

SEASONS

Winter (Dry Season):

Characterised by lower rainfall, winter brings cool nights and comfortably mild days. Wildlife gathers around waterholes, and the sparse vegetation makes for excellent game viewing opportunities.

Summer (Wet Season):

A season of abundance, summer is marked by dramatic afternoon thunderstorms, the arrival of newborn animals, and a vibrant display of lush green vegetation. Migratory birds also return, adding to the rich diversity of wildlife.

Summer	November - March	25 - 35 °C
Autumn	April - May	15 - 30 °C
Winter	June - August	8 - 25 °C
Spring	September - October	10 - 30 °C
