set menus, we can cater to all dietary requirements to ensure every guest's needs are met. A light early morning snack is provided before game drives and other snacks and drinks are provided on all activities. Dining is by individual seating arrangement, but guests are welcome to invite their guide or management to join them. They are also welcomed to dine with other guests. A variety of drinks are served including beers, wines and cocktails.

EXTRA BEDS	Extra beds are available, however, due to the design of the accommodations, space is limited. Please enquire with reservations.
FAN	Yes, in all tents, as well as lovely evening breezes.
HEATING	Double feather duvets and hot water bottles are provided during the colder months.
MOSQUITO NET	Yes, in all tents.
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BATH	Yes in all tents.
SHOWER	Outdoor.
SAFE	Yes.
HAIRDRYER	No hairdryers in the tents due to power restrictions but can be provided on request.
LAUNDRY	Yes, laundry is complimentary for all-inclusive packages. Kindly note that it is air-dried, so it takes at least 24 hours to be returned, and the service is weather-dependent.
POWER	Shawa Luangwa Camp is an eco-friendly lodge primarily powered by solar energy. All rooms are equipped with 220v electricity and built-in multi plugs for guest convenience.

We offer game drives twice daily, at sunrise and in the evening, with the evening drive returning 1 hour and a half after dark. Children aged 12 and older are welcome on game drives. Additionally, we provide Walking Safaris with a maximum of 6 people per safari, and the minimum age requirement is 12 years old.
